Adar a day [17 EST 09 19](#) # Therefore the Jews of the villages, that dwelt in the unwall'd towns, made the fourteenth day of the month Adar [a day of] gladness and feasting, and a good day, and of sending portions one to another.

Adar and fetched [06 JOS 15 03](#) # And it went out to the south side to Maalehacrabbin, and passed along to Zin, and ascended up on the south side unto Kadeshbarnea, and passed along to Hezron, and went up to Adar, and fetched a compass to Karkaa:

Adar and on [17 EST 09 17](#) # On the thirteenth day of the month Adar; and on the fourteenth day of the same rested they, and made it a day of feasting and gladness.

Adar and slew [17 EST 09 15](#) # For the Jews that [were] in Shushan gathered themselves together on the fourteenth day also of the month Adar, and slew three hundred men at Shushan; but on the prey they laid not their hand.

Adar and the [17 EST 09 21](#) # To stablish [this] among them, that they should keep the fourteenth day of the month Adar, and the fifteenth day of the same, yearly,

Adar and to [17 EST 03 13](#) # And the letters were sent by posts into all the king's provinces, to destroy, to kill, and to cause to perish, all Jews, both young and old, little children and women, in one day, [even] upon the thirteenth [day] of the twelfth month, which is the month Adar, and [to take] the spoil of them for a prey.

Adar on the [17 EST 09 01](#) # Now in the twelfth month, that [is], the month Adar, on the thirteenth day of the same, when the king's commandment and his decree drew near to be put in execution, in the day that the enemies of the Jews hoped to have power over them, [though it was turned to the contrary, that the Jews had rule over them that hated them;]

Adar which was [15 EZR 06 15](#) # And this house was finished on the third day of the month Adar, which was in the sixth year of the reign of Darius the king.

Adar [17 EST 03 07](#) # In the first month, that [is], the month Nisan, in the twelfth year of king Ahasuerus, they cast Pur, that [is], the lot, before Haman from day to day, and from month to month, [to] the twelfth [month], that [is], the month Adar.

Adar [17 EST 08 12](#) # Upon one day in all the provinces of king Ahasuerus, [namely], upon the thirteenth [day] of the twelfth month, which [is] the month Adar.

Atarothadar near the [06 JOS 18 13](#) # And the border went over from thence toward Luz, to the side of Luz, which [is] Bethel, southward; and the border descended to Atarothadar, near the hill that [lieth] on the south side of the nether Bethoron.

Gadarenes round about [42 LUK 08 37](#) # Then the whole multitude of the country of the Gadarenes round about besought him to depart from them; for they were taken with great fear: and he went up into the ship, and returned back again.

Gadarenes which is [42 LUK 08 26](#) # And they arrived at the country of the Gadarenes, which is over against Galilee.

Gadarenes [41 MAR 05 01](#) # And they came over unto the other side of the sea, into the country of the Gadarenes.

Hadar and Tema [01 GEN 25 15](#) # Hadar, and Tema, Jetur, Naphish, and Kedemah:

Hadar reigned in [01 GEN 36 39](#) # And Baalhanan the son of Achbor died, and Hadar reigned in his stead: and the name of his city [was] Pau; and his wife's name [was] Mehetabel, the daughter of Matred, the daughter of Mezahab.

Hadarezer and brought [13 1CH 18 07](#) # And David took the shields of gold that were on the servants of Hadarezer, and brought them to Jerusalem.

Hadarezer and smitten [13 1CH 18 10](#) # He sent Hadoram his son to king David, to inquire of his welfare, and to congratulate him, because he had fought against Hadarezer, and smitten him; [for Hadarezer had war with Tou;] and [with him] all manner of vessels of gold and silver and brass.

Hadarezer brought David [13 1CH 18 08](#) # Likewise from Tibhath, and from Chun, cities of Hadarezer, brought David very much brass, wherewith Solomon made the brazen sea, and the pillars, and the vessels of brass.

Hadarezer had war [13 1CH 18 10](#) # He sent Hadoram his son to king David, to inquire of his welfare, and to congratulate him, because he had fought against Hadarezer, and smitten him; [for Hadarezer had war with Tou;] and [with him] all manner of vessels of gold and silver and brass.

Hadarezer king of [13 1CH 18 03](#) # And David smote Hadarezer king of Zobah unto Hamath, as he went to stablish his dominion by the river Euphrates.

Hadarezer king of [13 1CH 18 05](#) # And when the Syrians of Damascus came to help Hadarezer king of Zobah, David slew of the Syrians two and twenty thousand men.

Hadarezer king of [13 1CH 18 09](#) # Now when Tou king of Hamath heard how David had smitten all the host of Hadarezer king of Zobah;

Hadarezer saw that [13 1CH 19 19](#) # And when the servants of Hadarezer saw that they were put to the worse before Israel, they made peace with David, and became his servants: neither would the Syrians help the children of Ammon any more.

Hadarezer saw that [10 2SA 10 19](#) # And when all the kings [that were] servants to Hadarezer saw that they were smitten before Israel, they made peace with Israel, and served them. So the Syrians feared to help the children of Ammon any more.

Hadarezer sent and [10 2SA 10 16](#) # And Hadarezer sent, and brought out the Syrians that [were] beyond the river: and they came to Helam; and Shobach the captain of the host of Hadarezer [went] before them.

Hadarezer went before [13 1CH 19 16](#) # And when the Syrians saw that they were put to the worse before Israel, they sent messengers, and drew forth the Syrians that [were] beyond the river: and Shophach the captain of the host of Hadarezer [went] before them.

Hadarezer went before [10 2SA 10 16](#) # And Hadarezer sent, and brought out the Syrians that [were] beyond the river: and they came to Helam; and Shobach the captain of the host of Hadarezer [went] before them.
