

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

beam and he <u>13\_1CH\_11\_23</u># And he slew an Egyptian, a man of [great] stature, five cubits high; and in the Egyptian's hand [was] a spear like a weaver's beam; and he went down to him with a staff, and plucked the spear out of the Egyptian's hand, and slew him with his own spear.

beam and his <u>09\_1SA\_17\_07</u># And the staff of his spear [was] like a weaver's beam; and his spear's head [weighed] six hundred shekels of iron: and one bearing a shield went before him.

beam and let <u>12\_2KI\_06\_02</u># Let us go, we pray thee, unto Jordan, and take thence every man a beam, and let us make us a place there, where we may dwell. And he answered, Go ye.

beam and with <u>07\_JUD\_16\_14</u># And she fastened [it] with the pin, and said unto him, The Philistines [be] upon thee, Samson. And he awaked out of his sleep, and went away with the pin of the beam, and with the web.

beam is in <u>40\_MAT\_07\_04</u># Or how wilt thou say to thy brother, Let me pull out the mote out of thine eye; and, behold, a beam [is] in thine own eye?

beam out of <u>35\_HAB\_02\_11</u># For the stone shall cry out of the wall, and the beam out of the timber shall answer it.

beam out of <u>42\_LUK\_06\_42</u> # Either how canst thou say to thy brother, Brother, let me pull out the mote that is in thine eye, when thou thyself beholdest not the beam that is in thine own eye? Thou hypocrite, cast out first the beam out of thine own eye, and then shalt thou see clearly to pull out the mote that is in thy brother's eye.

beam out of <u>40\_MAT\_07\_05</u># Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye.

beam that is <u>42\_LUK\_06\_41</u> # And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but perceivest not the beam that is in thine own eye?

beam that is <u>42\_LUK\_06\_42</u> # Either how canst thou say to thy brother, Brother, let me pull out the mote that is in thine eye, when thou thyself beholdest not the beam that is in thine own eye? Thou hypocrite, cast out first the beam out of thine own eye, and then shalt thou see clearly to pull out the mote that is in thy brother's eye.

beam that is <u>40\_MAT\_07\_03</u># And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but considerest not the beam that is in thine own eye?

beam the ax <u>12\_2KI\_06\_05</u> # But as one was felling a beam, the ax head fell into the water: and he cried, and said, Alas, master! for it was borrowed.

beam were before <u>11\_1KI\_07\_06</u># And he made a porch of pillars; the length thereof [was] fifty cubits, and the breadth thereof thirty cubits: and the porch [was] before them: and the [other] pillars and the thick beam [were] before them.

beam <u>13\_1CH\_20\_05</u> # And there was war again with the Philistines; and Elhanan the son of Jair slew Lahmi the brother of Goliath the Gittite, whose spear staff [was] like a weaver's beam.

beam <u>10\_2SA\_21\_19</u># And there was again a battle in Gob with the Philistines, where Elhanan the son of Jaareoregim, a Bethlehemite, slew [the brother of] Goliath the Gittite, the staff of whose spear [was] like a weaver's beam.

beams and boards <u>11\_1KI\_06\_09</u># So he built the house, and finished it; and covered the house with beams and boards of cedar.

beams both for <u>11\_1KI\_07\_12</u># And the great court round about [was] with three rows of hewed stones, and a row of cedar beams, both for the inner court of the house of the LORD, and for the porch of the house.

beams for the <u>16\_NEH\_02\_08</u># And a letter unto Asaph the keeper of the king's forest, that he may give me timber to make beams for the gates of the palace which [appertained] to the house, and for the wall of the city, and for the house that I shall enter into. And the king granted me, according to the good hand of my God upon me.

beams of his <u>19\_PSA\_104\_03</u># Who layeth the beams of his chambers in the waters: who maketh the clouds his chariot: who walketh upon the wings of the wind:

beams of our <u>22\_SON\_01\_17</u># The beams of our house [are] cedar, [and] our rafters of fir.

beams should not <u>11\_1KI\_06\_06</u># The nethermost chamber [was] five cubits broad, and the middle [was] six cubits broad, and the third [was] seven cubits broad: for without [in the wall] of the house he made narrowed rests round about, that [the beams] should not be fastened in the walls of the house.

beams that lay <u>11\_1KI\_07\_03</u># And [it was] covered with cedar above upon the beams, that [lay] on forty five pillars, fifteen [in] a row.

beams the posts <u>14\_2CH\_03\_07</u># He overlaid also the house, the beams, the posts, and the walls thereof, and the doors thereof, with gold; and graved cherubims on the walls.

beams thereof and <u>16\_NEH\_03\_03</u># But the fish gate did the sons of Hassenaah build, who [also] laid the beams thereof, and set up the doors thereof, the locks thereof, and the bars thereof.

beams thereof and <u>16\_NEH\_03\_06</u># Moreover the old gate repaired Jehoiada the son of Paseah, and Meshullam the son of Besodeiah; they laid the beams thereof, and set up the doors thereof, and the locks thereof, and the bars thereof.

beams upon the <u>11\_1KI\_07\_02</u># He built also the house of the forest of Lebanon; the length thereof [was] an hundred cubits, and the breadth thereof fifty cubits, and the height thereof thirty cubits, upon four rows of cedar pillars, with cedar beams upon the pillars.

beams <u>11\_1KI\_06\_36</u># And he built the inner court with three rows of hewed stone, and a row of cedar beams.

Jashobeam an Hachmonite <u>13\_1CH\_11\_11</u># And this [is] the number of the mighty men whom David had; Jashobeam, an Hachmonite, the chief of the captains: he lifted up his spear against three hundred slain [by him] at one time.

Jashobeam the Korhites <u>13\_1CH\_12\_06</u># Elkanah, and Jesiah, and Azareel, and Joezer, and Jashobeam, the Korhites,

Jashobeam the son <u>13\_1CH\_27\_02</u> # Over the first course for the first month [was] Jashobeam the son of Zabdiel: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.
