Babylon is taken <u>24_JER_50_02</u> # Declare ye among the nations, and publish, and set up a standard; publish, [and] conceal not: say, Babylon is taken, Bel is confounded, Merodach is broken in pieces; her idols are confounded, her images are broken in pieces.

Babylon Jechonias begat 40 MAT_01_12 # And after they were brought to Babylon, Jechonias begat Salathiel; and Salathiel begat Zorobabel;

Babylon made governor 24_JER_41_18 # Because of the Chaldeans: for they were afraid of them, because Ishmael the son of Nethaniah had slain Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, whom the king of Babylon made governor in the land.

Babylon made king 24_JER_37_01 # And king Zedekiah the son of Josiah reigned instead of Coniah the son of Jehoiakim, whom Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon made king in the land of Judah.

Babylon made Mattaniah 12 2KI 24 17 # And the king of Babylon made Mattaniah his father's brother king in his stead, and changed his name to Zedekiah.

Babylon made Succothbenoth 12_2KI_17_30 # And the men of Babylon made Succothbenoth, and the men of Cuth made Nergal, and the men of Hamath made Ashima,

Babylon make the <u>24_JER_51_12</u># Set up the standard upon the walls of Babylon, make the watch strong, set up the watchmen, prepare the ambushes: for the LORD hath both devised and done that which he spake against the inhabitants of Babylon.

Babylon maketh war 24_JER_21_02 # Inquire, I pray thee, of the LORD for us; for Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon maketh war against us; if so be that the LORD will deal with us according to all his wondrous works, that he may go up from us.

Babylon round about <u>24_JER_50_14</u> # Put yourselves in array against Babylon round about: all ye that bend the bow, shoot at her, spare no arrows: for she hath sinned against the LORD.

Babylon set himself <u>26_EZE_24_02</u># Son of man, write thee the name of the day, [even] of this same day: the king of Babylon set himself against Jerusalem this same day.

Babylon seventy years 24_JER_25_11 # And this whole land shall be a desolation, [and] an astonishment; and these nations shall serve the king of Babylon seventy years.

Babylon Shadrach Meshach <u>27_DAN_03_12</u> # There are certain Jews whom thou hast set over the affairs of the province of Babylon, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego; these men, O king, have not regarded thee: they serve not thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.

Babylon that mighty <u>66_REV_18_10</u> # Standing afar off for the fear of her torment, saying, Alas, alas that great city Babylon, that mighty city! for in one hour is thy judgment come.

Babylon that nation 24 JER 27 08 # And it shall come to pass, [that] the nation and kingdom which will not serve the same Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, and that will not put their neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, that nation will I punish, saith the LORD, with the sword, and with the famine, and with the pestilence, until I have consumed them by his hand.

Babylon where they <u>14_2CH_36_20</u> # And them that had escaped from the sword carried he away to Babylon; where they were servants to him and his sons until the reign of the kingdom of Persia:

Babylon whether it <u>15_EZR_05_17</u># Now therefore, if [it seem] good to the king, let there be search made in the king's treasure house, which [is] there at Babylon, whether it be [so], that a decree was made of Cyrus the king to build this house of God at Jerusalem, and let the king send his pleasure to us concerning this matter.

Babylon which Isaiah 23_ISA_13_01 # The burden of Babylon, which Isaiah the son of Amoz did see.

Babylon who art 19_PSA_137_08 # O daughter of Babylon, who art to be destroyed; happy [shall he be], that rewardeth thee as thou hast served us.

Babylon who sent 14_2CH_32_31 # Howbeit in [the business of] the ambassadors of the princes of Babylon, who sent unto him to inquire of the wonder that was [done] in the land, God left him, to try him, that he might know all [that was] in his heart.

Babylon Whosoever shall <u>27_DAN_05_07</u> # The king cried aloud to bring in the astrologers, the Chaldeans, and the soothsayers. [And] the king spake, and said to the wise [men] of Babylon, Whosoever shall read this writing, and show me the interpretation thereof, shall be clothed with scarlet, and [have] a chain of gold about his neck, and shall be the third ruler in the kingdom.

Babylon with the 14_2CH_36_10 # And when the year was expired, king Nebuchadnezzar sent, and brought him to Babylon, with the goodly vessels of the house of the LORD, and made Zedekiah his brother king over Judah and Jerusalem.

Babylon with the <u>12_2KI_25_11</u># Now the rest of the people [that were] left in the city, and the fugitives that fell away to the king of Babylon, with the remnant of the multitude, did Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carry away.

