alone against the <u>43\_JOH\_12\_07</u> # Then said Jesus, Let her alone: against the day of my burying hath she kept this.

alone all men <u>43\_JOH\_11\_48</u># If we let him thus alone, all [men] will believe on him: and the Romans shall come and take away both our place and nation.

alone and all <u>02\_EXO\_18\_14</u># And when Moses' father in law saw all that he did to the people, he said, What [is] this thing that thou doest to the people? why sittest thou thyself alone, and all the people stand by thee from morning unto even?

alone and blessed <u>23\_ISA\_51\_02</u> # Look unto Abraham your father, and unto Sarah [that] bare you: for I called him alone, and blessed him, and increased him.

alone And Ehud <u>07\_JUD\_03\_20</u> # And Ehud came unto him; and he was sitting in a summer parlour, which he had for himself alone. And Ehud said, I have a message from God unto thee. And he arose out of [his] seat.

alone and keepeth <u>25\_LAM\_03\_28</u># He sitteth alone and keepeth silence, because he hath borne [it] upon him.

alone and let <u>10\_2SA\_16\_11</u># And David said to Abishai, and to all his servants, Behold, my son, which came forth of my bowels, seeketh my life: how much more now [may this] Benjamite [do it]? let him alone, and let him curse; for the LORD hath bidden him.

alone and no <u>09\_1SA\_21\_01</u> # Then came David to Nob to Ahimelech the priest: and Ahimelech was afraid at the meeting of David, and said unto him, Why [art] thou alone, and no man with thee?

alone and not <u>48\_GAL\_06\_04</u> # But let every man prove his own work, and then shall he have rejoicing in himself alone, and not in another.

alone and of <u>23\_ISA\_63\_03</u> # I have trodden the winepress alone; and of the people [there was] none with me: for I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury; and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment.

alone and saw <u>27\_DAN\_10\_08</u># Therefore I was left alone, and saw this great vision, and there remained no strength in me: for my comeliness was turned in me into corruption, and I retained no strength.

alone and shall <u>04\_NUM\_23\_09</u> # For from the top of the rocks I see him, and from the hills I behold him: lo, the people shall dwell alone, and shall not be reckoned among the nations.

alone And the <u>10\_2SA\_18\_26</u> # And the watchman saw another man running: and the watchman called unto the porter, and said, Behold [another] man running alone. And the king said, He also bringeth tidings.

alone and the <u>18\_JOB\_31\_17</u># Or have eaten my morsel myself alone, and the fatherless hath not eaten thereof;

alone and the <u>43\_JOH\_08\_09</u> # And they which heard [it], being convicted by [their own] conscience, went out one by one, beginning at the eldest, [even] unto the last: and Jesus was left alone, and the woman

standing in the midst.

alone and there <u>21\_ECC\_04\_08</u> # There is one [alone], and [there is] not a second; yea, he hath neither child nor brother: yet [is there] no end of all his labour; neither is his eye satisfied with riches; neither [saith he], For whom do I labour, and bereave my soul of good? This [is] also vanity, yea, it [is] a sore travail.

alone and there <u>01\_GEN\_32\_24</u># And Jacob was left alone; and there wrestled a man with him until the breaking of the day.

alone And they <u>42\_LUK\_09\_36</u> # And when the voice was past, Jesus was found alone. And they kept [it] close, and told no man in those days any of those things which they had seen.

alone and they <u>45\_ROM\_11\_03</u># Lord, they have killed thy prophets, and digged down thine altars; and I am left alone, and they seek my life.

alone and yet <u>43\_JOH\_16\_32</u> # Behold, the hour cometh, yea, is now come, that ye shall be scattered, every man to his own, and shall leave me alone: and yet I am not alone, because the Father is with me.

alone at Ephesus <u>44\_ACT\_19\_26</u> # Moreover ye see and hear, that not alone at Ephesus, but almost throughout all Asia, this Paul hath persuaded and turned away much people, saying that they be no gods, which are made with hands:

alone bear your <u>05\_DEU\_01\_12</u># How can I myself alone bear your cumbrance, and your burden, and your strife?

alone because it <u>04\_NUM\_11\_14</u># I am not able to bear all this people alone, because [it is] too heavy for me.

alone because of <u>24\_JER\_15\_17</u># I sat not in the assembly of the mockers, nor rejoiced; I sat alone because of thy hand: for thou hast filled me with indignation.

