abroad among the <u>43\_JOH\_21\_23</u># Then went this saying abroad among the brethren, that that disciple should not die: yet Jesus said not unto him, He shall not die; but, If I will that he tarry till I come, what [is that] to thee?

abroad among the <u>16\_NEH\_01\_08</u> # Remember, I beseech thee, the word that thou commandedst thy servant Moses, saying, [If] ye transgress, I will scatter you abroad among the nations:

abroad and dispersed <u>17\_EST\_03\_08</u> # And Haman said unto king Ahasuerus, There is a certain people scattered abroad and dispersed among the people in all the provinces of thy kingdom; and their laws [are] diverse from all people; neither keep they the king's laws: therefore it [is] not for the king's profit to suffer them.

abroad and he <u>41\_MAR\_06\_14</u> # And king Herod heard [of him]; [for his name was spread abroad:] and he said, That John the Baptist was risen from the dead, and therefore mighty works do show forth themselves in him.

abroad and rivers <u>20\_PRO\_05\_16</u># Let thy fountains be dispersed abroad, [and] rivers of waters in the streets.

abroad and said <u>01\_GEN\_15\_05</u># And he brought him forth abroad, and said, Look now toward heaven, and tell the stars, if thou be able to number them: and he said unto him, So shall thy seed be.

abroad and the <u>05\_DEU\_24\_11</u># Thou shalt stand abroad, and the man to whom thou dost lend shall bring out the pledge abroad unto thee.

abroad and the <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_17</u> # Cry yet, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; My cities through prosperity shall yet be spread abroad; and the LORD shall yet comfort Zion, and shall yet choose Jerusalem.

abroad and took <u>07\_JUD\_12\_09</u> # And he had thirty sons, and thirty daughters, [whom] he sent abroad, and took in thirty daughters from abroad for his sons. And he judged Israel seven years.

abroad and upon <u>24\_JER\_06\_11</u># Therefore I am full of the fury of the LORD; I am weary with holding in: I will pour it out upon the children abroad, and upon the assembly of young men together: for even the husband with the wife shall be taken, the aged with [him that is] full of days.

abroad any whither <u>11\_1KI\_02\_42</u># And the king sent and called for Shimei, and said unto him, Did I not make thee to swear by the LORD, and protested unto thee, saying, Know for a certain, on the day thou goest out, and walkest abroad any whither, that thou shalt surely die? and thou saidst unto me, The word [that] I have heard [is] good.

abroad as sheep <u>40\_MAT\_09\_36</u># But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.

abroad as the <u>38\_ZEC\_02\_06</u> # Ho, ho, [come forth], and flee from the land of the north, saith the LORD: for I have spread you abroad as the four winds of the heaven, saith the LORD.

abroad even their <u>03\_LEV\_18\_09</u># The nakedness of thy sister, the daughter of thy father, or daughter of

thy mother, [whether she be] born at home, or born abroad, [even] their nakedness thou shalt not uncover.

abroad even to <u>14\_2CH\_26\_08</u> # And the Ammonites gave gifts to Uzziah: and his name spread abroad [even] to the entering in of Egypt; for he strengthened [himself] exceedingly.

abroad for bread <u>18\_JOB\_15\_23</u># He wandereth abroad for bread, [saying], Where [is it]? he knoweth that the day of darkness is ready at his hand.

abroad for he <u>14\_2CH\_26\_15</u> # And he made in Jerusalem engines, invented by cunning men, to be on the towers and upon the bulwarks, to shoot arrows and great stones withal. And his name spread far abroad; for he was marvellously helped, till he was strong.

abroad for his <u>07\_JUD\_12\_09</u># And he had thirty sons, and thirty daughters, [whom] he sent abroad, and took in thirty daughters from abroad for his sons. And he judged Israel seven years.

abroad for themselves <u>04\_NUM\_11\_32</u># And the people stood up all that day, and all [that] night, and all the next day, and they gathered the quails: he that gathered least gathered ten homers: and they spread [them] all abroad for themselves round about the camp.

abroad greeting <u>59\_JAM\_01\_01</u># James, a servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, to the twelve tribes which are scattered abroad, greeting.

abroad he hath <u>47\_2CO\_09\_09</u> # [As it is written, He hath dispersed abroad; he hath given to the poor: his righteousness remaineth for ever.

abroad he telleth <u>19\_PSA\_41\_06</u> # And if he come to see [me], he speaketh vanity: his heart gathereth iniquity to itself; [when] he goeth abroad, he telleth [it].

abroad her wings <u>05\_DEU\_32\_11</u># As an eagle stirreth up her nest, fluttereth over her young, spreadeth abroad her wings, taketh them, beareth them on her wings:

abroad his fame <u>40\_MAT\_09\_31</u># But they, when they were departed, spread abroad his fame in all that country.

abroad that he <u>01\_GEN\_19\_17</u># And it came to pass, when they had brought them forth abroad, that he said, Escape for thy life; look not behind thee, neither stay thou in all the plain; escape to the mountain, lest thou be consumed.

abroad the fitches <u>23\_ISA\_28\_25</u> # When he hath made plain the face thereof, doth he not cast abroad the fitches, and scatter the cummin, and cast in the principal wheat and the appointed barley and the rie in their place?

abroad the inhabitants <u>23\_ISA\_24\_01</u> # Behold, the LORD maketh the earth empty, and maketh it waste, and turneth it upside down, and scattereth abroad the inhabitants thereof.

abroad the matter <u>41\_MAR\_01\_45</u> # But he went out, and began to publish [it] much, and to blaze abroad the matter, insomuch that Jesus could no more openly enter into the city, but was without in desert places: and they came to him from every quarter.

abroad the sword <u>25\_LAM\_01\_20</u># Behold, O LORD; for I [am] in distress: my bowels are troubled; mine heart is turned within me; for I have grievously rebelled: abroad the sword bereaveth, at home [there is] as death.

abroad the tent <u>02\_EXO\_40\_19</u> # And he spread abroad the tent over the tabernacle, and put the covering of the tent above upon it; as the LORD commanded Moses.

abroad thou shalt <u>05\_DEU\_23\_13</u> # And thou shalt have a paddle upon thy weapon; and it shall be, when thou wilt ease thyself abroad, thou shalt dig therewith, and shalt turn back and cover that which cometh from thee:
