appeal unto Caesar [44 ACT 25 11](#) # For if I be an offender, or have committed any thing worthy of death, I refuse not to die: but if there be none of these things whereof these accuse me, no man may deliver me unto them. I appeal unto Caesar.

appeal unto Caesar [44 ACT 28 19](#) # But when the Jews spake against [it], I was constrained to appeal unto Caesar; not that I had ought to accuse my nation of.

appealed to Augustus [44 ACT 25 25](#) # But when I found that he had committed nothing worthy of death, and that he himself hath appealed to Augustus, I have determined to send him.

appealed to be [44 ACT 25 21](#) # But when Paul had appealed to be reserved unto the hearing of Augustus, I commanded him to be kept till I might send him to Caesar.

appealed unto Caesar [44 ACT 25 12](#) # Then Festus, when he had conferred with the council, answered, Hast thou appealed unto Caesar? unto Caesar shalt thou go.

appealed unto Caesar [44 ACT 26 32](#) # Then said Agrippa unto Festus, This man might have been set at liberty, if he had not appealed unto Caesar.