alone because the <u>43\_JOH\_16\_32</u> # Behold, the hour cometh, yea, is now come, that ye shall be scattered, every man to his own, and shall leave me alone: and yet I am not alone, because the Father is with me.

alone bid her <u>42\_LUK\_10\_40</u> # But Martha was cumbered about much serving, and came to him, and said, Lord, dost thou not care that my sister hath left me to serve alone? bid her therefore that she help me.

alone but by <u>42\_LUK\_04\_04</u> # And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.

alone but by <u>40\_MAT\_04\_04</u> # But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.

alone but for <u>43\_JOH\_17\_20</u># Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word;

alone but I <u>43\_JOH\_08\_16</u># And yet if I judge, my judgment is true: for I am not alone, but I and the Father that sent me.

alone but if <u>43\_JOH\_12\_24</u> # Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

alone by himself <u>28\_HOS\_08\_09</u> # For they are gone up to Assyria, a wild ass alone by himself: Ephraim hath hired lovers.

alone did lead <u>05\_DEU\_32\_12</u># [So] the LORD alone did lead him, and [there was] no strange god with him.

alone doeth great <u>19\_PSA\_136\_04</u># To him who alone doeth great wonders: for his mercy [endureth] for ever.

alone for her <u>12\_2KI\_04\_27</u># And when she came to the man of God to the hill, she caught him by the feet: but Gehazi came near to thrust her away. And the man of God said, Let her alone; for her soul [is] vexed within her: and the LORD hath hid [it] from me, and hath not told me.

alone for I <u>43\_JOH\_08\_29</u> # And he that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him.

alone for if <u>44\_ACT\_05\_38</u> # And now I say unto you, Refrain from these men, and let them alone: for if this counsel or this work be of men, it will come to nought:

alone for my <u>18\_JOB\_07\_16</u># I loathe [it]; I would not live alway: let me alone; for my days [are] vanity.

alone for they <u>17\_EST\_03\_06</u> # And he thought scorn to lay hands on Mordecai alone; for they had showed him the people of Mordecai: wherefore Haman sought to destroy all the Jews that [were] throughout the whole kingdom of Ahasuerus, [even] the people of Mordecai.

alone God hath <u>13\_1CH\_29\_01</u> # Furthermore David the king said unto all the congregation, Solomon my son, whom alone God hath chosen, [is yet] young and tender, and the work [is] great: for the palace [is] not for man, but for the LORD God.

alone he expounded <u>41\_MAR\_04\_34</u> # But without a parable spake he not unto them: and when they were alone, he expounded all things to his disciples.

alone I will <u>01\_GEN\_02\_18</u># And the LORD God said, [It is] not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him.

alone if he <u>40\_MAT\_18\_15</u># Moreover if thy brother shall trespass against thee, go and tell him his fault between thee and him alone: if he shall hear thee, thou hast gained thy brother.

alone if mischief <u>01\_GEN\_42\_38</u> # And he said, My son shall not go down with you; for his brother is dead, and he is left alone: if mischief befall him by the way in the which ye go, then shall ye bring down my gray hairs with sorrow to the grave.

alone in his <u>23\_ISA\_14\_31</u> # Howl, O gate; cry, O city; thou, whole Palestina, [art] dissolved: for there shall come from the north a smoke, and none [shall be] alone in his appointed times.

alone in his <u>06\_JOS\_22\_20</u># Did not Achan the son of Zerah commit a trespass in the accursed thing, and wrath fell on all the congregation of Israel? and that man perished not alone in his iniquity.

alone in the <u>11\_1KI\_11\_29</u># And it came to pass at that time when Jeroboam went out of Jerusalem, that the prophet Ahijah the Shilonite found him in the way; and he had clad himself with a new garment; and they two [were] alone in the field:

alone in the <u>23\_ISA\_05\_08</u> # Woe unto them that join house to house, [that] lay field to field, till [there be] no place, that they may be placed alone in the midst of the earth!

alone is excellent <u>19\_PSA\_148\_13</u> # Let them praise the name of the LORD: for his name alone is excellent; his glory [is] above the earth and heaven.

alone is JEHOVAH <u>19\_PSA\_83\_18</u># That [men] may know that thou, whose name alone [is] JEHOVAH, [art] the most high over all the earth.

alone is left <u>01\_GEN\_44\_20</u># And we said unto my lord, We have a father, an old man, and a child of his old age, a little one; and his brother is dead, and he alone is left of his mother, and his father loveth him.

alone let no <u>12\_2KI\_23\_18</u> # And he said, Let him alone; let no man move his bones. So they let his bones alone, with the bones of the prophet that came out of Samaria.

