Barabbas and destroy [40 MAT 27 20](#) # But the chief priests and elders persuaded the multitude that they should ask Barabbas, and destroy Jesus.

Barabbas Now Barabbas [43 JOH 18 40](#) # Then cried they all again, saying, Not this man, but Barabbas. Now Barabbas was a robber.

Barabbas or Jesus [40 MAT 27 17](#) # Therefore when they were gathered together, Pilate said unto them, Whom will ye that I release unto you? Barabbas, or Jesus which is called Christ?

Barabbas unto them [41 MAR 15 11](#) # But the chief priests moved the people, that he should rather release Barabbas unto them.

Barabbas unto them [41 MAR 15 15](#) # And [so] Pilate, willing to content the people, released Barabbas unto them, and delivered Jesus, when he had scourged [him], to be crucified.

Barabbas unto them [40 MAT 27 26](#) # Then released he Barabbas unto them: and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered [him] to be crucified.
