Ahi and Rohgah [13 1CH 07 34](#) # And the sons of Shamer; Ahi, and Rohgah, Jehubbah, and Aram.

Ahi the son [13 1CH 05 15](#) # Ahi the son of Abdiel, the son of Guni, chief of the house of their fathers.

Ahiah and Gera [13 1CH 08 07](#) # And Naaman, and Ahiah, and Gera, he removed them, and begat Uzza, and Ahihud.

Ahiah Bring hither [09 ISA 14 18](#) # And Saul said unto Ahiah, Bring hither the ark of God. For the ark of God was at that time with the children of Israel.

Ahiah the son [09 ISA 14 03](#) # And Ahiah, the son of Ahitub, Ichabod's brother, the son of Phinehas, the son of Eli, the LORD'S priest in Shiloh, wearing an ephod. And the people knew not that Jonathan was gone.

Ahiah the sons [11 1KI 04 03](#) # Elihoreph and Ahiah, the sons of Shisha, scribes; Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud, the recorder.

Ahiam the son [13 1CH 11 35](#) # Ahiam the son of Sacar the Hararite, Eliphai the son of Ur,

Ahiam the son [10 2SA 23 33](#) # Shammah the Hararite, Ahiam the son of Sharar the Hararite,

Ahian and Shechem [13 1CH 07 19](#) # And the sons of Shemidah were, Ahian, and Shechem, and Likhi, and Aniam.

Ahiezer the son [04 NUM 01 12](#) # Of Dan; Ahiezer the son of Ammishaddai.

Ahiezer the son [04 NUM 02 25](#) # The standard of the camp of Dan [shall be] on the north side by their armies: and the captain of the children of Dan [shall be] Ahiezer the son of Ammishaddai.

Ahiezer the son [04 NUM 07 66](#) # On the tenth day Ahiezer the son of Ammishaddai, prince of the children of Dan, [offered]:

Ahiezer the son [04 NUM 07 71](#) # And for a sacrifice of peace offerings, two oxen, five rams, five he goats, five lambs of the first year: this [was] the offering of Ahiezer the son of Ammishaddai.

Ahiezer the son [04 NUM 10 25](#) # And the standard of the camp of the children of Dan set forward, [which was] the rereward of all the camps throughout their hosts: and over his host [was] Ahiezer the son of Ammishaddai.

Ahiezer then Joash [13 1CH 12 03](#) # The chief [was] Ahiezer, then Joash, the sons of Shemaah the Gibeathite; and Jeziel, and Pelet, the sons of Azmaveth; and Berachah, and Jehu the Antothite,

Ahihud the son [04 NUM 34 27](#) # And the prince of the tribe of the children of Asher, Ahihud the son of Shelomi.

Ahihud [13 1CH 08 07](#) # And Naaman, and Ahiah, and Gera, he removed them, and begat Uzza, and Ahihud.

Ahijah Behold the [11\\_1KI\\_14\\_05](#) # And the LORD said unto Ahijah, Behold, the wife of Jeroboam cometh to ask a thing of thee for her son; for he [is] sick: thus and thus shalt thou say unto her: for it shall be, when she cometh in, that she shall feign herself [to be] another [woman].

Ahijah But Ahijah [11\\_1KI\\_14\\_04](#) # And Jeroboam's wife did so, and arose, and went to Shiloh, and came to the house of Ahijah. But Ahijah could not see; for his eyes were set by reason of his age.

Ahijah caught the [11\\_1KI\\_11\\_30](#) # And Ahijah caught the new garment that [was] on him, and rent it [in] twelve pieces:

Ahijah could not [11\\_1KI\\_14\\_04](#) # And Jeroboam's wife did so, and arose, and went to Shiloh, and came to the house of Ahijah. But Ahijah could not see; for his eyes were set by reason of his age.

Ahijah for the [11\\_1KI\\_21\\_22](#) # And will make thine house like the house of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, and like the house of Baasha the son of Ahijah, for the provocation wherewith thou hast provoked [me] to anger, and made Israel to sin.