alone let the <u>15\_EZR\_06\_07</u># Let the work of this house of God alone; let the governor of the Jews and the elders of the Jews build this house of God in his place.

alone let us <u>41\_MAR\_15\_36</u> # And one ran and filled a sponge full of vinegar, and put [it] on a reed, and gave him to drink, saying, Let alone; let us see whether Elias will come to take him down.

alone of all <u>12\_2KI\_19\_15</u># And Hezekiah prayed before the LORD, and said, O LORD God of Israel, which dwellest [between] the cherubims, thou art the God, [even] thou alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth; thou hast made heaven and earth.

alone of all <u>23\_ISA\_37\_16</u># O LORD of hosts, God of Israel, that dwellest [between] the cherubims, thou [art] the God, [even] thou alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth: thou hast made heaven and earth.

alone on the <u>41\_MAR\_06\_47</u> # And when even was come, the ship was in the midst of the sea, and he alone on the land.

alone once every <u>58\_HEB\_09\_07</u> # But into the second [went] the high priest alone once every year, not without blood, which he offered for himself, and [for] the errors of the people:

alone praying his <u>42\_LUK\_09\_18</u># And it came to pass, as he was alone praying, his disciples were with him: and he asked them, saying, Whom say the people that I am?

alone saw the <u>27\_DAN\_10\_07</u> # And I Daniel alone saw the vision: for the men that were with me saw not the vision; but a great quaking fell upon them, so that they fled to hide themselves.

alone shall be <u>23\_ISA\_02\_11</u># The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, and the haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day.

alone shall be <u>23\_ISA\_02\_17</u> # And the loftiness of man shall be bowed down, and the haughtiness of men shall be made low: and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day.

alone shall come <u>02\_EXO\_24\_02</u># And Moses alone shall come near the LORD: but they shall not come nigh; neither shall the people go up with him.

alone shalt bear <u>20\_PRO\_09\_12</u># If thou be wise, thou shalt be wise for thyself: but [if] thou scornest, thou alone shalt bear [it].

alone spreadeth out <u>18\_JOB\_09\_08</u># Which alone spreadeth out the heavens, and treadeth upon the waves of the sea.

alone that I <u>05\_DEU\_09\_14</u> # Let me alone, that I may destroy them, and blot out their name from under heaven: and I will make of thee a nation mightier and greater than they.

alone that I <u>18\_JOB\_10\_20</u># [Are] not my days few? cease [then, and] let me alone, that I may take comfort a little,

alone that I <u>18\_JOB\_13\_13</u> # Hold your peace, let me alone, that I may speak, and let come on me what [will].

alone that it <u>45\_ROM\_04\_23</u> # Now it was not written for his sake alone, that it was imputed to him;

alone that my <u>02\_EXO\_32\_10</u> # Now therefore let me alone, that my wrath may wax hot against them, and that I may consume them: and I will make of thee a great nation.

alone that spreadeth <u>23\_ISA\_44\_24</u> # Thus saith the LORD, thy redeemer, and he that formed thee from the womb, I [am] the LORD that maketh all [things]; that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself;

alone that we <u>02\_EXO\_14\_12</u> # [Is] not this the word that we did tell thee in Egypt, saying, Let us alone, that we may serve the Egyptians? For [it had been] better for us to serve the Egyptians, than that we should die in the wilderness.

alone the earth <u>18\_JOB\_15\_19</u># Unto whom alone the earth was given, and no stranger passed among them.

alone the fountain <u>05\_DEU\_33\_28</u> # Israel then shall dwell in safety alone: the fountain of Jacob [shall be] upon a land of corn and wine; also his heavens shall drop down dew.

alone there is <u>10\_2SA\_18\_25</u> # And the watchman cried, and told the king. And the king said, If he [be] alone, [there is] tidings in his mouth. And he came apace, and drew near.

alone these where 23\_ISA\_49\_21 # Then shalt thou say in thine heart, Who hath begotten me these, seeing I have lost my children, and am desolate, a captive, and removing to and fro? and who hath brought up these? Behold, I was left alone; these, where [had] they [been]?

alone they be <u>40\_MAT\_15\_14</u> # Let them alone: they be blind leaders of the blind. And if the blind lead the blind, both shall fall into the ditch.

alone they that <u>41\_MAR\_04\_10</u> # And when he was alone, they that were about him with the twelve asked of him the parable.

