Anah and Dishon <u>13_1CH_01_38</u># And the sons of Seir; Lotan, and Shobal, and Zibeon, and Anah, and Dishon, and Ezar, and Dishan.

Anah Dishon And <u>13_1CH_01_41</u># The sons of Anah; Dishon. And the sons of Dishon; Amram, and Eshban, and Ithran, and Cheran.

Anah Esau's wife <u>01_GEN_36_18</u># And these [are] the sons of Aholibamah Esau's wife; duke Jeush, duke Jaalam, duke Korah: these [were] the dukes [that came] of Aholibamah the daughter of Anah, Esau's wife.

Anah that found <u>01_GEN_36_24</u> # And these [are] the children of Zibeon; both Ajah, and Anah: this [was that] Anah that found the mules in the wilderness, as he fed the asses of Zibeon his father.

Anah the daughter <u>01_GEN_36_02</u># Esau took his wives of the daughters of Canaan; Adah the daughter of Elon the Hittite, and Aholibamah the daughter of Anah the daughter of Zibeon the Hivite;

Anah the daughter <u>01_GEN_36_14</u># And these were the sons of Aholibamah, the daughter of Anah the daughter of Zibeon, Esau's wife: and she bare to Esau Jeush, and Jaalam, and Korah.

Anah this was <u>01_GEN_36_24</u># And these [are] the children of Zibeon; both Ajah, and Anah: this [was that] Anah that found the mules in the wilderness, as he fed the asses of Zibeon his father.

Anah were these <u>01_GEN_36_25</u> # And the children of Anah [were] these; Dishon, and Aholibamah the daughter of Anah.

Anah <u>13_1CH_01_40</u># The sons of Shobal; Alian, and Manahath, and Ebal, Shephi, and Onam. And the sons of Zibeon; Aiah, and Anah.

Anah <u>01_GEN_36_20</u># These [are] the sons of Seir the Horite, who inhabited the land; Lotan, and Shobal, and Zibeon, and Anah,

Anah <u>01_GEN_36_25</u># And the children of Anah [were] these; Dishon, and Aholibamah the daughter of Anah.

Anah <u>01_GEN_36_29</u># These [are] the dukes [that came] of the Horites; duke Lotan, duke Shobal, duke Zibeon, duke Anah,

Anaharath <u>06_JOS_19_19</u># And Haphraim, and Shihon, and Anaharath,

Baanah a Netophathite <u>10_2SA_23_29</u> # Heleb the son of Baanah, a Netophathite, Ittai the son of Ribai out of Gibeah of the children of Benjamin,

Baanah and the <u>10_2SA_04_02</u> # And Saul's son had two men [that were] captains of bands: the name of the one [was] Baanah, and the name of the other Rechab, the sons of Rimmon a Beerothite, of the children of Benjamin: [for Beeroth also was reckoned to Benjamin.

Baanah his brother <u>10_2SA_04_06</u> # And they came thither into the midst of the house, [as though] they would have fetched wheat; and they smote him under the fifth [rib]: and Rechab and Baanah his brother escaped.

Baanah his brother <u>10_2SA_04_09</u> # And David answered Rechab and Baanah his brother, the sons of Rimmon the Beerothite, and said unto them, [As] the LORD liveth, who hath redeemed my soul out of all adversity,

Baanah the Netophathite <u>13_1CH_11_30</u># Maharai the Netophathite, Heled the son of Baanah the Netophathite,

Baanah The number <u>15_EZR_02_02</u> # Which came with Zerubbabel: Jeshua, Nehemiah, Seraiah, Reelaiah, Mordecai, Bilshan, Mizpar, Bigvai, Rehum, Baanah. The number of the men of the people of Israel:

Baanah The number <u>16_NEH_07_07</u> # Who came with Zerubbabel, Jeshua, Nehemiah, Azariah, Raamiah, Nahamani, Mordecai, Bilshan, Mispereth, Bigvai, Nehum, Baanah. The number, [I say], of the men of the people of Israel [was this];

Baanah the son <u>11_1KI_04_16</u># Baanah the son of Hushai [was] in Asher and in Aloth:

Baanah went and <u>10_2SA_04_05</u> # And the sons of Rimmon the Beerothite, Rechab and Baanah, went, and came about the heat of the day to the house of Ishbosheth, who lay on a bed at noon.

