aware and will [42 LUK 12 46](#) # The lord of that servant will come in a day when he looketh not for [him], and at an hour when he is not aware, and will cut him in sunder, and will appoint him his portion with the unbelievers.

aware my soul [22 SON 06 12](#) # Or ever I was aware, my soul made me [like] the chariots of Amminadib.

aware of them [42 LUK 11 44](#) # Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye are as graves which appear not, and the men that walk over [them] are not aware [of them].

aware of [40 MAT 24 50](#) # The lord of that servant shall come in a day when he looketh not for [him], and in an hour that he is not aware of,

aware thou art [24 JER 50 24](#) # I have laid a snare for thee, and thou art also taken, O Babylon, and thou wast not aware: thou art found, and also caught, because thou hast striven against the LORD.

unawares and hated [05 DEU 04 42](#) # That the slayer might flee thither, which should kill his neighbour unawares, and hated him not in times past; and that fleeing unto one of these cities he might live:

unawares and let [19 PSA 35 08](#) # Let destruction come upon him at unawares; and let his net that he hath hid catch himself: into that very destruction let him fall.

unawares and unwittingly [06 JOS 20 03](#) # That the slayer that killeth [any] person unawares [and] unwittingly may flee thither: and they shall be your refuge from the avenger of blood.

unawares brought in [48 GAL 02 04](#) # And that because of false brethren unawares brought in, who came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage:

unawares may flee [04 NUM 35 15](#) # These six cities shall be a refuge, [both] for the children of Israel, and for the stranger, and for the sojourner among them: that every one that killeth any person unawares may flee thither.

unawares might flee [06 JOS 20 09](#) # These were the cities appointed for all the children of Israel, and for the stranger that sojourneth among them, that whosoever killeth [any] person at unawares might flee thither, and not die by the hand of the avenger of blood, until he stood before the congregation.

unawares to Laban [01 GEN 31 20](#) # And Jacob stole away unawares to Laban the Syrian, in that he told him not that he fled.

unawares to me [01 GEN 31 26](#) # And Laban said to Jacob, What hast thou done, that thou hast stolen away unawares to me, and carried away my daughters, as captives [taken] with the sword?

unawares who were [65 JDE 01 04](#) # For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.

unawares [58 HEB 13 02](#) # Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.

unawares [42 LUK 21 34](#) # And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and [so] that day come upon you unawares.

unawares [04 NUM 35 11](#) # Then ye shall appoint you cities to be cities of refuge for you; that the slayer may flee thither, which killeth any person at unawares.