Babylon with the <u>15_EZR_07_16</u># And all the silver and gold that thou canst find in all the province of Babylon, with the freewill offering of the people, and of the priests, offering willingly for the house of their God which [is] in Jerusalem:

Babylon <u>14_2CH_33_11</u># Wherefore the LORD brought upon them the captains of the host of the king of Assyria, which took Manasseh among the thorns, and bound him with fetters, and carried him to Babylon.

Babylon <u>14_2CH_36_06</u> # Against him came up Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, and bound him in fetters, to carry him to Babylon.

Babylon <u>14_2CH_36_07</u> # Nebuchadnezzar also carried of the vessels of the house of the LORD to Babylon, and put them in his temple at Babylon.

Babylon 14_2CH_36_18 # And all the vessels of the house of God, great and small, and the treasures of the house of the LORD, and the treasures of the king, and of his princes; all [these] he brought to Babylon.

Babylon <u>12_2KI_20_14</u># Then came Isaiah the prophet unto king Hezekiah, and said unto him, What said these men? and from whence came they unto thee? And Hezekiah said, They are come from a far country, [even] from Babylon.

Babylon 12_2KI_20_18 # And of thy sons that shall issue from thee, which thou shalt beget, shall they take away; and they shall be eunuchs in the palace of the king of Babylon.

Babylon <u>12_2KI_24_15</u> # And he carried away Jehoiachin to Babylon, and the king's mother, and the king's wives, and his officers, and the mighty of the land, [those] carried he into captivity from Jerusalem to Babylon.

Babylon 12_2KI_24_16 # And all the men of might, [even] seven thousand, and craftsmen and smiths a thousand, all [that were] strong [and] apt for war, even them the king of Babylon brought captive to Babylon.

Babylon 12_2KI_24_20 # For through the anger of the LORD it came to pass in Jerusalem and Judah, until he had cast them out from his presence, that Zedekiah rebelled against the king of Babylon.

Babylon 12_2KI_25_07 # And they slew the sons of Zedekiah before his eyes, and put out the eyes of Zedekiah, and bound him with fetters of brass, and carried him to Babylon.

Babylon 12_2KI_25_13 # And the pillars of brass that [were] in the house of the LORD, and the bases, and the brazen sea that [was] in the house of the LORD, did the Chaldees break in pieces, and carried the brass of them to Babylon.

Babylon 12_2KI_25_28 # And he spake kindly to him, and set his throne above the throne of the kings that [were] with him in Babylon;

Babylon <u>44_ACT_07_43</u> # Yea, ye took up the tabernacle of Moloch, and the star of your god Remphan, figures which ye made to worship them: and I will carry you away beyond Babylon.

Babylon <u>27_DAN_02_12</u> # For this cause the king was angry and very furious, and commanded to destroy all the wise [men] of Babylon.

Babylon <u>27_DAN_02_14</u> # Then Daniel answered with counsel and wisdom to Arioch the captain of the king's guard, which was gone forth to slay the wise [men] of Babylon:

Babylon <u>27_DAN_02_18</u># That they would desire mercies of the God of heaven concerning this secret; that Daniel and his fellows should not perish with the rest of the wise [men] of Babylon.

Babylon <u>27_DAN_02_48</u># Then the king made Daniel a great man, and gave him many great gifts, and made him ruler over the whole province of Babylon, and chief of the governors over all the wise [men] of Babylon.

Babylon <u>27_DAN_03_01</u> # Nebuchadnezzar the king made an image of gold, whose height [was] threescore cubits, [and] the breadth thereof six cubits: he set it up in the plain of Dura, in the province of Babylon.

Babylon 27_DAN_03_30 # Then the king promoted Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, in the province of

Babylon.

Babylon 27_DAN_04_29 # At the end of twelve months he walked in the palace of the kingdom of Babylon.

Babylon <u>26_EZE_17_12</u> # Say now to the rebellious house, Know ye not what these [things mean]? tell [them], Behold, the king of Babylon is come to Jerusalem, and hath taken the king thereof, and the princes thereof, and led them with him to Babylon;

Babylon <u>26_EZE_30_10</u> # Thus saith the Lord GOD; I will also make the multitude of Egypt to cease by the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon.

Babylon <u>15_EZR_05_12</u> # But after that our fathers had provoked the God of heaven unto wrath, he gave them into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, the Chaldean, who destroyed this house, and carried the people away into Babylon.

Babylon <u>15_EZR_06_01</u> # Then Darius the king made a decree, and search was made in the house of the rolls, where the treasures were laid up in Babylon.

