Anna a prophetess <u>42\_LUK\_02\_36</u> # And there was one Anna, a prophetess, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Aser: she was of a great age, and had lived with an husband seven years from her virginity;

Joanna the wife <u>42\_LUK\_08\_03</u># And Joanna the wife of Chuza Herod's steward, and Susanna, and many others, which ministered unto him of their substance.

Joanna which was <u>42\_LUK\_03\_27</u> # Which was [the son] of Joanna, which was [the son] of Rhesa, which was [the son] of Zorobabel, which was [the son] of Salathiel, which was [the son] of Neri,

Kirjathsannah which is <u>06\_JOS\_15\_49</u># And Dannah, and Kirjathsannah, which [is] Debir,

Madmannah and Sansannah <u>06\_JOS\_15\_31</u> # And Ziklag, and Madmannah, and Sansannah,

Madmannah Sheva the <u>13\_1CH\_02\_49</u> # She bare also Shaaph the father of Madmannah, Sheva the father of Machbenah, and the father of Gibea: and the daughter of Caleb [was] Achsa.

manna and Aaron's <u>58\_HEB\_09\_04</u> # Which had the golden censer, and the ark of the covenant overlaid round about with gold, wherein [was] the golden pot that had manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tables of the covenant;

manna and are <u>43\_JOH\_06\_58</u># This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever.

manna which thou <u>05\_DEU\_08\_03</u> # And he humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that he might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every [word] that proceedeth out of the mouth of the LORD doth man