Baanah <u>16_NEH_10_27</u> # Malluch, Harim, Baanah.

Chenaanah and Zethan <u>13_1CH_07_10</u> # The sons also of Jediael; Bilhan: and the sons of Bilhan; Jeush, and Benjamin, and Ehud, and Chenaanah, and Zethan, and Tharshish, and Ahishahar.

Chenaanah came near <u>14_2CH_18_23</u># Then Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah came near, and smote Micaiah upon the cheek, and said, Which way went the Spirit of the LORD from me to speak unto thee?

Chenaanah had made <u>14_2CH_18_10</u> # And Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah had made him horns of iron, and said, Thus saith the LORD, With these thou shalt push Syria until they be consumed.

Elkanah and all <u>09_1SA_01_21</u># And the man Elkanah, and all his house, went up to offer unto the LORD the yearly sacrifice, and his vow.

Elkanah the son <u>13_1CH_06_35</u># The son of Zuph, the son of Elkanah, the son of Mahath, the son of Amasai,

Elkanah the son <u>13_1CH_06_36</u># The son of Elkanah, the son of Joel, the son of Azariah, the son of Zephaniah,

Elkanah the son <u>09_1SA_01_01</u># Now there was a certain man of Ramathaimzophim, of mount Ephraim, and his name [was] Elkanah, the son of Jeroham, the son of Elihu, the son of Tohu, the son of Zuph, an Ephrathite:

Elkanah the sons <u>13_1CH_06_26</u># [As for] Elkanah: the sons of Elkanah; Zophai his son, and Nahath his son,

Elkanah went to <u>09_1SA_02_11</u># And Elkanah went to Ramah to his house. And the child did minister unto the LORD before Eli the priest.

Jeshanah with the <u>14_2CH_13_19</u># And Abijah pursued after Jeroboam, and took cities from him, Bethel with the towns thereof, and Jeshanah with the towns thereof, and Ephrain with the towns thereof.

Kanah and the <u>06_JOS_16_08</u># The border went out from Tappuah westward unto the river Kanah; and the goings out thereof were at the sea. This [is] the inheritance of the tribe of the children of Ephraim by their families.

Kanah even unto <u>06_JOS_19_28</u> # And Hebron, and Rehob, and Hammon, and Kanah, [even] unto great Zidon;

Kanah southward of <u>06_JOS_17_09</u># And the coast descended unto the river Kanah, southward of the

river: these cities of Ephraim [are] among the cities of Manasseh: the coast of Manasseh also [was] on the north side of the river, and the outgoings of it were at the sea:

Lebanah the children <u>15_EZR_02_45</u> # The children of Lebanah, the children of Hagabah, the children of Akkub,

Manahath and Ebal <u>13 1CH_01_40</u># The sons of Shobal; Alian, and Manahath, and Ebal, Shephi, and Onam. And the sons of Zibeon; Aiah, and Anah.

Manahath and Ebal <u>01_GEN_36_23</u> # And the children of Shobal [were] these; Alvan, and Manahath, and Ebal, Shepho, and Onam.

Manahath <u>13_1CH_08_06</u> # And these [are] the sons of Ehud: these are the heads of the fathers of the inhabitants of Geba, and they removed them to Manahath:

Manahethites the Zorites <u>13_1CH_02_54</u># The sons of Salma; Bethlehem, and the Netophathites, Ataroth, the house of Joab, and half of the Manahethites, the Zorites.

Manahethites <u>13_1CH_02_52</u> # And Shobal the father of Kirjathjearim had sons; Haroeh, [and] half of the Manahethites.

Mattanah to Nahaliel <u>04_NUM_21_19</u># And from Mattanah to Nahaliel: and from Nahaliel to Bamoth:

Mattanah <u>04_NUM_21_18</u> # The princes digged the well, the nobles of the people digged it, by [the direction of] the lawgiver, with their staves. And from the wilderness [they went] to Mattanah:

Tirhanah <u>13_1CH_02_48</u> # Maachah, Caleb's concubine, bare Sheber, and Tirhanah.

Zartanah beneath Jezreel <u>11_1KI_04_12</u># Baana the son of Ahilud; [to him pertained] Taanach and Megiddo, and all Bethshean, which [is] by Zartanah beneath Jezreel, from Bethshean to Abelmeholah, [even] unto [the place that is] beyond Jokneam:
