Barnabas also was 48 GAL 02 13# And the other Jews dissembled likewise with him; insomuch that Barnabas also was carried away with their dissimulation.

Barnabas and certain 44 ACT 15 02 # When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.

Barnabas and expelled 44 ACT 13 50 # But the Jews stirred up the devout and honourable women, and the chief men of the city, and raised persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and expelled them out of their coasts

Barnabas and Paul 44 ACT 14 14 # [Which] when the apostles, Barnabas and Paul, heard [of], they rent their clothes, and ran in among the people, crying out,

Barnabas and Paul 44 ACT 15 12 # Then all the multitude kept silence, and gave audience to Barnabas and Paul, declaring what miracles and wonders God had wrought among the Gentiles by them.

Barnabas and Paul 44 ACT 15 25 # It seemed good unto us, being assembled with one accord, to send chosen men unto you with our beloved Barnabas and Paul.

Barnabas and Saul 44 ACT 11 30 # Which also they did, and sent it to the elders by the hands of Barnabas and Saul.

Barnabas and Saul 44 ACT 12 25 # And Barnabas and Saul returned from Jerusalem, when they had fulfilled [their] ministry, and took with them John, whose surname was Mark.

Barnabas and Saul 44 ACT 13 02 # As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them.

Barnabas and Saul 44 ACT 13 07 # Which was with the deputy of the country, Sergius Paulus, a prudent man; who called for Barnabas and Saul, and desired to hear the word of God.

Barnabas and Simeon 44 ACT 13 01 # Now there were in the church that was at Antioch certain prophets and teachers; as Barnabas, and Simeon that was called Niger, and Lucius of Cyrene, and Manaen, which had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch, and Saul.

Barnabas continued in 44 ACT 15 35 # Paul also and Barnabas continued in Antioch, teaching and preaching the word of the Lord, with many others also.

Barnabas determined to 44 ACT 15 37 # And Barnabas determined to take with them John, whose surname was Mark.

Barnabas had no 44 ACT 15 02 # When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.

Barnabas have not 46 1CO 09 06 # Or I only and Barnabas, have not we power to forbear working?

Barnabas Jupiter and 44 ACT 14 12 # And they called Barnabas, Jupiter; and Paul, Mercurius, because he was the chief speaker.

Barnabas Let us 44 ACT 15 36 # And some days after Paul said unto Barnabas, Let us go again and visit our brethren in every city where we have preached the word of the Lord, [and see] how they do.

Barnabas namely Judas 44 ACT 15 22 # Then pleased it the apostles and elders, with the whole church, to send chosen men of their own company to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas; [namely], Judas surnamed Barsabas, and Silas, chief men among the brethren:

Barnabas that he 44 ACT 11 22 # Then tidings of these things came unto the ears of the church which was in Jerusalem: and they sent forth Barnabas, that he should go as far as Antioch.

Barnabas the right 48 GAL 02 09 # And when James, Cephas, and John, who seemed to be pillars, perceived the grace that was given unto me, they gave to me and Barnabas the right hands of fellowship; that we [should go] unto the heathen, and they unto the circumcision.

Barnabas to Derbe 44 ACT 14 20 # Howbeit, as the disciples stood round about him, he rose up, and came into the city: and the next day he departed with Barnabas to Derbe.

Barnabas to Tarsus 44 ACT 11 25 # Then departed Barnabas to Tarsus, for to seek Saul:

Barnabas took him 44 ACT 09 27 # But Barnabas took him, and brought [him] to the apostles, and declared unto them how he had seen the Lord in the way, and that he had spoken to him, and how he had preached holdly at Damacrus in the name of Jesus.

Barnabas took Mark 44 ACT 15 39 # And the contention was so sharp between them, that they departed asunder one from the other: and so Barnabas took Mark, and sailed unto Cyprus;

Barnabas touching whom 51 COL 04 10 # Aristarchus my fellowprisoner saluteth you, and Marcus, sister's son to Barnabas, [touching whom ye received commandments: if he come unto you, receive him;]

Barnabas waxed bold 44 ACT 13 46 # Then Paul and Barnabas waxed bold, and said, It was necessary that the word of God should first have been spoken to you: but seeing ye put it from you, and judge yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, lo, we turn to the Gentiles.

Barnabas which is 44 ACT 04 36 # And Joses, who by the apostles was surnamed Barnabas, [which is, being interpreted, The son of consolation,] a Levite, [and] of the country of Cyprus,

Barnabas who speaking 44 ACT 13 43 # Now when the congregation was broken up, many of the Jews and religious proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas: who, speaking to them, persuaded them to continue in the grace of God.
