ariseth a little [11 1KI 18 44](#) # And it came to pass at the seventh time, that he said, Behold, there ariseth a little cloud out of the sea, like a man's hand. And he said, Go up, say unto Ahab, Prepare [thy chariot], and get thee down, that the rain stop thee not.

ariseth and the [21 ECC 01 05](#) # The sun also ariseth, and the sun goeth down, and hasteth to his place where he arose.

ariseth another priest [58 HEB 07 15](#) # And it is yet far more evident: for that after the similitude of Melchisedec there ariseth another priest,

ariseth they flee [34 NAH 03 17](#) # Thy crowned [are] as the locusts, and thy captains as the great grasshoppers, which camp in the hedges in the cold day, [but] when the sun ariseth they flee away, and their place is not known where they [are].

ariseth they gather [19 PSA 104 22](#) # The sun ariseth, they gather themselves together, and lay them down in their dens.

ariseth to shake [23 ISA 02 19](#) # And they shall go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth.

ariseth to shake [23 ISA 02 21](#) # To go into the clefts of the rocks, and into the tops of the ragged rocks, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth.
