Ahiah Bring hither <u>09_1SA_14_18</u># And Saul said unto Ahiah, Bring hither the ark of God. For the ark of God was at that time with the children of Israel.

Ahiah the son <u>09_1SA_14_03</u># And Ahiah, the son of Ahitub, Ichabod's brother, the son of Phinehas, the son of Eli, the LORD'S priest in Shiloh, wearing an ephod. And the people knew not that Jonathan was gone.

Ahiah the sons 11_1KI_04_03# Elihoreph and Ahiah, the sons of Shisha, scribes; Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud, the recorder.

Ahiam the son 13_1CH_11_35 # Ahiam the son of Sacar the Hararite, Eliphal the son of Ur,

Ahiam the son 10_2SA_23_33 # Shammah the Hararite, Ahiam the son of Sharar the Hararite,

Ahian and Shechem <u>13_1CH_07_19</u># And the sons of Shemidah were, Ahian, and Shechem, and Likhi, and Aniam.

Ahiezer the son 04_NUM_01_12 # Of Dan; Ahiezer the son of Ammishaddai.

Ahiezer the son <u>04_NUM_02_25</u> # The standard of the camp of Dan [shall be] on the north side by their armies: and the captain of the children of Dan [shall be] Ahiezer the son of Ammishaddai.

Ahiezer the son <u>04_NUM_07_66</u> # On the tenth day Ahiezer the son of Ammishaddai, prince of the children of Dan, [offered]:

Ahijah heard the 11_1KI_14_06 # And it was [so], when Ahijah heard the sound of her feet, as she came in at the door, that he said, Come in, thou wife of Jeroboam; why feignest thou thyself [to be] another? for I [am] sent to thee [with] heavy [tidings].

Ahijah of the 11_1KI_15_27# And Baasha the son of Ahijah, of the house of Issachar, conspired against him; and Baasha smote him at Gibbethon, which [belonged] to the Philistines; for Nadab and all Israel laid siege to Gibbethon.

Ahijah the Pelonite 13_1CH_11_36# Hepher the Mecherathite, Ahijah the Pelonite,

Ahijah the prophet 11_1KI_14_02 # And Jeroboam said to his wife, Arise, I pray thee, and disguise thyself, that thou be not known to be the wife of Jeroboam; and get thee to Shiloh: behold, there [is] Ahijah the prophet, which told me that [I should be] king over this people.

Ahikam and Achbor 12_2KI_22_14 # So Hilkiah the priest, and Ahikam, and Achbor, and Shaphan, and Asahiah, went unto Huldah the prophetess, the wife of Shallum the son of Tikvah, the son of Harhas, keeper of the wardrobe; [now she dwelt in Jerusalem in the college;] and they communed with her.

Ahikam and Ishmael 24_JER_41_10# Then Ishmael carried away captive all the residue of the people that [were] in Mizpah, [even] the king's daughters, and all the people that remained in Mizpah, whom Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had committed to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam: and Ishmael the son of Nethaniah carried them away captive, and departed to go over to the Ammonites.

Ahikam believed them 24_JER_40_14 # And said unto him, Dost thou certainly know that Baalis the king of the Ammonites hath sent Ishmael the son of Nethaniah to slay thee? But Gedaliah the son of Ahikam believed them not.

Ahikam even mighty 24_JER_41_16 # Then took Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces that [were] with him, all the remnant of the people whom he had recovered from Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, from Mizpah, after [that] he had slain Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, [even] mighty men of war, and the women, and the children, and the eunuchs, whom he had brought again from Gibeon:

Ahikam the son 24_JER_26_24 # Nevertheless the hand of Ahikam the son of Shaphan was with Jeremiah, that they should not give him into the hand of the people to put him to death.

Ahikam the son 24_JER_39_14 # Even they sent, and took Jeremiah out of the court of the prison, and committed him unto Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, that he should carry him home: so he

dwelt among the people.

Ahikam the son 24_JER_40_05 # Now while he was not yet gone back, [he said], Go back also to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, whom the king of Babylon hath made governor over the cities of Judah, and dwell with him among the people: or go wheresoever it seemeth convenient unto thee to go. So the captain of the guard gave him victuals and a reward, and let him go.

Ahikam the son 24 JER 40 09 # And Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan sware unto them and to their men, saying, Fear not to serve the Chaldeans: dwell in the land, and serve the king of Babylon, and it shall be well with you.

Ahikam the son 24_JER_40_11 # Likewise when all the Jews that [were] in Moab, and among the Ammonites, and in Edom, and that [were] in all the countries, heard that the king of Babylon had left a remnant of Judah, and that he had set over them Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan;

Ahikam the son 24 JER 41 02 # Then arose Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and the ten men that were with him, and smote Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan with the sword, and slew him, whom the king of Babylon had made governor over the land.

Ahikam the son 24_JER_43_06 # [Even] men, and women, and children, and the king's daughters, and every person that Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had left with Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Jeremiah the prophet, and Baruch the son of Neriah.

Ahikam to Mizpah <u>24_JER_40_06</u> # Then went Jeremiah unto Gedaliah the son of Ahikam to Mizpah; and dwelt with him among the people that were left in the land.

Ahikam to Mizpah 24 JER_41_01 # Now it came to pass in the seventh month, [that] Ishmael the son of Nethaniah the son of Elishama, of the seed royal, and the princes of the king, even ten men with him, came unto Gedaliah the son of Ahikam to Mizpah; and there they did eat bread together in Mizpah.