Ahijah Hanan Anan [16\\_NEH\\_10\\_26](#) # And Ahijah, Hanan, Anan,

Ahijah heard the [11\\_1KI\\_14\\_06](#) # And it was [so], when Ahijah heard the sound of her feet, as she came in at the door, that he said, Come in, thou wife of Jeroboam; why feignest thou thyself [to be] another? for I [am] sent to thee [with] heavy [tidings].

Ahijah of the [11\\_1KI\\_15\\_27](#) # And Baasha the son of Ahijah, of the house of Issachar, conspired against him; and Baasha smote him at Gibbethon, which [belonged] to the Philistines; for Nadab and all Israel laid siege to Gibbethon.

Ahijah the Pelonite [13\\_1CH\\_11\\_36](#) # Hopher the Mecherathite, Ahijah the Pelonite,

Ahijah the prophet [11\\_1KI\\_14\\_02](#) # And Jeroboam said to his wife, Arise, I pray thee, and disguise thyself, that thou be not known to be the wife of Jeroboam; and get thee to Shiloh: behold, there [is] Ahijah the prophet, which told me that [I should be] king over this people.

Ahijah the prophet [11\\_1KI\\_14\\_18](#) # And they buried him; and all Israel mourned for him, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake by the hand of his servant Ahijah the prophet.

Ahijah the Shilonite [11\\_1KI\\_11\\_29](#) # And it came to pass at that time when Jeroboam went out of Jerusalem, that the prophet Ahijah the Shilonite found him in the way; and he had clad himself with a new garment; and they two [were] alone in the field:

Ahijah the Shilonite [11\\_1KI\\_12\\_15](#) # Wherefore the king hearkened not unto the people; for the cause was from the LORD, that he might perform his saying, which the LORD spake by Ahijah the Shilonite unto Jeroboam the son of Nebat.

Ahijah the Shilonite [11\\_1KI\\_15\\_29](#) # And it came to pass, when he reigned, [that] he smote all the house of Jeroboam; he left not to Jeroboam any that breathed, until he had destroyed him, according unto the saying of the LORD, which he spake by his servant Ahijah the Shilonite:

Ahijah the Shilonite [14\\_2CH\\_09\\_29](#) # Now the rest of the acts of Solomon, first and last, [are] they not written in the book of Nathan the prophet, and in the prophecy of Ahijah the Shilonite, and in the visions of Iddo the seer against Jeroboam the son of Nebat?

Ahijah the Shilonite [14\\_2CH\\_10\\_15](#) # So the king hearkened not unto the people: for the cause was of God, that the LORD might perform his word, which he spake by the hand of Ahijah the Shilonite to Jeroboam the son of Nebat.

Ahijah to reign [11\\_1KI\\_15\\_33](#) # In the third year of Asa king of Judah began Baasha the son of Ahijah to reign over all Israel in Tirzah, twenty and four years.

Ahijah was over [13\\_1CH\\_26\\_20](#) # And of the Levites, Ahijah [was] over the treasures of the house of God, and over the treasures of the dedicated things.

Ahijah [13\\_1CH\\_02\\_25](#) # And the sons of Jerahmeel the firstborn of Hezron were, Ram the firstborn, and Bunah, and Oren, and Ozem, [and] Ahijah.

Ahijah [12\\_2KI\\_09\\_09](#) # And I will make the house of Ahab like the house of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, and like the house of Baasha the son of Ahijah:

Ahikam and Achbor [12\\_2KI\\_22\\_14](#) # So Hilkiah the priest, and Ahikam, and Achbor, and Shaphan, and Asahiah, went unto Huldah the prophetess, the wife of Shallum the son of Tikvah, the son of Harhas, keeper of the wardrobe; [now she dwelt in Jerusalem in the college;] and they communed with her.

Ahikam and Ishmael [24\\_JER\\_41\\_10](#) # Then Ishmael carried away captive all the residue of the people that [were] in Mizpah, [even] the king's daughters, and all the people that remained in Mizpah, whom Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had committed to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam: and Ishmael the son of Nethaniah carried them away captive, and departed to go over to the Ammonites.