alone this year <u>42\_LUK\_13\_08</u># And he answering said unto him, Lord, let it alone this year also, till I shall dig about it, and dung [it]:

alone thou hast <u>16\_NEH\_09\_06</u> # Thou, [even] thou, [art] LORD alone; thou hast made heaven, the heaven of heavens, with all their host, the earth, and all [things] that [are] therein, the seas, and all that [is] therein, and thou preservest them all; and the host of heaven worshippeth thee.

alone till I <u>18\_JOB\_07\_19</u># How long wilt thou not depart from me, nor let me alone till I swallow down my spittle?

alone to tell <u>18\_JOB\_01\_15</u> # And the Sabeans fell [upon them], and took them away; yea, they have slain the servants with the edge of the sword; and I only am escaped alone to tell thee.

alone to tell <u>18\_JOB\_01\_16</u> # While he [was] yet speaking, there came also another, and said, The fire of God is fallen from heaven, and hath burned up the sheep, and the servants, and consumed them; and I only am escaped alone to tell thee.

alone to tell <u>18\_JOB\_01\_17</u> # While he [was] yet speaking, there came also another, and said, The Chaldeans made out three bands, and fell upon the camels, and have carried them away, yea, and slain the servants with the edge of the sword; and I only am escaped alone to tell thee.

alone to tell <u>18\_JOB\_01\_19</u> # And, behold, there came a great wind from the wilderness, and smote the four corners of the house, and it fell upon the young men, and they are dead; and I only am escaped alone to tell thee.

alone two months <u>07\_JUD\_11\_37</u># And she said unto her father, Let this thing be done for me: let me alone two months, that I may go up and down upon the mountains, and bewail my virginity, I and my fellows.

alone upon the <u>19\_PSA\_102\_07</u> # I watch, and am as a sparrow alone upon the house top.

alone what have <u>42\_LUK\_04\_34</u> # Saying, Let [us] alone; what have we to do with thee, [thou] Jesus of Nazareth? art thou come to destroy us? I know thee who thou art; the Holy One of God.

alone what have <u>41\_MAR\_01\_24</u># Saying, Let [us] alone; what have we to do with thee, thou Jesus of Nazareth? art thou come to destroy us? I know thee who thou art, the Holy One of God.

alone when he <u>21\_ECC\_04\_10</u># For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow: but woe to him [that is] alone when he falleth; for [he hath] not another to help him up.

alone why trouble <u>41\_MAR\_14\_06</u> # And Jesus said, Let her alone; why trouble ye her? she hath wrought a good work on me.

alone with the <u>12\_2KI\_23\_18</u># And he said, Let him alone; let no man move his bones. So they let his bones alone, with the bones of the prophet that came out of Samaria.

alone without the <u>03\_LEV\_13\_46</u> # All the days wherein the plague [shall be] in him he shall be defiled; he [is] unclean: he shall dwell alone; without the camp [shall] his habitation [be].

alone <u>52\_1TH\_03\_01</u># Wherefore when we could no longer forbear, we thought it good to be left at Athens alone;

alone <u>10\_2SA\_18\_24</u># And David sat between the two gates: and the watchman went up to the roof over the gate unto the wall, and lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold a man running alone.

alone <u>05\_DEU\_01\_09</u> # And I spake unto you at that time, saying, I am not able to bear you myself alone:

alone <u>21\_ECC\_04\_11</u># Again, if two lie together, then they have heat: but how can one be warm [alone]?

alone <u>02\_EXO\_18\_18</u> # Thou wilt surely wear away, both thou, and this people that [is] with thee: for this thing [is] too heavy for thee; thou art not able to perform it thyself alone.

alone <u>28\_HOS\_04\_17</u># Ephraim [is] joined to idols: let him alone.

alone <u>59\_JAM\_02\_17</u> # Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone.

alone <u>24\_JER\_49\_31</u># Arise, get you up unto the wealthy nation, that dwelleth without care, saith the LORD, which have neither gates nor bars, [which] dwell alone.

alone <u>43\_JOH\_06\_15</u> # When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and take him by force, to make him a king, he departed again into a mountain himself alone.

alone <u>43\_JOH\_06\_22</u> # The day following, when the people which stood on the other side of the sea saw that there was none other boat there, save that one whereinto his disciples were entered, and that Jesus went not with his disciples into the boat, but [that] his disciples were gone away alone;

alone <u>42\_LUK\_05\_21</u> # And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, Who is this which speaketh blasphemies? Who can forgive sins, but God alone?
