apes and peacocks 11 1KI 10 22 # For the king had at sea a navy of Tharshish with the navy of Hiram: once in three years came the navy of Tharshish, bringing gold, and silver, ivory, and apes, and peacocks.

apes and peacocks 14\_2CH\_09\_21 # For the king's ships went to Tarshish with the servants of Huram: every three years once came the ships of Tarshish bringing gold, and silver, ivory, and apes, and peacocks.

grapes against all <u>24\_JER\_25\_30</u> # Therefore prophesy thou against them all these words, and say unto them, The LORD shall roar from on high, and utter his voice from his holy habitation; he shall mightily roar upon his habitation; he shall give a shout, as they that tread [the grapes], against all the inhabitants of the earth.

grapes and figs <u>16\_NEH\_13\_15</u># In those days saw I in Judah [some] treading wine presses on the sabbath, and bringing in sheaves, and lading asses; as also wine, grapes, and figs, and all [manner of] burdens, which they brought into Jerusalem on the sabbath day: and I testified [against them] in the day wherein they sold victuals.

grapes if thieves 24\_JER\_49\_09 # If grapegatherers come to thee, would they not leave [some] gleaning grapes? if thieves by night, they will destroy till they have enough.

grapes in it <u>03\_LEV\_25\_11</u># A jubilee shall that fiftieth year be unto you: ye shall not sow, neither reap that which groweth of itself in it, nor gather [the grapes] in it of thy vine undressed.

grapes in the <u>28\_HOS\_09\_10</u># I found Israel like grapes in the wilderness; I saw your fathers as the firstripe in the fig tree at her first time: [but] they went to Baalpeor, and separated themselves unto [that] shame; and [their] abominations were according as they loved.

grapes nor eat <u>04\_NUM\_06\_03</u> # He shall separate [himself] from wine and strong drink, and shall drink no vinegar of wine, or vinegar of strong drink, neither shall he drink any liquor of grapes, nor eat moist grapes, or dried.

grapes which the 04\_NUM\_13\_24 # The place was called the brook Eshcol, because of the cluster of grapes

which the children of Israel cut down from thence.

grapes <u>01\_GEN\_40\_10</u># And in the vine [were] three branches: and it [was] as though it budded, [and] her blossoms shot forth; and the clusters thereof brought forth ripe grapes:

grapes <u>01\_GEN\_49\_11</u># Binding his foal unto the vine, and his ass's colt unto the choice vine; he washed his garments in wine, and his clothes in the blood of grapes:

shapes of the 66\_REV\_09\_07 # And the shapes of the locusts [were] like unto horses prepared unto battle; and on their heads [were] as it were crowns like gold, and their faces [were] as the faces of men.

tapestry her clothing <u>20\_PRO\_31\_22</u> # She maketh herself coverings of tapestry; her clothing [is] silk and purple.
