

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Beor and the 13\_1CH\_01\_43 # Now these [are] the kings that reigned in the land of Edom before [any] king reigned over the children of Israel; Bela the son of Beor: and the name of his city [was] Dinhabah.

Beor answered him <u>33\_MIC\_06\_05</u># O my people, remember now what Balak king of Moab consulted, and what Balaam the son of Beor answered him from Shittim unto Gilgal; that ye may know the righteousness of the LORD.

Beor hath said <u>04\_NUM\_24\_03</u> # And he took up his parable, and said, Balaam the son of Beor hath said, and the man whose eyes are open hath said:

Beor hath said <u>04\_NUM\_24\_15</u># And he took up his parable, and said, Balaam the son of Beor hath said, and the man whose eyes are open hath said:

Beor of Pethor <u>05\_DEU\_23\_04</u># Because they met you not with bread and with water in the way, when ye came forth out of Egypt; and because they hired against thee Balaam the son of Beor of Pethor of Mesopotamia, to curse thee.

Beor reigned in <u>01\_GEN\_36\_32</u> # And Bela the son of Beor reigned in Edom: and the name of his city [was] Dinhabah.

Beor the soothsayer <u>06\_JOS\_13\_22</u> # Balaam also the son of Beor, the soothsayer, did the children of Israel slay with the sword among them that were slain by them.

Beor they slew <u>04\_NUM\_31\_08</u># And they slew the kings of Midian, beside the rest of them that were slain; [namely], Evi, and Rekem, and Zur, and Hur, and Reba, five kings of Midian: Balaam also the son of Beor they slew with the sword.

Beor to curse <u>06\_JOS\_24\_09</u> # Then Balak the son of Zippor, king of Moab, arose and warred against Israel, and sent and called Balaam the son of Beor to curse you:

Beor to Pethor <u>04\_NUM\_22\_05</u># He sent messengers therefore unto Balaam the son of Beor to Pethor, which [is] by the river of the land of the children of his people, to call him, saying, Behold, there is a people come out from Egypt: behold, they cover the face of the earth, and they abide over against me:
