Abigail and she [09 ISA 25 03](#) # Now the name of the man [was] Nabal; and the name of his wife Abigail; and [she was] a woman of good understanding, and of a beautiful countenance; but the man [was] churlish and evil in his doings; and he [was] of the house of Caleb.

Abigail And the [13 1CH 02 16](#) # Whose sisters [were] Zeruah, and Abigail. And the sons of Zeruah; Abishai, and Joab, and Asahel, three.

Abigail bare Amasa [13 1CH 02 17](#) # And Abigail bare Amasa; and the father of Amasa [was] Jether the Ishmeelite.

Abigail Blessed be [09 ISA 25 32](#) # And David said to Abigail, Blessed [be] the LORD God of Israel, which sent thee this day to meet me:

Abigail came to [09 ISA 25 36](#) # And Abigail came to Nabal; and, behold, he held a feast in his house, like the feast of a king; and Nabal's heart [was] merry within him, for he [was] very drunken: wherefore she told him nothing, less or more, until the morning light.

Abigail hasted and [09 ISA 25 42](#) # And Abigail hasted, and arose, and rode upon an ass, with five damsels of hers that went after her; and she went after the messengers of David, and became his wife.

Abigail made haste [09 ISA 25 18](#) # Then Abigail made haste, and took two hundred loaves, and two bottles of wine, and five sheep ready dressed, and five measures of parched [corn], and an hundred clusters of raisins, and two hundred cakes of figs, and laid [them] on asses.

Abigail Nabal's wife [09 ISA 25 14](#) # But one of the young men told Abigail, Nabal's wife, saying, Behold, David sent messengers out of the wilderness to salute our master; and he railed on them.

Abigail Nabal's wife [10 2SA 02 02](#) # So David went up thither, and his two wives also, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail Nabal's wife the Carmelite.

Abigail saw David [09 ISA 25 23](#) # And when Abigail saw David, she hasted, and lighted off the ass, and fell before David on her face, and bowed herself to the ground,

Abigail the Carmelitess [13 1CH 03 01](#) # Now these were the sons of David, which were born unto him in Hebron; the firstborn Amnon, of Ahinoam the Jezreelitess; the second Daniel, of Abigail the Carmelitess:

Abigail the Carmelitess [09 ISA 27 03](#) # And David dwelt with Achish at Gath, he and his men, every man with his household, [even] David with his two wives, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail the Carmelitess, Nabal's wife.

Abigail the daughter [10 2SA 17 25](#) # And Absalom made Amasa captain of the host instead of Joab: which Amasa [was] a man's son, whose name [was] Ithra an Israelite, that went in to Abigail the daughter of Nahash, sister to Zeruah Joab's mother.

Abigail the wife [09 ISA 30 05](#) # And David's two wives were taken captives, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail the wife of Nabal the Carmelite.

Abigail the wife [10 2SA 03 03](#) # And his second, Chileab, of Abigail the wife of Nabal the Carmelite; and the third, Absalom the son of Maacah the daughter of Talmi king of Geshur;

Abigail to Carmel [09 ISA 25 40](#) # And when the servants of David were come to Abigail to Carmel, they spake unto her, saying, David sent us unto thee, to take thee to him to wife.

Abigail to take [09 ISA 25 39](#) # And when David heard that Nabal was dead, he said, Blessed [be] the LORD, that hath pleaded the cause of my reproach from the hand of Nabal, and hath kept his servant from evil: for the LORD hath returned the wickedness of Nabal upon his own head. And David sent and communed with Abigail, to take her to him to wife.
