Asahel and Asahel [10 2SA 02 18](#) # And there were three sons of Zeruiah there, Joab, and Abishai, and Asahel: and Asahel [was as] light of foot as a wild roe.

Asahel and buried [10 2SA 02 32](#) # And they took up Asahel, and buried him in the sepulchre of his father, which [was in] Bethlehem. And Joab and his men went all night, and they came to Hebron at break of day.

Asahel And he [10 2SA 02 20](#) # Then Abner looked behind him, and said, [Art] thou Asahel? And he answered, I [am].

Asahel and Jahaziah [15 EZR 10 15](#) # Only Jonathan the son of Asahel and Jahaziah the son of Tikvah were employed about this [matter]: and Meshullam and Shabbethai the Levite helped them.

Asahel and Jerimoth [14 2CH 31 13](#) # And Jehiel, and Azaziah, and Nahath, and Asahel, and Jerimoth, and Jozabad, and Eliel, and Ismachiah, and Mahath, and Benaiah, [were] overseers under the hand of Cononiah and Shimei his brother, at the commandment of Hezekiah the king, and Azariah the ruler of the house of God.

Asahel and Shemiramoth [14 2CH 17 08](#) # And with them [he sent] Levites, [even] Shemaiah, and Nethaniah, and Zebadiah, and Asahel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehonathan, and Adonijah, and Tobijah, and Tobadonijah, Levites; and with them Elishama and Jehoram, priests.

Asahel at Gibeon [10 2SA 03 30](#) # So Joab and Abishai his brother slew Abner, because he had slain their brother Asahel at Gibeon in the battle.

Asahel fell down [10 2SA 02 23](#) # Howbeit he refused to turn aside: wherefore Abner with the hinder end of the spear smote him under the fifth [rib], that the spear came out behind him; and he fell down there, and died in the same place: and it came to pass, [that] as many as came to the place where Asahel fell down and died stood still.

Asahel his brother [10 2SA 03 27](#) # And when Abner was returned to Hebron, Joab took him aside in the gate to speak with him quietly, and smote him there under the fifth [rib], that he died, for the blood of Asahel his brother.

Asahel pursued after [10 2SA 02 19](#) # And Asahel pursued after Abner; and in going he turned not to the right hand nor to the left from following Abner.

Asahel the brother [13 1CH 11 26](#) # Also the valiant men of the armies [were], Asahel the brother of Joab, Elhanan the son of Dodo of Bethlehem,

Asahel the brother [13 1CH 27 07](#) # The fourth [captain] for the fourth month [was] Asahel the brother of Joab, and Zebadiah his son after him: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

Asahel the brother [10 2SA 23 24](#) # Asahel the brother of Joab [was] one of the thirty; Elhanan the son of Dodo of Bethlehem,

Asahel three [13 1CH 02 16](#) # Whose sisters [were] Zeruiah, and Abigail. And the sons of Zeruiah; Abishai, and Joab, and Asahel, three.

Asahel Turn thee [10 2SA 02 22](#) # And Abner said again to Asahel, Turn thee aside from following me: wherefore should I smite thee to the ground? how then should I hold up my face to Joab thy brother?
