blow against thee <u>26\_EZE\_21\_31</u># And I will pour out mine indignation upon thee, I will blow against thee in the fire of my wrath, and deliver thee into the hand of brutish men, [and] skilful to destroy.

blow an alarm <u>04\_NUM\_10\_05</u># When ye blow an alarm, then the camps that lie on the east parts shall go forward.

blow an alarm <u>04\_NUM\_10\_06</u> # When ye blow an alarm the second time, then the camps that lie on the south side shall take their journey: they shall blow an alarm for their journeys.

blow an alarm <u>04\_NUM\_10\_06</u> # When ye blow an alarm the second time, then the camps that lie on the south side shall take their journey: they shall blow an alarm for their journeys.

blow an alarm <u>04\_NUM\_10\_09</u># And if ye go to war in your land against the enemy that oppresseth you, then ye shall blow an alarm with the trumpets; and ye shall be remembered before the LORD your God, and ye shall be saved from your enemies.

blow and the <u>19\_PSA\_147\_18</u># He sendeth out his word, and melteth them: he causeth his wind to blow, [and] the waters flow.

blow but with <u>04\_NUM\_10\_04</u> # And if they blow [but] with one [trumpet], then the princes, [which are] heads of the thousands of Israel, shall gather themselves unto thee.

blow but ye <u>04\_NUM\_10\_07</u># But when the congregation is to be gathered together, ye shall blow, but ye shall not sound an alarm.

blow in his <u>04\_NUM\_31\_06</u> # And Moses sent them to the war, a thousand of [every] tribe, them and Phinehas the son of Eleazar the priest, to the war, with the holy instruments, and the trumpets to blow in his hand.

blow in the <u>19\_PSA\_78\_26</u># He caused an east wind to blow in the heaven: and by his power he brought in the south wind.

blow not the <u>26\_EZE\_33\_06</u> # But if the watchman see the sword come, and blow not the trumpet, and the people be not warned; if the sword come, and take [any] person from among them, he is taken away in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at the watchman's hand.

blow of thine <u>19\_PSA\_39\_10</u> # Remove thy stroke away from me: I am consumed by the blow of thine hand.

blow on the <u>66\_REV\_07\_01</u> # And after these things I saw four angels standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree.

blow the fire <u>26\_EZE\_22\_20</u> # [As] they gather silver, and brass, and iron, and lead, and tin, into the midst of the furnace, to blow the fire upon it, to melt [it]; so will I gather [you] in mine anger and in my fury, and I will leave [you there], and melt you.

blow the trumpet <u>26\_EZE\_33\_03</u> # If when he seeth the sword come upon the land, he blow the trumpet,

blow the trumpet <u>24\_JER\_51\_27</u> # Set ye up a standard in the land, blow the trumpet among the nations, prepare the nations against her, call together against her the kingdoms of Ararat, Minni, and Ashchenaz; appoint a captain against her; cause the horses to come up as the rough caterpillars.

Blow the trumpet <u>29\_JOE\_02\_15</u> # Blow the trumpet in Zion, sanctify a fast, call a solemn assembly:

blow the trumpet <u>38\_ZEC\_09\_14</u> # And the LORD shall be seen over them, and his arrow shall go forth as the lightning: and the Lord GOD shall blow the trumpet, and shall go with whirlwinds of the south.

Blow up the <u>19\_PSA\_81\_03</u> # Blow up the trumpet in the new moon, in the time appointed, on our solemn feast day.

blow upon it <u>37\_HAG\_01\_09</u> # Ye looked for much, and, lo, [it came] to little; and when ye brought [it] home, I did blow upon it. Why? saith the LORD of hosts. Because of mine house that [is] waste, and ye run every man unto his own house.

blow upon my <u>22\_SON\_04\_16</u> # Awake, O north wind; and come, thou south; blow upon my garden, [that] the spices thereof may flow out. Let my beloved come into his garden, and eat his pleasant fruits.

blow upon them <u>23\_ISA\_40\_24</u> # Yea, they shall not be planted; yea, they shall not be sown: yea, their stock shall not take root in the earth: and he shall also blow upon them, and they shall wither, and the whirlwind shall take them away as stubble.

blow upon you <u>26\_EZE\_22\_21</u># Yea, I will gather you, and blow upon you in the fire of my wrath, and ye shall be melted in the midst thereof.

blow with a <u>07\_JUD\_07\_18</u># When I blow with a trumpet, I and all that [are] with me, then blow ye the trumpets also on every side of all the camp, and say, [The sword] of the LORD, and of Gideon.

blow with the <u>13\_1CH\_15\_24</u> # And Shebaniah, and Jehoshaphat, and Nethaneel, and Amasai, and Zechariah, and Benaiah, and Eliezer, the priests, did blow with the trumpets before the ark of God: and Obededom and Jehiah [were] doorkeepers for the ark.

