Pharaoh is become <u>23_ISA_19_11</u># Surely the princes of Zoan [are] fools, the counsel of the wise counsellors of Pharaoh is become brutish: how say ye unto Pharaoh, I [am] the son of the wise, the son of ancient kings?

Pharaoh is one <u>01_GEN_41_25</u># And Joseph said unto Pharaoh, The dream of Pharaoh [is] one: God hath showed Pharaoh what he [is] about to do.

Pharaoh king of <u>11_1KI_03_01</u># And Solomon made affinity with Pharaoh king of Egypt, and took Pharaoh's daughter, and brought her into the city of David, until he had made an end of building his own house, and the house of the LORD, and the wall of Jerusalem round about.

Pharaoh king of 11 1KI 09 16 [For] Pharaoh king of Egypt had gone up, and taken Gezer, and burnt it with fire, and slain the Canaanites that dwelt in the city, and given it [for] a present unto his daughter, Solomon's wife.

Pharaoh king of 11 1KI 11 18 And they arose out of Midian, and came to Paran: and they took men with them out of Paran, and they came to Egypt, unto Pharaoh king of Egypt; which gave him an house, and appointed him victuals, and gave him land.

Pharaoh king of 12 2KI 17 07 # For [so] it was, that the children of Israel had sinned against the LORD their God, which had brought them up out of the land of Egypt, from under the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and had feared other gods,

Pharaoh king of <u>12_2KI_18_21</u> # Now, behold, thou trustest upon the staff of this bruised reed, [even] upon Egypt, on which if a man lean, it will go into his hand, and pierce it: so [is] Pharaoh king of Egypt unto all that trust on him.

Pharaoh king of 44_ACT_07_10 # And delivered him out of all his afflictions, and gave him favour and wisdom in the sight of Pharaoh king of Egypt; and he made him governor over Egypt and all his house.

Pharaoh king of <u>05_DEU_07_08</u># But because the LORD loved you, and because he would keep the oath which he had sworn unto your fathers, hath the LORD brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of bondmen, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.

Pharaoh king of <u>02_EXO_06_11</u># Go in, speak unto Pharaoh king of Egypt, that he let the children of Israel go out of his land.

Pharaoh king of <u>02_EXO_06_13</u># And the LORD spake unto Moses and unto Aaron, and gave them a charge unto the children of Israel, and unto Pharaoh king of Egypt, to bring the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh king of 02_EXO_06_27 # These [are] they which spake to Pharaoh king of Egypt, to bring out the

children of Israel from Egypt: these [are] that Moses and Aaron.

Pharaoh king of <u>02_EXO_06_29</u> # That the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, I [am] the LORD: speak thou unto Pharaoh king of Egypt all that I say unto thee.

Pharaoh king of <u>02_EXO_14_08</u># And the LORD hardened the heart of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and he pursued after the children of Israel: and the children of Israel went out with an high hand.

Pharaoh king of <u>26_EZE_29_02</u> # Son of man, set thy face against Pharaoh king of Egypt, and prophesy against him, and against all Egypt:

Pharaoh king of <u>26_EZE_29_03</u># Speak, and say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I [am] against thee, Pharaoh king of Egypt, the great dragon that lieth in the midst of his rivers, which hath said, My river [is] mine own, and I have made [it] for myself.

Pharaoh king of <u>26_EZE_30_21</u> # Son of man, I have broken the arm of Pharaoh king of Egypt; and, lo, it shall not be bound up to be healed, to put a roller to bind it, to make it strong to hold the sword.

Pharaoh king of <u>26_EZE_30_22</u> # Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I [am] against Pharaoh king of Egypt, and will break his arms, the strong, and that which was broken; and I will cause the sword to fall out of his hand.

Pharaoh king of <u>26_EZE_31_02</u># Son of man, speak unto Pharaoh king of Egypt, and to his multitude; Whom art thou like in thy greatness?

Pharaoh king of <u>26_EZE_32_02</u> # Son of man, take up a lamentation for Pharaoh king of Egypt, and say unto him, Thou art like a young lion of the nations, and thou [art] as a whale in the seas: and thou camest forth with thy rivers, and troubledst the waters with thy feet, and fouledst their rivers.

