audience and hear <u>09\_1SA\_25\_24</u> # And fell at his feet, and said, Upon me, my lord, [upon] me [let this] iniquity [be]: and let thine handmaid, I pray thee, speak in thine audience, and hear the words of thine handmaid.

audience of all <u>42\_LUK\_20\_45</u> # Then in the audience of all the people he said unto his disciples,

audience of our <u>13\_1CH\_28\_08</u> # Now therefore in the sight of all Israel the congregation of the LORD, and in the audience of our God, keep and seek for all the commandments of the LORD your God: that ye may possess this good land, and leave [it] for an inheritance for your children after you for ever.

audience of the <u>02\_EXO\_24\_07</u> # And he took the book of the covenant, and read in the audience of the people: and they said, All that the LORD hath said will we do, and be obedient.

audience of the <u>01\_GEN\_23\_10</u># And Ephron dwelt among the children of Heth: and Ephron the Hittite answered Abraham in the audience of the children of Heth, [even] of all that went in at the gate of his city, saying,

audience of the <u>01\_GEN\_23\_13</u> # And he spake unto Ephron in the audience of the people of the land, saying, But if thou [wilt give it], I pray thee, hear me: I will give thee money for the field; take [it] of me, and I will bury my dead there.

audience of the <u>01\_GEN\_23\_16</u># And Abraham hearkened unto Ephron; and Abraham weighed to Ephron the silver, which he had named in the audience of the sons of Heth, four hundred shekels of silver, current [money] with the merchant.

audience of the <u>42\_LUK\_07\_01</u> # Now when he had ended all his sayings in the audience of the people, he entered into Capernaum.

audience of the <u>16\_NEH\_13\_01</u> # On that day they read in the book of Moses in the audience of the people; and therein was found written, that the Ammonite and the Moabite should not come into the congregation of God for ever;

audience to Barnabas <u>44\_ACT\_15\_12</u> # Then all the multitude kept silence, and gave audience to Barnabas and Paul, declaring what miracles and wonders God had wrought among the Gentiles by them.

audience unto this <u>44\_ACT\_22\_22</u> # And they gave him audience unto this word, and [then] lifted up their voices, and said, Away with such a [fellow] from the earth: for it is not fit that he should live.

audience <u>44\_ACT\_13\_16</u># Then Paul stood up, and beckoning with [his] hand said, Men of Israel, and ye that fear God, give audience.