Ahikam believed them [24\\_JER\\_40\\_14](#) # And said unto him, Dost thou certainly know that Baalis the king of the Ammonites hath sent Ishmael the son of Nethaniah to slay thee? But Gedaliah the son of Ahikam believed them not.

Ahikam even mighty [24\\_JER\\_41\\_16](#) # Then took Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces that [were] with him, all the remnant of the people whom he had recovered from Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, from Mizpah, after [that] he had slain Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, [even] mighty men of war, and the women, and the children, and the eunuchs, whom he had brought again from Gibeon:

Ahikam governor in [24\\_JER\\_40\\_07](#) # Now when all the captains of the forces which [were] in the fields, [even] they and their men, heard that the king of Babylon had made Gedaliah the son of Ahikam governor in the land, and had committed unto him men, and women, and children, and of the poor of the land, of them that were not carried away captive to Babylon;

Ahikam said unto [24\\_JER\\_40\\_16](#) # But Gedaliah the son of Ahikam said unto Johanan the son of Kareah, Thou shalt not do this thing: for thou speakest falsely of Ishmael.

Ahikam the son [14\\_2CH\\_34\\_20](#) # And the king commanded Hilkiah, and Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Abdon the son of Micah, and Shaphan the scribe, and Asaiah a servant of the king's, saying,

Ahikam the son [12\\_2KI\\_22\\_12](#) # And the king commanded Hilkiah the priest, and Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Achbor the son of Michaiah, and Shaphan the scribe, and Asahiah a servant of the king's, saying,

Ahikam the son [12\\_2KI\\_25\\_22](#) # And [as for] the people that remained in the land of Judah, whom Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon had left, even over them he made Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, the son of Shaphan, ruler.

Ahikam the son [24\\_JER\\_26\\_24](#) # Nevertheless the hand of Ahikam the son of Shaphan was with Jeremiah, that they should not give him into the hand of the people to put him to death.

Ahikam the son [24\\_JER\\_39\\_14](#) # Even they sent, and took Jeremiah out of the court of the prison, and committed him unto Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, that he should carry him home: so he

dwelt among the people.

Ahikam the son [24 JER 40 05](#) # Now while he was not yet gone back, [he said], Go back also to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, whom the king of Babylon hath made governor over the cities of Judah, and dwell with him among the people: or go wheresoever it seemeth convenient unto thee to go. So the captain of the guard gave him victuals and a reward, and let him go.

Ahikam the son [24 JER 40 09](#) # And Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan sware unto them and to their men, saying, Fear not to serve the Chaldeans: dwell in the land, and serve the king of Babylon, and it shall be well with you.

Ahikam the son [24 JER 40 11](#) # Likewise when all the Jews that [were] in Moab, and among the Ammonites, and in Edom, and that [were] in all the countries, heard that the king of Babylon had left a remnant of Judah, and that he had set over them Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan;

Ahikam the son [24 JER 41 02](#) # Then arose Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and the ten men that were with him, and smote Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan with the sword, and slew him, whom the king of Babylon had made governor over the land.

Ahikam the son [24 JER 43 06](#) # [Even] men, and women, and children, and the king's daughters, and every person that Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had left with Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Jeremiah the prophet, and Baruch the son of Neriah.

Ahikam to Mizpah [24 JER 40 06](#) # Then went Jeremiah unto Gedaliah the son of Ahikam to Mizpah; and dwelt with him among the people that were left in the land.

Ahikam to Mizpah [24 JER 41 01](#) # Now it came to pass in the seventh month, [that] Ishmael the son of Nethaniah the son of Elishama, of the seed royal, and the princes of the king, even ten men with him, came unto Gedaliah the son of Ahikam to Mizpah; and there they did eat bread together in Mizpah.

Ahikam whom the [24 JER 41 18](#) # Because of the Chaldeans: for they were afraid of them, because Ishmael the son of Nethaniah had slain Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, whom the king of Babylon made governor in the land.