Pharaoh king of <u>01_GEN_41_46</u># And Joseph [was] thirty years old when he stood before Pharaoh king of Egypt. And Joseph went out from the presence of Pharaoh, and went throughout all the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh king of 23_ISA_36_06 # Lo, thou trustest in the staff of this broken reed, on Egypt; whereon if a man lean, it will go into his hand, and pierce it: so [is] Pharaoh king of Egypt to all that trust in him.

Pharaoh king of <u>24_JER_25_19</u> # Pharaoh king of Egypt, and his servants, and his princes, and all his people;

Pharaoh king of 24_JER_46_17 # They did cry there, Pharaoh king of Egypt [is but] a noise; he hath passed the time appointed.

Pharaoh Let me 11_1KI_11_21# And when Hadad heard in Egypt that David slept with his fathers, and that Joab the captain of the host was dead, Hadad said to Pharaoh, Let me depart, that I may go to mine own country.

Pharaoh lift up <u>01_GEN_40_13</u># Yet within three days shall Pharaoh lift up thine head, and restore thee unto thy place: and thou shalt deliver Pharaoh's cup into his hand, after the former manner when thou wast his butler.

Pharaoh lift up <u>01_GEN_40_19</u> # Yet within three days shall Pharaoh lift up thy head from off thee, and shall hang thee on a tree; and the birds shall eat thy flesh from off thee.

Pharaoh lo he <u>02_EXO_08_20</u> # And the LORD said unto Moses, Rise up early in the morning, and stand before Pharaoh; lo, he cometh forth to the water; and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Let my people go, that they may serve me.

Pharaoh lo here <u>01_GEN_47_23</u> # Then Joseph said unto the people, Behold, I have bought you this day and your land for Pharaoh: lo, [here is] seed for you, and ye shall sow the land.

Pharaoh look out <u>01_GEN_41_33</u> # Now therefore let Pharaoh look out a man discreet and wise, and set him over the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh made his <u>02_EXO_09_20</u> # He that feared the word of the LORD among the servants of Pharaoh made his servants and his cattle flee into the houses:

Pharaoh out of 14_2CH_08_11 # And Solomon brought up the daughter of Pharaoh out of the city of David unto the house that he had built for her: for he said, My wife shall not dwell in the house of David king of Israel, because [the places are] holy, whereunto the ark of the LORD hath come.

Pharaoh rose up <u>02_EXO_12_30</u> # And Pharaoh rose up in the night, he, and all his servants, and all the Egyptians; and there was a great cry in Egypt; for [there was] not a house where [there was] not one dead.

Pharaoh said Behold <u>02_EXO_05_05</u># And Pharaoh said, Behold, the people of the land now [are] many, and ye make them rest from their burdens.

Pharaoh said Go <u>01_GEN_50_06</u># And Pharaoh said, Go up, and bury thy father, according as he made thee swear.

Pharaoh said I <u>02_EXO_08_28</u> # And Pharaoh said, I will let you go, that ye may sacrifice to the LORD your God in the wilderness; only ye shall not go very far away: entreat for me.

Pharaoh said unto 11_1KI_11_22# Then Pharaoh said unto him, But what hast thou lacked with me, that, behold, thou seekest to go to thine own country? And he answered, Nothing: howbeit let me go in any wise.

Pharaoh said unto <u>02_EXO_10_28</u># And Pharaoh said unto him, Get thee from me, take heed to thyself, see my face no more; for in [that] day thou seest my face thou shalt die.

Pharaoh said unto <u>01_GEN_41_15</u># And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, I have dreamed a dream, and [there is] none that can interpret it: and I have heard say of thee, [that] thou canst understand a dream to interpret it.

Pharaoh said unto <u>01_GEN_41_17</u># And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, In my dream, behold, I stood upon the bank of the river:

Pharaoh said unto <u>01_GEN_41_38</u> # And Pharaoh said unto his servants, Can we find [such a one] as this [is], a man in whom the Spirit of God [is]?

