Asher according to <u>06_JOS_19_24</u># And the fifth lot came out for the tribe of the children of Asher according to their families.

Asher according to <u>06_JOS_19_31</u> # This [is] the inheritance of the tribe of the children of Asher according to their families, these cities with their villages.

Asher according to <u>04_NUM_26_47</u> # These [are] the families of the sons of Asher according to those that were numbered of them; [who were] fifty and three thousand and four hundred.

Asher after their <u>04_NUM_26_44</u> # [Of] the children of Asher after their families: of Jimna, the family of the Jimnites: of Jesui, the family of the Jesuites: of Beriah, the family of the Beriites.

Asher Ahihud the <u>04_NUM_34_27</u> # And the prince of the tribe of the children of Asher, Ahihud the son of Shelomi.

Asher and in <u>11_1KI_04_16</u># Baanah the son of Hushai [was] in Asher and in Aloth:

Asher and Manasseh <u>14_2CH_30_11</u> # Nevertheless divers of Asher and Manasseh and of Zebulun humbled themselves, and came to Jerusalem.

Asher and out <u>13_1CH_06_62</u># And to the sons of Gershom throughout their families out of the tribe of Issachar, and out of the tribe of Asher, and out of the tribe of Naphtali, and out of the tribe of Manasseh in Bashan, thirteen cities.

Asher and out <u>06_JOS_21_06</u> # And the children of Gershon [had] by lot out of the families of the tribe of Issachar, and out of the tribe of Asher, and out of the tribe of Naphtali, and out of the half tribe of Manasseh in Bashan, thirteen cities.

Asher and out <u>07_JUD_07_23</u># And the men of Israel gathered themselves together out of Naphtali, and out of Asher, and out of all Manasseh, and pursued after the Midianites.

Asher Mashal with <u>13_1CH_06_74</u># And out of the tribe of Asher; Mashal with her suburbs, and Abdon with her suburbs,

Asher Mishal with <u>06_JOS_21_30</u># And out of the tribe of Asher, Mishal with her suburbs, Abdon with her suburbs,

Asher offered <u>04_NUM_07_72</u># On the eleventh day Pagiel the son of Ocran, prince of the children of Asher, [offered]:

Asher <u>13_1CH_02_02</u> # Dan, Joseph, and Benjamin, Naphtali, Gad, and Asher.

Asher <u>02_EXO_01_04</u> # Dan, and Naphtali, Gad, and Asher.

Asher <u>26_EZE_48_02</u># And by the border of Dan, from the east side unto the west side, a [portion for] Asher.

Asher <u>01_GEN_30_13</u># And Leah said, Happy am I, for the daughters will call me blessed: and she called his name Asher.

Asherites dwelt among <u>07_JUD_01_32</u> # But the Asherites dwelt among the Canaanites, the inhabitants of the land: for they did not drive them out.