Babylon <u>23_ISA_39_03</u># Then came Isaiah the prophet unto king Hezekiah, and said unto him, What said these men? and from whence came they unto thee? And Hezekiah said, They are come from a far country unto me, [even] from Babylon.

Babylon 23_ISA_39_07 # And of thy sons that shall issue from thee, which thou shalt beget, shall they take away; and they shall be eunuchs in the palace of the king of Babylon.

Babylon 24_JER_20_05 # Moreover I will deliver all the strength of this city, and all the labours thereof, and all the precious things thereof, and all the treasures of the kings of Judah will I give into the hand of their enemies, which shall spoil them, and take them, and carry them to Babylon.

Babylon 24_JER_24_01 # The LORD showed me, and, behold, two baskets of figs [were] set before the temple of the LORD, after that Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon had carried away captive Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah, and the princes of Judah, with the carpenters and smiths, from Jerusalem, and had brought them to Babylon.

Babylon <u>24_JER_25_01</u> # The word that came to Jeremiah concerning all the people of Judah in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah, that [was] the first year of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon;

Babylon <u>24_JER_27_09</u> # Therefore hearken not ye to your prophets, nor to your diviners, nor to your dreamers, nor to your enchanters, nor to your sorcerers, which speak unto you, saying, Ye shall not serve the king of Babylon:

Babylon 24_JER_27_13 # Why will ye die, thou and thy people, by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence, as the LORD hath spoken against the nation that will not serve the king of Babylon?

Babylon <u>24_JER_27_18</u> # But if they [be] prophets, and if the word of the LORD be with them, let them now make intercession to the LORD of hosts, that the vessels which are left in the house of the LORD, and [in] the house of the king of Judah, and at Jerusalem, go not to Babylon.

Babylon <u>24_JER_28_02</u> # Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, saying, I have broken the yoke of the king of Babylon.

Babylon <u>24_JER_28_03</u> # Within two full years will I bring again into this place all the vessels of the LORD'S house, that Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon took away from this place, and carried them to Babylon:

Babylon 24_JER_28_04 # And I will bring again to this place Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah, with all the captives of Judah, that went into Babylon, saith the LORD: for I will break the yoke of the king of Babylon.

Babylon 24_JER_29_01 # Now these [are] the words of the letter that Jeremiah the prophet sent from Jerusalem unto the residue of the elders which were carried away captives, and to the priests, and to the prophets, and to all the people whom Nebuchadnezzar had carried away captive from Jerusalem to Babylon;

Babylon <u>24_JER_29_04</u> # Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, unto all that are carried away captives, whom I have caused to be carried away from Jerusalem unto Babylon;

Babylon 24_JER_29_15 # Because ye have said, The LORD hath raised us up prophets in Babylon;

Babylon <u>24_JER_29_20</u> # Hear ye therefore the word of the LORD, all ye of the captivity, whom I have sent from Jerusalem to Babylon:

Babylon 24_JER_34_03 # And thou shalt not escape out of his hand, but shalt surely be taken, and delivered into his hand; and thine eyes shall behold the eyes of the king of Babylon, and he shall speak with thee mouth to mouth, and thou shalt go to Babylon.

Babylon <u>24_JER_37_17</u> # Then Zedekiah the king sent, and took him out: and the king asked him secretly in his house, and said, Is there [any] word from the LORD? And Jeremiah said, There is: for, said he, thou shalt be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon.

Babylon <u>24_JER_39_03</u> # And all the princes of the king of Babylon came in, and sat in the middle gate, [even] Nergalsharezer, Samgarnebo, Sarsechim, Rabsaris, Nergalsharezer, Rabmag, with all the residue of the princes of the king of Babylon.

Babylon <u>24_JER_39_07</u> # Moreover he put out Zedekiah's eyes, and bound him with chains, to carry him to Babylon.

Babylon 24_JER_40_01 # The word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD, after that Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had let him go from Ramah, when he had taken him being bound in chains among all that were carried away captive of Jerusalem and Judah, which were carried away captive unto Babylon.

Babylon 24_JER_40_07 # Now when all the captains of the forces which [were] in the fields, [even] they and their men, heard that the king of Babylon had made Gedaliah the son of Ahikam governor in the land, and had committed unto him men, and women, and children, and of the poor of the land, of them that were not carried away captive to Babylon;

Babylon <u>24_JER_43_03</u> # But Baruch the son of Neriah setteth thee on against us, for to deliver us into the hand of the Chaldeans, that they might put us to death, and carry us away captives into Babylon.

Babylon <u>24_JER_50_34</u> # Their Redeemer [is] strong; the LORD of hosts [is] his name: he shall thoroughly plead their cause, that he may give rest to the land, and disquiet the inhabitants of Babylon.