Ahilud to him 11 1KI 04 12 # Baana the son of Ahilud; [to him pertained] Taanach and Megiddo, and all Bethshean, which [is] by Zartanah beneath Jezreel, from Bethshean to Abelmeholah, [even] unto [the place that is] beyond Jokneam:

Ahilud was recorder 10_2SA_08_16 # And Joab the son of Zeruiah [was] over the host; and Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud [was] recorder;

Ahilud was recorder <u>10_2SA_20_24</u> # And Adoram [was] over the tribute: and Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud [was] recorder:

Ahimaaz and Jonathan 10_2SA_17_20 # And when Absalom's servants came to the woman to the house,

they said, Where [is] Ahimaaz and Jonathan? And the woman said unto them, They be gone over the brook of water. And when they had sought and could not find [them], they returned to Jerusalem.

Ahimaaz and the <u>09_1SA_14_50</u> # And the name of Saul's wife [was] Ahinoam, the daughter of Ahimaaz: and the name of the captain of his host [was] Abner, the son of Ner, Saul's uncle.

Ahimaaz answered When 10_2SA_18_29 # And the king said, Is the young man Absalom safe? And Ahimaaz answered, When Joab sent the king's servant, and [me] thy servant, I saw a great tumult, but I knew not what [it was].

Ahimaaz begat Azariah 13_1CH_06_09 # And Ahimaaz begat Azariah, and Azariah begat Johanan,

Ahimaaz called and 10_2SA_18_28 # And Ahimaaz called, and said unto the king, All is well. And he fell down to the earth upon his face before the king, and said, Blessed [be] the LORD thy God, which hath delivered up the men that lifted up their hand against my lord the king.

Ahimaaz his son 13_1CH_06_53 # Zadok his son, Ahimaaz his son.

Ahimaaz ran by 10_2SA_18_23 # But howsoever, [said he], let me run. And he said unto him, Run. Then Ahimaaz ran by the way of the plain, and overran Cushi.

Ahimaaz stayed by 10_2SA_17_17 # Now Jonathan and Ahimaaz stayed by Enrogel; for they might not be seen to come into the city: and a wench went and told them; and they went and told king David.

Ahiman and Talmai <u>06_JOS_15_14</u># And Caleb drove thence the three sons of Anak, Sheshai, and Ahiman, and Talmai, the children of Anak.

Ahiman and Talmai <u>07_JUD_01_10</u># And Judah went against the Canaanites that dwelt in Hebron: [now the name of Hebron before [was] Kirjatharba:] and they slew Sheshai, and Ahiman, and Talmai.

Ahiman and their 13_1CH_09_17 # And the porters [were], Shallum, and Akkub, and Talmon, and Ahiman, and their brethren: Shallum [was] the chief;

Ahiman Sheshai and <u>04_NUM_13_22</u># And they ascended by the south, and came unto Hebron; where Ahiman, Sheshai, and Talmai, the children of Anak, [were]. [Now Hebron was built seven years before Zoan in Egypt.]

Ahimelech And is <u>09_1SA_21_08</u># And David said unto Ahimelech, And is there not here under thine hand spear or sword? for I have neither brought my sword nor my weapons with me, because the king's business required haste.

Ahimelech and the 13_1CH_24_31 # These likewise cast lots over against their brethren the sons of Aaron in the presence of David the king, and Zadok, and Ahimelech, and the chief of the fathers of the priests and Levites, even the principal fathers over against their younger brethren.

Ahimelech answered the <u>09_1SA_22_14</u># Then Ahimelech answered the king, and said, And who [is so] faithful among all thy servants as David, which is the king's son in law, and goeth at thy bidding, and is honourable in thine house?

Ahimelech the son <u>10_2SA_08_17</u> # And Zadok the son of Ahitub, and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar, [were] the priests; and Seraiah [was] the scribe;

Ahimelech thou and <u>09_1SA_22_16</u> # And the king said, Thou shalt surely die, Ahimelech, thou, and all thy father's house.

Ahimelech was afraid <u>09_1SA_21_01</u># Then came David to Nob to Ahimelech the priest: and Ahimelech was afraid at the meeting of David, and said unto him, Why [art] thou alone, and no man with thee?

Ahimelech Why boastest 19 PSA 52 01 # To the chief Musician, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when Doeg the Edomite came and told Saul, and said unto him, David is come to the house of Ahimelech. Why boastest thou thyself in mischief, O mighty man? the goodness of God [endureth] continually.

Ahimelech's son I <u>09_1SA_30_07</u> # And David said to Abiathar the priest, Ahimelech's son, I pray thee, bring me hither the ephod. And Abiathar brought thither the ephod to David.

Ahimoth 13_1CH_06_25 # And the sons of Elkanah; Amasai, and Ahimoth.

Ahinadab the son 11_1KI_04_14 # Ahinadab the son of Iddo [had] Mahanaim:

Ahinoam of Jezreel <u>09_1SA_25_43</u> # David also took Ahinoam of Jezreel; and they were also both of them his wives.

Ahinoam the daughter <u>09_1SA_14_50</u> # And the name of Saul's wife [was] Ahinoam, the daughter of Ahimaaz: and the name of the captain of his host [was] Abner, the son of Ner, Saul's uncle.

Ahinoam the Jezreelitess 13_1CH_03_01 # Now these were the sons of David, which were born unto him in Hebron; the firstborn Amnon, of Ahinoam the Jezreelitess; the second Daniel, of Abigail the Carmelitess:

Ahinoam the Jezreelitess <u>09_1SA_27_03</u> # And David dwelt with Achish at Gath, he and his men, every man with his household, [even] David with his two wives, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail the Carmelitess, Nabal's wife.