Ahikam [24 JER 41 06](#) # And Ishmael the son of Nethaniah went forth from Mizpah to meet them, weeping all along as he went: and it came to pass, as he met them, he said unto them, Come to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam.

Ahilud recorder [13 1CH 18 15](#) # And Joab the son of Zeruiah [was] over the host; and Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud, recorder.

Ahilud the recorder [11 1KI 04 03](#) # Elihoreph and Ahiah, the sons of Shisha, scribes; Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud, the recorder.

Ahilud to him [11 1KI 04 12](#) # Baana the son of Ahilud; [to him pertained] Taanach and Megiddo, and all Bethshean, which [is] by Zartanah beneath Jezreel, from Bethshean to Abelmeholah, [even] unto [the place that is] beyond Jokneam:

Ahilud was recorder [10 2SA 08 16](#) # And Joab the son of Zeruiah [was] over the host; and Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud [was] recorder;

Ahilud was recorder [10 2SA 20 24](#) # And Adoram [was] over the tribute: and Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud [was] recorder:

Ahimaaz and Jonathan [10 2SA 17 20](#) # And when Absalom's servants came to the woman to the house,

they said, Where [is] Ahimaaz and Jonathan? And the woman said unto them, They be gone over the brook of water. And when they had sought and could not find [them], they returned to Jerusalem.

Ahimaaz and the [09 ISA 14 50](#) # And the name of Saul's wife [was] Ahinoam, the daughter of Ahimaaz: and the name of the captain of his host [was] Abner, the son of Ner, Saul's uncle.

Ahimaaz answered When [10 2SA 18 29](#) # And the king said, Is the young man Absalom safe? And Ahimaaz answered, When Joab sent the king's servant, and [me] thy servant, I saw a great tumult, but I knew not what [it was].

Ahimaaz begat Azariah [13 1CH 06 09](#) # And Ahimaaz begat Azariah, and Azariah begat Johanan,

Ahimaaz called and [10 2SA 18 28](#) # And Ahimaaz called, and said unto the king, All is well. And he fell down to the earth upon his face before the king, and said, Blessed [be] the LORD thy God, which hath delivered up the men that lifted up their hand against my lord the king.

Ahimaaz his son [13 1CH 06 53](#) # Zadok his son, Ahimaaz his son.

Ahimaaz ran by [10 2SA 18 23](#) # But howsoever, [said he], let me run. And he said unto him, Run. Then Ahimaaz ran by the way of the plain, and overran Cushi.

Ahimaaz stayed by [10 2SA 17 17](#) # Now Jonathan and Ahimaaz stayed by Enrogel; for they might not be seen to come into the city: and a wench went and told them; and they went and told king David.

Ahimaaz the son [10 2SA 18 19](#) # Then said Ahimaaz the son of Zadok, Let me now run, and bear the king tidings, how that the LORD hath avenged him of his enemies.

Ahimaaz the son [10 2SA 18 22](#) # Then said Ahimaaz the son of Zadok yet again to Joab, But howsoever, let me, I pray thee, also run after Cushi. And Joab said, Wherefore wilt thou run, my son, seeing that thou hast no tidings ready?

Ahimaaz the son [10 2SA 18 27](#) # And the watchman said, Me thinketh the running of the foremost is like the running of Ahimaaz the son of Zadok. And the king said, He [is] a good man, and cometh with good tidings.

Ahimaaz thy son [10 2SA 15 27](#) # The king said also unto Zadok the priest, [Art not] thou a seer? return into the city in peace, and your two sons with you, Ahimaaz thy son, and Jonathan the son of Abiathar.

Ahimaaz was in [11 1KI 04 15](#) # Ahimaaz [was] in Naphtali; he also took Basmath the daughter of Solomon to wife:

Ahimaaz Zadok's son [10 2SA 15 36](#) # Behold, [they have] there with them their two sons, Ahimaaz Zadok's [son], and Jonathan Abiathar's [son]; and by them ye shall send unto me every thing that ye can hear.

