

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

anguish and sorrows <u>24\_JER\_49\_24</u> # Damascus is waxed feeble, [and] turneth herself to flee, and fear hath seized on [her]: anguish and sorrows have taken her, as a woman in travail.

anguish and they 23 ISA 08 22 # And they shall look unto the earth; and behold trouble and darkness, dimness of anguish; and [they shall be] driven to darkness.

anguish as of 24\_JER\_04\_31 # For I have heard a voice as of a woman in travail, [and] the anguish as of her that bringeth forth her first child, the voice of the daughter of Zion, [that] bewaileth herself, [that] spreadeth her hands, [saying], Woe [is] me now! for my soul is wearied because of murderers.

anguish because of <u>05\_DEU\_02\_25</u># This day will I begin to put the dread of thee and the fear of thee upon the nations [that are] under the whole heaven, who shall hear report of thee, and shall tremble, and be in anguish because of thee.

anguish cometh upon <u>20\_PRO\_01\_27</u> # When your fear cometh as desolation, and your destruction cometh as a whirlwind; when distress and anguish cometh upon you.

anguish for joy <u>43\_JOH\_16\_21</u> # A woman when she is in travail hath sorrow, because her hour is come: but as soon as she is delivered of the child, she remembereth no more the anguish, for joy that a man is born into the world.

anguish from whence <u>23\_ISA\_30\_06</u># The burden of the beasts of the south: into the land of trouble and anguish, from whence [come] the young and old lion, the viper and fiery flying serpent, they will carry their riches upon the shoulders of young asses, and their treasures upon the bunches of camels, to a people [that] shall not profit [them].

anguish hath taken <u>24\_JER\_06\_24</u> # We have heard the fame thereof: our hands wax feeble: anguish hath taken hold of us, [and] pain, as of a woman in travail.

anguish have taken <u>19\_PSA\_119\_143</u># Trouble and anguish have taken hold on me: [yet] thy commandments [are] my delights.

anguish is come <u>10\_2SA\_01\_09</u> # He said unto me again, Stand, I pray thee, upon me, and slay me: for anguish is come upon me, because my life [is] yet whole in me.

anguish of heart <u>47\_2CO\_02\_04</u> # For out of much affliction and anguish of heart I wrote unto you with many tears; not that ye should be grieved, but that ye might know the love which I have more abundantly unto you.

anguish of his <u>01\_GEN\_42\_21</u># And they said one to another, We [are] verily guilty concerning our brother, in that we saw the anguish of his soul, when he besought us, and we would not hear; therefore is this distress come upon us.

anguish of my <u>18\_JOB\_07\_11</u># Therefore I will not refrain my mouth; I will speak in the anguish of my spirit; I will complain in the bitterness of my soul.

anguish of spirit <u>02\_EXO\_06\_09</u> # And Moses spake so unto the children of Israel: but they hearkened not unto Moses for anguish of spirit, and for cruel bondage.

anguish shall make <u>18\_JOB\_15\_24</u># Trouble and anguish shall make him afraid; they shall prevail against him, as a king ready to the battle.

anguish took hold <u>24\_JER\_50\_43</u> # The king of Babylon hath heard the report of them, and his hands waxed feeble: anguish took hold of him, [and] pangs as of a woman in travail.

anguish upon every <u>45\_ROM\_02\_09</u># Tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that doeth evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile;

languish and the <u>23\_ISA\_16\_08</u> # For the fields of Heshbon languish, [and] the vine of Sibmah: the lords of the heathen have broken down the principal plants thereof, they are come [even] unto Jazer, they wandered [through] the wilderness: her branches are stretched out, they are gone over the sea.

languish they are <u>24\_JER\_14\_02</u> # Judah mourneth, and the gates thereof languish; they are black unto the ground; and the cry of Jerusalem is gone up.

languish with the <u>28\_HOS\_04\_03</u># Therefore shall the land mourn, and every one that dwelleth therein shall languish, with the beasts of the field, and with the fowls of heaven; yea, the fishes of the sea also shall be taken away.

languish <u>23\_ISA\_19\_08</u># The fishers also shall mourn, and all they that cast angle into the brooks shall lament, and they that spread nets upon the waters shall languish.

languish <u>23\_ISA\_24\_04</u> # The earth mourneth [and] fadeth away, the world languisheth [and] fadeth away, the haughty people of the earth do languish.

languished together <u>25\_LAM\_02\_08</u> # The LORD hath purposed to destroy the wall of the daughter of Zion: he hath stretched out a line, he hath not withdrawn his hand from destroying: therefore he made the rampart and the wall to lament; they languished together.

languisheth all the <u>23\_ISA\_24\_07</u> # The new wine mourneth, the vine languisheth, all the merryhearted do sigh.

languisheth and Carmel <u>34\_NAH\_01\_04</u># He rebuketh the sea, and maketh it dry, and drieth up all the rivers: Bashan languisheth, and Carmel, and the flower of Lebanon languisheth.

languisheth and fadeth <u>23\_ISA\_24\_04</u> # The earth mourneth [and] fadeth away, the world languisheth [and] fadeth away, the haughty people of the earth do languish.

languisheth Lebanon is <u>23\_ISA\_33\_09</u># The earth mourneth [and] languisheth: Lebanon is ashamed [and] hewn down: Sharon is like a wilderness; and Bashan and Carmel shake off [their fruits].

languisheth she hath <u>24\_JER\_15\_09</u> # She that hath borne seven languisheth: she hath given up the ghost; her sun is gone down while [it was] yet day: she hath been ashamed and confounded: and the residue of them will I deliver to the sword before their enemies, saith the LORD.

languisheth the pomegranate <u>29\_JOE\_01\_12</u> # The vine is dried up, and the fig tree languisheth; the pomegranate tree, the palm tree also, and the apple tree, [even] all the trees of the field, are withered: because joy is withered away from the sons of men.

languisheth <u>29\_JOE\_01\_10</u> # The field is wasted, the land mourneth; for the corn is wasted: the new wine is dried up, the oil languisheth.

languisheth <u>34\_NAH\_01\_04</u> # He rebuketh the sea, and maketh it dry, and drieth up all the rivers: Bashan