Pharaoh said unto <u>01_GEN_41_39</u> # And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, Forasmuch as God hath showed thee all this, [there is] none so discreet and wise as thou [art]:

Pharaoh said unto <u>01_GEN_41_41</u> # And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, See, I have set thee over all the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh said unto <u>01_GEN_41_44</u> # And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, I [am] Pharaoh, and without thee shall no man lift up his hand or foot in all the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh said unto <u>01_GEN_41_55</u># And when all the land of Egypt was famished, the people cried to Pharaoh for bread: and Pharaoh said unto all the Egyptians, Go unto Joseph; what he saith to you, do.

Pharaoh said unto 01_GEN_45_17 # And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, Say unto thy brethren, This do ye;

lade your beasts, and go, get you unto the land of Canaan;

Pharaoh said unto <u>01_GEN_47_03</u># And Pharaoh said unto his brethren, What [is] your occupation? And they said unto Pharaoh, Thy servants [are] shepherds, both we, [and] also our fathers.

Pharaoh said unto 01_GEN_47_08 # And Pharaoh said unto Jacob, How old [art] thou?

Pharaoh said Who <u>02_EXO_05_02</u> # And Pharaoh said, Who [is] the LORD, that I should obey his voice to let Israel go? I know not the LORD, neither will I let Israel go.

Pharaoh saw her <u>01_GEN_12_15</u># The princes also of Pharaoh saw her, and commended her before Pharaoh: and the woman was taken into Pharaoh's house.

Pharaoh saw that <u>02_EXO_08_15</u> # But when Pharaoh saw that there was respite, he hardened his heart, and hearkened not unto them; as the LORD had said.

Pharaoh saw that <u>02_EXO_09_34</u> # And when Pharaoh saw that the rain and the hail and the thunders were ceased, he sinned yet more, and hardened his heart, he and his servants.

Pharaoh saying I <u>01_GEN_41_09</u># Then spake the chief butler unto Pharaoh, saying, I do remember my faults this day:

Pharaoh saying If <u>01_GEN_50_04</u> # And when the days of his mourning were past, Joseph spake unto the house of Pharaoh, saying, If now I have found grace in your eyes, speak, I pray you, in the ears of Pharaoh, saying,

Pharaoh saying It <u>01_GEN_41_16</u># And Joseph answered Pharaoh, saying, [It is] not in me: God shall give Pharaoh an answer of peace.

Pharaoh saying Wherefore <u>02_EXO_05_15</u># Then the officers of the children of Israel came and cried unto Pharaoh, saying, Wherefore dealest thou thus with thy servants?

Pharaoh saying <u>01_GEN_50_04</u> # And when the days of his mourning were past, Joseph spake unto the house of Pharaoh, saying, If now I have found grace in your eyes, speak, I pray you, in the ears of Pharaoh, saying,

Pharaoh sent and <u>02_EXO_09_07</u># And Pharaoh sent, and, behold, there was not one of the cattle of the Israelites dead. And the heart of Pharaoh was hardened, and he did not let the people go.

Pharaoh sent and <u>02_EXO_09_27</u> # And Pharaoh sent, and called for Moses and Aaron, and said unto them, I have sinned this time: the LORD [is] righteous, and I and my people [are] wicked.

Pharaoh sent and <u>01_GEN_41_14</u># Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph, and they brought him hastily out of the dungeon: and he shaved [himself], and changed his raiment, and came in unto Pharaoh.

Pharaoh shall call <u>01_GEN_46_33</u> # And it shall come to pass, when Pharaoh shall call you, and shall say, What [is] your occupation?

Pharaoh shall fall <u>26_EZE_30_25</u> # But I will strengthen the arms of the king of Babylon, and the arms of Pharaoh shall fall down; and they shall know that I [am] the LORD, when I shall put my sword into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall stretch it out upon the land of Egypt.

Pharaoh smote Gaza <u>24_JER_47_01</u> # The word of the LORD that came to Jeremiah the prophet against the Philistines, before that Pharaoh smote Gaza.

Pharaoh so that 11_1KI_11_19# And Hadad found great favour in the sight of Pharaoh, so that he gave him to wife the sister of his own wife, the sister of Tahpenes the queen.

Pharaoh spake unto <u>01_GEN_47_05</u># And Pharaoh spake unto Joseph, saying, Thy father and thy brethren are come unto thee:

Pharaoh surely ye <u>01_GEN_42_16</u> # Send one of you, and let him fetch your brother, and ye shall be kept in prison, that your words may be proved, whether [there be any] truth in you: or else by the life of Pharaoh surely ye [are] spies.