Ahimaaz [13 1CH 06 08](#) # And Ahitub begat Zadok, and Zadok begat Ahimaaz,

Ahiman and Talmai [06 JOS 15 14](#) # And Caleb drove thence the three sons of Anak, Sheshai, and Ahiman, and Talmai, the children of Anak.

Ahiman and Talmai [07 JUD 01 10](#) # And Judah went against the Canaanites that dwelt in Hebron: [now the name of Hebron before [was] Kirjatharba:] and they slew Sheshai, and Ahiman, and Talmai.

Ahiman and their [13 1CH 09 17](#) # And the porters [were], Shallum, and Akkub, and Talmon, and Ahiman, and their brethren: Shallum [was] the chief;

Ahiman Sheshai and [04 NUM 13 22](#) # And they ascended by the south, and came unto Hebron; where Ahiman, Sheshai, and Talmai, the children of Anak, [were]. [Now Hebron was built seven years before Zoan in Egypt.]

Ahimelech And is [09 ISA 21 08](#) # And David said unto Ahimelech, And is there not here under thine hand spear or sword? for I have neither brought my sword nor my weapons with me, because the king's business required haste.

Ahimelech and the [13 1CH 24 31](#) # These likewise cast lots over against their brethren the sons of Aaron in the presence of David the king, and Zadok, and Ahimelech, and the chief of the fathers of the priests and Levites, even the principal fathers over against their younger brethren.

Ahimelech answered the [09 ISA 22 14](#) # Then Ahimelech answered the king, and said, And who [is so] faithful among all thy servants as David, which is the king's son in law, and goeth at thy bidding, and is honourable in thine house?

Ahimelech fled to [09 ISA 23 06](#) # And it came to pass, when Abiathar the son of Ahimelech fled to David to Keilah, [that] he came down [with] an ephod in his hand.

Ahimelech of the [13 1CH 24 03](#) # And David distributed them, both Zadok of the sons of Eleazar, and Ahimelech of the sons of Ithamar, according to their offices in their service.

Ahimelech the Hittite [09 ISA 26 06](#) # Then answered David and said to Ahimelech the Hittite, and to Abishai the son of Zeruiah, brother to Joab, saying, Who will go down with me to Saul to the camp? And Abishai said, I will go down with thee.

Ahimelech the priest [09 ISA 21 01](#) # Then came David to Nob to Ahimelech the priest: and Ahimelech was afraid at the meeting of David, and said unto him, Why [art] thou alone, and no man with thee?

Ahimelech the priest [09 ISA 21 02](#) # And David said unto Ahimelech the priest, The king hath commanded me a business, and hath said unto me, Let no man know any thing of the business whereabout I send thee, and what I have commanded thee: and I have appointed [my] servants to such and such a place.

Ahimelech the priest [09 ISA 22 11](#) # Then the king sent to call Ahimelech the priest, the son of Ahitub, and all his father's house, the priests that [were] in Nob: and they came all of them to the king.

Ahimelech the son [13 1CH 24 06](#) # And Shemaiah the son of Nethaneel the scribe, [one] of the Levites, wrote them before the king, and the princes, and Zadok the priest, and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar, and [before] the chief of the fathers of the priests and Levites: one principal household being taken for Eleazar, and [one] taken for Ithamar.

Ahimelech the son [09 ISA 22 09](#) # Then answered Doeg the Edomite, which was set over the servants of Saul, and said, I saw the son of Jesse coming to Nob, to Ahimelech the son of Ahitub.

Ahimelech the son [09 ISA 22 20](#) # And one of the sons of Ahimelech the son of Ahitub, named Abiathar, escaped, and fled after David.

Ahimelech the son [10 2SA 08 17](#) # And Zadok the son of Ahitub, and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar, [were] the priests; and Seraiah [was] the scribe;

Ahimelech thou and [09 ISA 22 16](#) # And the king said, Thou shalt surely die, Ahimelech, thou, and all thy father's house.

