ariseth a little 11 1KI 18 44 # And it came to pass at the seventh time, that he said, Behold, there ariseth a little cloud out of the sea, like a man's hand. And he said, Go up, say unto Ahab, Prepare [thy chariot], and get thee down, that the rain stop thee not.

ariseth and the <u>21\_ECC\_01\_05</u># The sun also ariseth, and the sun goeth down, and hasteth to his place where he arose.

ariseth another priest <u>58\_HEB\_07\_15</u># And it is yet far more evident: for that after the similitude of Melchisedec there ariseth another priest,

ariseth because of 40 MAT\_13\_21 # Yet hath he not root in himself, but dureth for a while: for when tribulation or persecution ariseth because of the word, by and by he is offended.

ariseth for the <u>41\_MAR\_04\_17</u> # And have no root in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended.

ariseth light in 19\_PSA\_112\_04 # Unto the upright there ariseth light in the darkness: [he is] gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous.

ariseth no prophet 43\_JOH\_07\_52 # They answered and said unto him, Art thou also of Galilee? Search, and look: for out of Galilee ariseth no prophet.

ariseth they flee <u>34\_NAH\_03\_17</u> # Thy crowned [are] as the locusts, and thy captains as the great grasshoppers, which camp in the hedges in the cold day, [but] when the sun ariseth they flee away, and their place is not known where they [are].

ariseth they gather 19\_PSA\_104\_22 # The sun ariseth, they gather themselves together, and lay them down in their dens.

ariseth to shake 23\_ISA\_02\_19 # And they shall go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth.

ariseth to shake <u>23\_ISA\_02\_21</u># To go into the clefts of the rocks, and into the tops of the ragged rocks, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth.