Babylon <u>24_JER_50_42</u> # They shall hold the bow and the lance: they [are] cruel, and will not show mercy: their voice shall roar like the sea, and they shall ride upon horses, [every one] put in array, like a man to the battle, against thee, O daughter of Babylon.

Babylon <u>24_JER_51_12</u> # Set up the standard upon the walls of Babylon, make the watch strong, set up the watchmen, prepare the ambushes: for the LORD hath both devised and done that which he spake against the inhabitants of Babylon.

Babylon <u>24_JER_51_60</u> # So Jeremiah wrote in a book all the evil that should come upon Babylon, [even] all these words that are written against Babylon.

Babylon 24_JER_52_03 # For through the anger of the LORD it came to pass in Jerusalem and Judah, till he had cast them out from his presence, that Zedekiah rebelled against the king of Babylon.

Babylon <u>24_JER_52_17</u># Also the pillars of brass that [were] in the house of the LORD, and the bases, and the brazen sea that [was] in the house of the LORD, the Chaldeans brake, and carried all the brass of them to Babylon.

Babylon 24_JER_52_32 # And spake kindly unto him, and set his throne above the throne of the kings that [were] with him in Babylon,

Babylon <u>40_MAT_01_11</u># And Josias begat Jechonias and his brethren, about the time they were carried away to Babylon:

Babylon 38_ZEC_02_07 # Deliver thyself, O Zion, that dwellest [with] the daughter of Babylon.

Babylon's army besieged 24 JER 32 02 # For then the king of Babylon's army besieged Jerusalem: and Jeremiah the prophet was shut up in the court of the prison, which [was] in the king of Judah's house.

Babylon's army fought <u>24_JER_34_07</u> # When the king of Babylon's army fought against Jerusalem, and against all the cities of Judah that were left, against Lachish, and against Azekah: for these defenced cities remained of the cities of Judah.

Babylon's army which 24_JER_34_21# And Zedekiah king of Judah and his princes will I give into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of them that seek their life, and into the hand of the king of Babylon's army, which are gone up from you.

Babylon's army which <u>24_JER_38_03</u> # Thus saith the LORD, This city shall surely be given into the hand of the king of Babylon's army, which shall take it.

Babylon's princes and 24_JER_38_22 # And, behold, all the women that are left in the king of Judah's house [shall be] brought forth to the king of Babylon's princes, and those [women] shall say, Thy friends have set thee on, and have prevailed against thee: thy feet are sunk in the mire, [and] they are turned away back.

Babylon's princes then <u>24_JER_38_17</u> # Then said Jeremiah unto Zedekiah, Thus saith the LORD, the God of hosts, the God of Israel; If thou wilt assuredly go forth unto the king of Babylon's princes, then thy soul shall live, and this city shall not be burned with fire; and thou shall live, and thine house:

Babylon's princes then <u>24_JER_38_18</u># But if thou wilt not go forth to the king of Babylon's princes, then shall this city be given into the hand of the Chaldeans, and they shall burn it with fire, and thou shalt not escape out of their hand.

Babylon's princes <u>24_JER_39_13</u> # So Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard sent, and Nebushasban, Rabsaris, and Nergalsharezer, Rabmag, and all the king of Babylon's princes;

Babylonians and all <u>26_EZE_23_23</u># The Babylonians, and all the Chaldeans, Pekod, and Shoa, and Koa, [and] all the Assyrians with them: all of them desirable young men, captains and rulers, great lords and renowned, all of them riding upon horses.

Babylonians came to <u>26_EZE_23_17</u># And the Babylonians came to her into the bed of love, and they defiled her with their whoredom, and she was polluted with them, and her mind was alienated from them.

Babylonians of Chaldea <u>26_EZE_23_15</u># Girded with girdles upon their loins, exceeding in dyed attire upon their heads, all of them princes to look to, after the manner of the Babylonians of Chaldea, the land of their nativity:

Babylonians the Susanchites <u>15 EZR 04 09 # Then [wrote]</u> Rehum the chancellor, and Shimshai the scribe, and the rest of their companions; the Dinaites, the Apharsathchites, the Tarpelites, the Apharsites, the Archevites, the Babylonians, the Susanchites, the Dehavites, [and] the Elamites,

Babylonish garment and <u>06_JOS_07_21</u> # When I saw among the spoils a goodly Babylonish garment, and two hundred shekels of silver, and a wedge of gold of fifty shekels weight, then I coveted them, and took them; and, behold, they [are] hid in the earth in the midst of my tent, and the silver under it.
