angle into the <u>23\_ISA\_19\_08</u># The fishers also shall mourn, and all they that cast angle into the brooks shall lament, and they that spread nets upon the waters shall languish.

angle they catch <u>35\_HAB\_01\_15</u># They take up all of them with the angle, they catch them in their net, and gather them in their drag: therefore they rejoice and are glad.

entangle him in 40\_MAT\_22\_15 # Then went the Pharisees, and took counsel how they might entangle him in [his] talk.

entangled again with <u>48\_GAL\_05\_01</u># Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.

entangled in the <u>02\_EXO\_14\_03</u> # For Pharaoh will say of the children of Israel, They [are] entangled in the land, the wilderness hath shut them in.

entangled therein and <u>61\_2PE\_02\_20</u># For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning.

entangleth himself with <u>55\_2TI\_02\_04</u># No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of [this] life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.

strangled and from 44\_ACT\_15\_20 # But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and [from] fornication, and [from] things strangled, and [from] blood.

strangled and from 44\_ACT\_15\_29 # That ye abstain from meats offered to idols, and from blood, and from things strangled, and from fornication: from which if ye keep yourselves, ye shall do well. Fare ye well.

strangled and from 44\_ACT\_21\_25 # As touching the Gentiles which believe, we have written [and] concluded that they observe no such thing, save only that they keep themselves from [things] offered to idols, and from blood, and from strangled, and from fornication.

strangled for his <u>34\_NAH\_02\_12</u> # The lion did tear in pieces enough for his whelps, and strangled for his lionesses, and filled his holes with prey, and his dens with ravin.
