apiece after the [04_NUM_07_86](#) # The golden spoons [were] twelve, full of incense, [weighing] ten [shekels] apiece, after the shekel of the sanctuary: all the gold of the spoons [was] an hundred and twenty [shekels].

apiece and a [11_1KI_07_15](#) # For he cast two pillars of brass, of eighteen cubits high apiece: and a line of twelve cubits did compass either of them about.

apiece and every [26_EZE_10_21](#) # Every one had four faces apiece, and every one four wings; and the likeness of the hands of a man [was] under their wings.

apiece by the [04_NUM_03_47](#) # Thou shalt even take five shekels apiece by the poll, after the shekel of the sanctuary shalt thou take [them]: [the shekel [is] twenty gerahs:]
