Arad and Ader [13 1CH 08 15](#) # And Zebadiah, and Arad, and Ader,

Arad and they [07 JUD 01 16](#) # And the children of the Kenite, Moses' father in law, went up out of the city of palm trees with the children of Judah into the wilderness of Judah, which [lieth] in the south of Arad; and they went and dwelt among the people.

Arad one [06 JOS 12 14](#) # The king of Hormah, one; the king of Arad, one;

Arad the Canaanite [04 NUM 21 01](#) # And [when] king Arad the Canaanite, which dwelt in the south, heard tell that Israel came by the way of the spies; then he fought against Israel, and took [some] of them prisoners.

Arad the Canaanite [04 NUM 33 40](#) # And king Arad the Canaanite, which dwelt in the south in the land of Canaan, heard of the coming of the children of Israel.

Haradah and pitched [04 NUM 33 25](#) # And they removed from Haradah, and pitched in Makheloth.

Haradah [04 NUM 33 24](#) # And they removed from mount Shapher, and encamped in Haradah.

Hazaraddar and pass [04 NUM 34 04](#) # And your border shall turn from the south to the ascent of Akkrabbim, and pass on to Zin: and the going forth thereof shall be from the south to Kadeshbarnea, and shall go on to Hazaraddar, and pass on to Azmon:

Nebuzaradan captain of [12 2KI 25 08](#) # And in the fifth month, on the seventh [day] of the month, which [is] the nineteenth year of king Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, came Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard, a servant of the king of Babylon, unto Jerusalem:

Nebuzaradan captain of [12 2KI 25 20](#) # And Nebuzaradan captain of the guard took these, and brought them to the king of Babylon to Riblah:

Nebuzaradan captain of [24 JER 52 12](#) # Now in the fifth month, in the tenth [day] of the month, which [was] the nineteenth year of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, came Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard, [which] served the king of Babylon, into Jerusalem,

Nebuzaradan the captain [12 2KI 25 11](#) # Now the rest of the people [that were] left in the city, and the fugitives that fell away to the king of Babylon, with the remnant of the multitude, did Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carry away.

Nebuzaradan the captain [24 JER 39 09](#) # Then Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carried away captive into Babylon the remnant of the people that remained in the city, and those that fell away, that fell to him, with the rest of the people that remained.

Nebuzaradan the captain [24 JER 39 10](#) # But Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard left of the poor of the people, which had nothing, in the land of Judah, and gave them vineyards and fields at the same time.

Nebuzaradan the captain [24 JER 39 11](#) # Now Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon gave charge concerning Jeremiah to Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard, saying,

Nebuzaradan the captain [24 JER 43 06](#) # [Even] men, and women, and children, and the king's daughters, and every person that Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had left with Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Jeremiah the prophet, and Baruch the son of Neriah.

Nebuzaradan the captain [24 JER 52 15](#) # Then Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carried away captive [certain] of the poor of the people, and the residue of the people that remained in the city, and those that fell away, that fell to the king of Babylon, and the rest of the multitude.

Nebuzaradan the captain [24 JER 52 16](#) # But Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard left [certain] of the poor of the land for vinedressers and for husbandmen.

Nebuzaradan the captain [24 JER 52 26](#) # So Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard took them, and brought them to the king of Babylon to Riblah.

Nebuzaradan the captain [24 JER 52 30](#) # In the three and twentieth year of Nebuchadnezzar Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carried away captive of the Jews seven hundred forty and five persons: all the persons [were] four thousand and six hundred.

paradise [42 LUK 23 43](#) # And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, To day shalt thou be with me in paradise.