blow with the <u>06\_JOS\_06\_04</u> # And seven priests shall bear before the ark seven trumpets of rams' horns: and the seventh day ye shall compass the city seven times, and the priests shall blow with the trumpets.

blow with the <u>04\_NUM\_10\_08</u> # And the sons of Aaron, the priests, shall blow with the trumpets; and they shall be to you for an ordinance for ever throughout your generations.

blow with the <u>04\_NUM\_10\_10</u> # Also in the day of your gladness, and in your solemn days, and in the beginnings of your months, ye shall blow with the trumpets over your burnt offerings, and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings; that they may be to you for a memorial before your God: I [am] the LORD your God.

blow with them <u>04\_NUM\_10\_03</u> # And when they shall blow with them, all the assembly shall assemble themselves to thee at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation.

blow with thy <u>02\_EXO\_15\_10</u># Thou didst blow with thy wind, the sea covered them: they sank as lead in the mighty waters.

blow withal and <u>07\_JUD\_07\_20</u># And the three companies blew the trumpets, and brake the pitchers, and held the lamps in their left hands, and the trumpets in their right hands to blow [withal]: and they cried, The sword of the LORD, and of Gideon.

blow ye say <u>42\_LUK\_12\_55</u> # And when [ye see] the south wind blow, ye say, There will be heat; and it cometh to pass.

Blow ye the <u>28\_HOS\_05\_08</u># Blow ye the cornet in Gibeah, [and] the trumpet in Ramah: cry aloud [at] Bethaven, after thee, O Benjamin.

Blow ye the <u>24\_JER\_04\_05</u> # Declare ye in Judah, and publish in Jerusalem; and say, Blow ye the trumpet in the land: cry, gather together, and say, Assemble yourselves, and let us go into the defenced cities.

Blow ye the <u>29\_JOE\_02\_01</u> # Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my holy mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble: for the day of the LORD cometh, for [it is] nigh at hand;

blow ye the <u>07\_JUD\_07\_18</u># When I blow with a trumpet, I and all that [are] with me, then blow ye the trumpets also on every side of all the camp, and say, [The sword] of the LORD, and of Gideon.

blow ye with <u>11\_1KI\_01\_34</u># And let Zadok the priest and Nathan the prophet anoint him there king over Israel: and blow ye with the trumpet, and say, God save king Solomon.

blow <u>24\_JER\_14\_17</u> # Therefore thou shalt say this word unto them; Let mine eyes run down with tears night and day, and let them not cease: for the virgin daughter of my people is broken with a great breach, with a very grievous blow.

bloweth a trumpet <u>23\_ISA\_18\_03</u> # All ye inhabitants of the world, and dwellers on the earth, see ye, when he lifteth up an ensign on the mountains; and when he bloweth a trumpet, hear ye.

bloweth the coals <u>23\_ISA\_54\_16</u> # Behold, I have created the smith that bloweth the coals in the fire, and that bringeth forth an instrument for his work; and I have created the waster to destroy.

bloweth upon it <u>23\_ISA\_40\_07</u> # The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: because the spirit of the LORD bloweth upon it: surely the people [is] grass.

bloweth where it <u>43\_JOH\_03\_08</u># The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

blowing of trumpets <u>03\_LEV\_23\_24</u># Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first [day] of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation.

blowing the trumpets <u>04\_NUM\_29\_01</u> # And in the seventh month, on the first [day] of the month, ye shall have an holy convocation; ye shall do no servile work: it is a day of blowing the trumpets unto you.

blowing with the <u>06\_JOS\_06\_09</u># And the armed men went before the priests that blew with the trumpets, and the rereward came after the ark, [the priests] going on, and blowing with the trumpets.

blowing with the <u>06\_JOS\_06\_13</u> # And seven priests bearing seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark of the LORD went on continually, and blew with the trumpets: and the armed men went before them; but the rereward came after the ark of the LORD, [the priests] going on, and blowing with the trumpets.

blown and they <u>23\_ISA\_27\_13</u> # And it shall come to pass in that day, [that] the great trumpet shall be blown, and they shall come which were ready to perish in the land of Assyria, and the outcasts in the land

of Egypt, and shall worship the LORD in the holy mount at Jerusalem.

blown in the <u>30\_AMO\_03\_06</u> # Shall a trumpet be blown in the city, and the people not be afraid? shall there be evil in a city, and the LORD hath not done [it]?

blown shall consume <u>18\_JOB\_20\_26</u> # All darkness [shall be] hid in his secret places: a fire not blown shall consume him; it shall go ill with him that is left in his tabernacle.

blown the trumpet <u>26\_EZE\_07\_14</u># They have blown the trumpet, even to make all ready; but none goeth to the battle: for my wrath [is] upon all the multitude thereof.
