Andrew and again 43_JOH_12_22 # Philip cometh and telleth Andrew: and again Andrew and Philip tell Jesus.

Andrew and Peter 43_JOH_01_44 # Now Philip was of Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter.

Andrew and Philip 43_JOH_12_22# Philip cometh and telleth Andrew: and again Andrew and Philip tell Jesus.

Andrew and Philip 41_MAR_03_18 # And Andrew, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the [son] of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus, and Simon the Canaanite,

Andrew asked him <u>41_MAR_13_03</u># And as he sat upon the mount of Olives over against the temple, Peter and James and John and Andrew asked him privately,

Andrew his brother <u>42_LUK_06_14</u> # Simon, [whom he also named Peter,] and Andrew his brother, James and John, Philip and Bartholomew,

Andrew his brother 41_MAR_01_16 # Now as he walked by the sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and Andrew his brother casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers.