Pharaoh that came <u>02_EXO_14_28</u># And the waters returned, and covered the chariots, and the horsemen, [and] all the host of Pharaoh that came into the sea after them; there remained not so much as one of them.

Pharaoh that he <u>02_EXO_07_02</u># Thou shalt speak all that I command thee: and Aaron thy brother shall speak unto Pharaoh, that he send the children of Israel out of his land.

Pharaoh that sat <u>02_EXO_12_29</u> # And it came to pass, that at midnight the LORD smote all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sat on his throne unto the firstborn of the captive that [was] in the dungeon; and all the firstborn of cattle.

Pharaoh that sitteth <u>02_EXO_11_05</u># And all the firstborn in the land of Egypt shall die, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sitteth upon his throne, even unto the firstborn of the maidservant that [is] behind the mill; and all the firstborn of beasts.

Pharaoh that thou <u>02_EXO_03_10</u># Come now therefore, and I will send thee unto Pharaoh, that thou mayest bring forth my people the children of Israel out of Egypt.

Pharaoh Thus saith <u>02_EXO_04_22</u> # And thou shalt say unto Pharaoh, Thus saith the LORD, Israel [is] my son, [even] my firstborn:

Pharaoh Thus saith <u>02_EXO_05_01</u># And afterward Moses and Aaron went in, and told Pharaoh, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Let my people go, that they may hold a feast unto me in the wilderness.

Pharaoh Thy servants <u>01_GEN_47_03</u> # And Pharaoh said unto his brethren, What [is] your occupation? And they said unto Pharaoh, Thy servants [are] shepherds, both we, [and] also our fathers.

Pharaoh to speak <u>02_EXO_05_23</u> # For since I came to Pharaoh to speak in thy name, he hath done evil to this people; neither hast thou delivered thy people at all.

Pharaoh was hardened <u>02_EXO_09_07</u># And Pharaoh sent, and, behold, there was not one of the cattle of the Israelites dead. And the heart of Pharaoh was hardened, and he did not let the people go.

Pharaoh was hardened <u>02_EXO_09_35</u> # And the heart of Pharaoh was hardened, neither would he let the children of Israel go; as the LORD had spoken by Moses.

Pharaoh was wroth <u>01_GEN_40_02</u> # And Pharaoh was wroth against two [of] his officers, against the chief of the butlers, and against the chief of the bakers.

Pharaoh was wroth <u>01_GEN_41_10</u># Pharaoh was wroth with his servants, and put me in ward in the captain of the guard's house, [both] me and the chief baker:

Pharaoh well and <u>01_GEN_45_16</u># And the fame thereof was heard in Pharaoh's house, saying, Joseph's brethren are come: and it pleased Pharaoh well, and his servants.

Pharaoh went in <u>02_EXO_15_19</u># For the horse of Pharaoh went in with his chariots and with his horsemen into the sea, and the LORD brought again the waters of the sea upon them; but the children of Israel went on dry [land] in the midst of the sea.

Pharaoh What God <u>01_GEN_41_28</u> # This [is] the thing which I have spoken unto Pharaoh: What God [is] about to do he showeth unto Pharaoh.

Pharaoh what he <u>01_GEN_41_25</u> # And Joseph said unto Pharaoh, The dream of Pharaoh [is] one: God hath showed Pharaoh what he [is] about to do.

Pharaoh which I <u>02 EXO 04 21 # And the LORD said unto Moses</u>, When thou goest to return into Egypt, see that thou do all those wonders before Pharaoh, which I have put in thine hand: but I will harden his heart, that he shall not let the people go.

Pharaoh which Mered <u>13_1CH_04_18</u> # And his wife Jehudijah bare Jered the father of Gedor, and Heber the father of Socho, and Jekuthiel the father of Zanoah. And these [are] the sons of Bithiah the daughter of Pharaoh, which Mered took.

Pharaoh who hath <u>02_EXO_18_10</u># And Jethro said, Blessed [be] the LORD, who hath delivered you out of the hand of the Egyptians, and out of the hand of Pharaoh, who hath delivered the people from under the hand of the Egyptians.