Ahimelech was afraid [09 ISA 21 01](#) # Then came David to Nob to Ahimelech the priest: and Ahimelech was afraid at the meeting of David, and said unto him, Why [art] thou alone, and no man with thee?

Ahimelech Why boastest [19 PSA 52 01](#) # To the chief Musician, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when Doeg the Edomite came and told Saul, and said unto him, David is come to the house of Ahimelech. Why boastest thou thyself in mischief, O mighty man? the goodness of God [endureth] continually.

Ahimelech's son I [09 ISA 30 07](#) # And David said to Abiathar the priest, Ahimelech's son, I pray thee, bring me hither the ephod. And Abiathar brought thither the ephod to David.

Ahimoth [13 1CH 06 25](#) # And the sons of Elkanah; Amasai, and Ahimoth.

Ahinadab the son [11 1KI 04 14](#) # Ahinadab the son of Iddo [had] Mahanaim:

Ahinoam of Jezreel [09 ISA 25 43](#) # David also took Ahinoam of Jezreel; and they were also both of them his wives.

Ahinoam the daughter [09 ISA 14 50](#) # And the name of Saul's wife [was] Ahinoam, the daughter of Ahimaaz: and the name of the captain of his host [was] Abner, the son of Ner, Saul's uncle.

Ahinoam the Jezreelitess [13 1CH 03 01](#) # Now these were the sons of David, which were born unto him in Hebron; the firstborn Amnon, of Ahinoam the Jezreelitess; the second Daniel, of Abigail the Carmelitess:

Ahinoam the Jezreelitess [09 ISA 27 03](#) # And David dwelt with Achish at Gath, he and his men, every man with his household, [even] David with his two wives, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail the Carmelitess, Nabal's wife.

Ahinoam the Jezreelitess [09 ISA 30 05](#) # And David's two wives were taken captives, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail the wife of Nabal the Carmelite.

Ahinoam the Jezreelitess [10 2SA 02 02](#) # So David went up thither, and his two wives also, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail Nabal's wife the Carmelite.

Ahinoam the Jezreelitess [10 2SA 03 02](#) # And unto David were sons born in Hebron: and his firstborn was Amnon, of Ahinoam the Jezreelitess;

Ahio and Zacher [13 1CH 08 31](#) # And Gedor, and Ahio, and Zacher.

Ahio and Zechariah [13 1CH 09 37](#) # And Gedor, and Ahio, and Zechariah, and Mikloth.

Ahio drave the [13 1CH 13 07](#) # And they carried the ark of God in a new cart out of the house of Abinadab: and Uzza and Ahio drave the cart.

Ahio Shashak and [13 1CH 08 14](#) # And Ahio, Shashak, and Jeremoth,

Ahio the sons [10 2SA 06 03](#) # And they set the ark of God upon a new cart, and brought it out of the house of Abinadab that [was] in Gibeah: and Uzzah and Ahio, the sons of Abinadab, drave the new cart.

Ahio went before [10 2SA 06 04](#) # And they brought it out of the house of Abinadab which [was] at Gibeah, accompanying the ark of God: and Ahio went before the ark.

Ahira the son [04 NUM 01 15](#) # Of Naphtali; Ahira the son of Enan.

Ahira the son [04 NUM 02 29](#) # Then the tribe of Naphtali: and the captain of the children of Naphtali [shall be] Ahira the son of Enan.

Ahira the son [04\\_NUM\\_07\\_78](#) # On the twelfth day Ahira the son of Enan, prince of the children of Naphtali, [offered]:

Ahira the son [04\\_NUM\\_07\\_83](#) # And for a sacrifice of peace offerings, two oxen, five rams, five he goats, five lambs of the first year: this [was] the offering of Ahira the son of Enan.

Ahira the son [04\\_NUM\\_10\\_27](#) # And over the host of the tribe of the children of Naphtali [was] Ahira the son of Enan.

Ahiram the family [04\\_NUM\\_26\\_38](#) # The sons of Benjamin after their families: of Bela, the family of the Belaites: of Ashbel, the family of the Ashbelites: of Ahiram, the family of the Ahiramites:
