apple of his <u>05_DEU_32_10</u># He found him in a desert land, and in the waste howling wilderness; he led him about, he instructed him, he kept him as the apple of his eye.

apple of his <u>38_ZEC_02_08</u># For thus saith the LORD of hosts; After the glory hath he sent me unto the nations which spoiled you: for he that toucheth you toucheth the apple of his eye.

apple of the <u>19_PSA_17_08</u># Keep me as the apple of the eye, hide me under the shadow of thy wings,

apple of thine <u>25_LAM_02_18</u> # Their heart cried unto the Lord, O wall of the daughter of Zion, let tears run down like a river day and night: give thyself no rest; let not the apple of thine eye cease.