Pharaoh will say <u>02_EXO_14_03</u> # For Pharaoh will say of the children of Israel, They [are] entangled in the land, the wilderness hath shut them in.

Pharaoh with his <u>26_EZE_17_17</u> # Neither shall Pharaoh with [his] mighty army and great company make for him in the war, by casting up mounts, and building forts, to cut off many persons:

Pharaoh women of <u>11_1KI_11_01</u># But king Solomon loved many strange women, together with the daughter of Pharaoh, women of the Moabites, Ammonites, Edomites, Zidonians, [and] Hittites;

Pharaoh would hardly <u>02_EXO_13_15</u># And it came to pass, when Pharaoh would hardly let us go, that the LORD slew all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both the firstborn of man, and the firstborn of beast: therefore I sacrifice to the LORD all that openeth the matrix, being males; but all the firstborn of my children I redeem.

Pharaoh ye shall <u>01_GEN_42_15</u># Hereby ye shall be proved: By the life of Pharaoh ye shall not go forth hence, except your youngest brother come hither.

Pharaoh <u>11_1KI_11_20</u># And the sister of Tahpenes bare him Genubath his son, whom Tahpenes weaned in Pharaoh's house: and Genubath was in Pharaoh's household among the sons of Pharaoh.

Pharaoh <u>44_ACT_07_13</u> # And at the second [time] Joseph was made known to his brethren; and Joseph's kindred was made known unto Pharaoh.

Pharaoh <u>02_EXO_05_20</u> # And they met Moses and Aaron, who stood in the way, as they came forth from Pharaoh:

Pharaoh <u>02_EXO_07_07</u> # And Moses [was] fourscore years old, and Aaron fourscore and three years old, when they spake unto Pharaoh.

Pharaoh's army was <u>24_JER_37_05</u> # Then Pharaoh's army was come forth out of Egypt: and when the Chaldeans that besieged Jerusalem heard tidings of them, they departed from Jerusalem.

separate place and <u>26_EZE_42_10</u> # The chambers [were] in the thickness of the wall of the court toward the east, over against the separate place, and over against the building.

separate place at <u>26_EZE_41_12</u># Now the building that [was] before the separate place at the end toward the west [was] seventy cubits broad; and the wall of the building [was] five cubits thick round about, and the length thereof ninety cubits.

separated I and <u>02_EXO_33_16</u># For wherein shall it be known here that I and thy people have found grace in thy sight? [is it] not in that thou goest with us? so shall we be separated, I and thy people, from all the people that [are] upon the face of the earth.

separated me from <u>48_GAL_01_15</u># But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called [me] by his grace,

separated me from <u>23_ISA_56_03</u># Neither let the son of the stranger, that hath joined himself to the LORD, speak, saying, The LORD hath utterly separated me from his people: neither let the eunuch say, Behold, I [am] a dry tree.

separated that he <u>13_1CH_23_13</u> # The sons of Amram; Aaron and Moses: and Aaron was separated, that he should sanctify the most holy things, he and his sons for ever, to burn incense before the LORD, to minister unto him, and to bless in his name for ever.

separated the disciples <u>44_ACT_19_09</u># But when divers were hardened, and believed not, but spake evil of that way before the multitude, he departed from them, and separated the disciples, disputing daily in the school of one Tyrannus.

separated the sons <u>05_DEU_32_08</u># When the Most High divided to the nations their inheritance, when he separated the sons of Adam, he set the bounds of the people according to the number of the children of Israel.

separated upon the <u>16_NEH_04_19</u> # And I said unto the nobles, and to the rulers, and to the rest of the people, The work [is] great and large, and we are separated upon the wall, one far from another.

separated with whores 28_HOS_04_14 # I will not punish your daughters when they commit whoredom,

nor your spouses when they commit adultery: for themselves are separated with whores, and they sacrifice with harlots: therefore the people [that] doth not understand shall fall.

separated you from <u>03_LEV_20_24</u> # But I have said unto you, Ye shall inherit their land, and I will give it unto you to possess it, a land that floweth with milk and honey: I [am] the LORD your God, which have separated you from [other] people.

