astray and hide [05 DEU 22 01](#) # Thou shalt not see thy brother's ox or his sheep go astray, and hide thyself from them: thou shalt in any case bring them again unto thy brother.

astray as soon [19 PSA 58 03](#) # The wicked are estranged from the womb: they go astray as soon as they be born, speaking lies.

astray as the [26 EZE 48 11](#) # [It shall be] for the priests that are sanctified of the sons of Zadok; which have kept my charge, which went not astray when the children of Israel went astray, as the Levites went astray.

astray away from [26 EZE 44 10](#) # And the Levites that are gone away far from me, when Israel went astray, which went astray away from me after their idols; they shall even bear their iniquity.

astray but are [60 1PE 02 25](#) # For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls.

astray but now [19 PSA 119 67](#) # Before I was afflicted I went astray: but now have I kept thy word.

astray doth he [40 MAT 18 12](#) # How think ye? if a man have an hundred sheep, and one of them be gone astray, doth he not leave the ninety and nine, and goeth into the mountains, and seeketh that which is gone astray?

astray following the [61 2PE 02 15](#) # Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following the way of Balaam [the son] of Bosor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness;

astray from me [26 EZE 14 11](#) # That the house of Israel may go no more astray from me, neither be polluted any more with all their transgressions; but that they may be my people, and I may be their God, saith the Lord GOD.

astray from me [26 EZE 44 15](#) # But the priests the Levites, the sons of Zadok, that kept the charge of my sanctuary when the children of Israel went astray from me, they shall come near to me to minister unto me, and they shall stand before me to offer unto me the fat and the blood, saith the Lord GOD:

astray in an [20 PRO 28 10](#) # Whoso causeth the righteous to go astray in an evil way, he shall fall himself into his own pit: but the upright shall have good [things] in possession.

astray in her [20 PRO 07 25](#) # Let not thine heart decline to her ways, go not astray in her paths.

astray like a [19 PSA 119 176](#) # I have gone astray like a lost sheep; seek thy servant; for I do not forget thy commandments.

astray they have [24 JER 50 06](#) # My people hath been lost sheep: their shepherds have caused them to go astray, they have turned them away [on] the mountains: they have gone from mountain to hill, they have forgotten their restingplace.

astray thou shalt [02 EXO 23 04](#) # If thou meet thine enemy's ox or his ass going astray, thou shalt surely bring it back to him again.

astray we have [23 ISA 53 06](#) # All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.