separateth himself from <u>26_EZE_14_07</u> # For every one of the house of Israel, or of the stranger that sojourneth in Israel, which separateth himself from me, and setteth up his idols in his heart, and putteth the stumblingblock of his iniquity before his face, and cometh to a prophet to inquire of him concerning me; I the LORD will answer him by myself:

separation and shall <u>04_NUM_06_12</u># And he shall consecrate unto the LORD the days of his separation, and shall bring a lamb of the first year for a trespass offering: but the days that were before shall be lost, because his separation was defiled.

separation and she <u>03_LEV_12_05</u># But if she bear a maid child, then she shall be unclean two weeks, as in her separation: and she shall continue in the blood of her purifying threescore and six days.

separation and whatsoever <u>03_LEV_15_26</u># Every bed whereon she lieth all the days of her issue shall be unto her as the bed of her separation: and whatsoever she sitteth upon shall be unclean, as the uncleanness of her separation.

separation are fulfilled <u>04_NUM_06_13</u> # And this [is] the law of the Nazarite, when the days of his separation are fulfilled: he shall be brought unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation:

separation she shall <u>03_LEV_15_25</u># And if a woman have an issue of her blood many days out of the time of her separation, or if it run beyond the time of her separation; all the days of the issue of her uncleanness shall be as the days of her separation: she [shall be] unclean.

separation there shall <u>04_NUM_06_05</u># All the days of the vow of his separation there shall no razor come upon his head: until the days be fulfilled, in the which he separateth [himself] unto the LORD, he shall be holy, [and] shall let the locks of the hair of his head grow.

Sepharad shall possess <u>31_OBA_01_20</u># And the captivity of this host of the children of Israel [shall possess] that of the Canaanites, [even] unto Zarephath; and the captivity of Jerusalem, which [is] in Sepharad, shall possess the cities of the south.

Shaaraim even unto <u>09_1SA_17_52</u># And the men of Israel and of Judah arose, and shouted, and pursued the Philistines, until thou come to the valley, and to the gates of Ekron. And the wounded of the Philistines fell down by the way to Shaaraim, even unto Gath, and unto Ekron.

Shaaraim These were <u>13_1CH_04_31</u> # And at Bethmarcaboth, and Hazarsusim, and at Bethbirei, and at Shaaraim. These [were] their cities unto the reign of David.

Shaharaim begat children <u>13_1CH_08_08</u> # And Shaharaim begat [children] in the country of Moab, after he had sent them away; Hushim and Baara [were] his wives.

Sharai 15_EZR_10_40 # Machnadebai, Shashai, Sharai,

Sharaim and Adithaim <u>06_JOS_15_36</u># And Sharaim, and Adithaim, and Gederah, and Gederothaim; fourteen cities with their villages:

Sharar the Hararite 10_2SA_23_33 # Shammah the Hararite, Ahiam the son of Sharar the Hararite,

Tarah and pitched 04_NUM_33_28 # And they removed from Tarah, and pitched in Mithcah.

Tarah 04 NUM 33 27 # And they departed from Tahath, and pitched at Tarah.

Taralah 06_JOS_18_27_# And Rekem, and Irpeel, and Taralah,

Thara which was 42_LUK_03_34 # Which was [the son] of Jacob, which was [the son] of Isaac, which was [the son] of Abraham, which was [the son] of Thara, which was [the son] of Nachor,

Zara of Thamar <u>40_MAT_01_03</u># And Judas begat Phares and Zara of Thamar; and Phares begat Esrom; and Esrom begat Aram;

Zarah but Er <u>01_GEN_46_12</u> # And the sons of Judah; Er, and Onan, and Shelah, and Pharez, and Zarah: but Er and Onan died in the land of Canaan. And the sons of Pharez were Hezron and Hamul.

Zarah <u>01_GEN_38_30</u> # And afterward came out his brother, that had the scarlet thread upon his hand: and his name was called Zarah.

Zemaraim and Bethel 06_JOS_18_22 # And Betharabah, and Zemaraim, and Bethel,

Zemaraim which is <u>14_2CH_13_04</u># And Abijah stood up upon mount Zemaraim, which [is] in mount Ephraim, and said, Hear me, thou Jeroboam, and all Israel;
