become a booty <u>36\_ZEP\_01\_13</u># Therefore their goods shall become a booty, and their houses a desolation: they shall also build houses, but not inhabit [them]; and they shall plant vineyards, but not drink the wine thereof.

become a den <u>24\_JER\_07\_11</u># Is this house, which is called by my name, become a den of robbers in your eyes? Behold, even I have seen [it], saith the LORD.

become a desolation <u>12\_2KI\_22\_19</u># Because thine heart was tender, and thou hast humbled thyself before the LORD, when thou heardest what I spake against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, that they should become a desolation and a curse, and hast rent thy clothes, and wept before me; I also have heard [thee], saith the LORD.

become a serpent <u>02\_EXO\_07\_09</u># When Pharaoh shall speak unto you, saying, Show a miracle for you: then thou shalt say unto Aaron, Take thy rod, and cast [it] before Pharaoh, [and] it shall become a serpent.

become a snare <u>19\_PSA\_69\_22</u># Let their table become a snare before them: and [that which should have been] for [their] welfare, [let it become] a trap.

become a spoil <u>26\_EZE\_26\_05</u> # It shall be [a place for] the spreading of nets in the midst of the sea: for I have spoken [it], saith the Lord GOD: and it shall become a spoil to the nations.

become a stranger <u>19\_PSA\_69\_08</u># I am become a stranger unto my brethren, and an alien unto my mother's children.

become a stumblingblock <u>46\_1CO\_08\_09</u> # But take heed lest by any means this liberty of yours become a stumblingblock to them that are weak.

become a thousand <u>23\_ISA\_60\_22</u># A little one shall become a thousand, and a small one a strong nation: I the LORD will hasten it in his time.

become a transgressor <u>59\_JAM\_02\_11</u># For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the law.

become a trap <u>19\_PSA\_69\_22</u># Let their table become a snare before them: and [that which should have been] for [their] welfare, [let it become] a trap.

become an astonishment <u>24\_JER\_51\_41</u># How is Sheshach taken! and how is the praise of the whole earth surprised! how is Babylon become an astonishment among the nations!

become an harlot <u>23\_ISA\_01\_21</u> # How is the faithful city become an harlot! it was full of judgment; righteousness lodged in it; but now murderers.

become another man's <u>24\_JER\_03\_01</u> # They say, If a man put away his wife, and she go from him, and become another man's, shall he return unto her again? shall not that land be greatly polluted? but thou hast played the harlot with many lovers; yet return again to me, saith the LORD.

become as a <u>25\_LAM\_01\_01</u> # How doth the city sit solitary, [that was] full of people! [how] is she become as a widow! she [that was] great among the nations, [and] princess among the provinces, [how] is she become tributary!

become as little <u>40\_MAT\_18\_03</u># And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven.

become as one <u>01\_GEN\_03\_22</u> # And the LORD God said, Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know good and evil: and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live for ever:

become as women <u>24\_JER\_50\_37</u> # A sword [is] upon their horses, and upon their chariots, and upon all the mingled people that [are] in the midst of her; and they shall become as women: a sword [is] upon her treasures; and they shall be robbed.

become bitter and <u>04\_NUM\_05\_27</u> # And when he hath made her to drink the water, then it shall come to pass, [that], if she be defiled, and have done trespass against her husband, that the water that causeth the curse shall enter into her, [and become] bitter, and her belly shall swell, and her thigh shall rot: and the woman shall be a curse among her people.

become dim how <u>25\_LAM\_04\_01</u> # How is the gold become dim! [how] is the most fine gold changed! the stones of the sanctuary are poured out in the top of every street.

become dross all <u>26\_EZE\_22\_18</u># Son of man, the house of Israel is to me become dross: all they [are] brass, and tin, and iron, and lead, in the midst of the furnace; they are [even] the dross of silver.

become dross behold <u>26\_EZE\_22\_19</u># Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Because ye are all become dross, behold, therefore I will gather you into the midst of Jerusalem.

become dross thy <u>23\_ISA\_01\_22</u># Thy silver is become dross, thy wine mixed with water:

become dry and <u>28\_HOS\_13\_15</u># Though he be fruitful among [his] brethren, an east wind shall come, the wind of the LORD shall come up from the wilderness, and his spring shall become dry, and his fountain shall be dried up: he shall spoil the treasure of all pleasant vessels.

become effectual by <u>57\_PHM\_01\_06</u> # That the communication of thy faith may become effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus.

become fenced and <u>26 EZE 36 35</u> # And they shall say, This land that was desolate is become like the garden of Eden; and the waste and desolate and ruined cities [are become] fenced, [and] are inhabited.

become filthy there <u>19\_PSA\_14\_03</u> # They are all gone aside, they are [all] together become filthy: [there is] none that doeth good, no, not one.

become filthy there <u>19\_PSA\_53\_03</u># Every one of them is gone back: they are altogether become filthy; [there is] none that doeth good, no, not one.

become fishers of <u>41\_MAR\_01\_17</u># And Jesus said unto them, Come ye after me, and I will make you to become fishers of men.

become fools the <u>23\_ISA\_19\_13</u> # The princes of Zoan are become fools, the princes of Noph are deceived; they have also seduced Egypt, [even they that are] the stay of the tribes thereof.

become full of <u>03\_LEV\_19\_29</u># Do not prostitute thy daughter, to cause her to be a whore; lest the land fall to whoredom, and the land become full of wickedness.

become garments neither <u>23\_ISA\_59\_06</u># Their webs shall not become garments, neither shall they cover themselves with their works: their works [are] works of iniquity, and the act of violence [is] in their hands.

become glorious in <u>02\_EXO\_15\_06</u># Thy right hand, O LORD, is become glorious in power: thy right hand, O LORD, hath dashed in pieces the enemy.

become great and <u>01\_GEN\_24\_35</u># And the LORD hath blessed my master greatly; and he is become great: and he hath given him flocks, and herds, and silver, and gold, and menservants, and maidservants, and camels, and asses.

become great and <u>24\_JER\_05\_27</u> # As a cage is full of birds, so [are] their houses full of deceit: therefore they are become great, and waxen rich.

become guilty before <u>45\_ROM\_03\_19</u> # Now we know that what things soever the law saith, it saith to them who are under the law: that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God.

become guilty in <u>26\_EZE\_22\_04</u># Thou art become guilty in thy blood that thou hast shed; and hast defiled thyself in thine idols which thou hast made; and thou hast caused thy days to draw near, and art come [even] unto thy years: therefore have I made thee a reproach unto the heathen, and a mocking to all countries.

become heaps a <u>24\_JER\_51\_37</u> # And Babylon shall become heaps, a dwellingplace for dragons, and astonishment, and an hissing, without an inhabitant.

become rich I <u>28\_HOS\_12\_08</u> # And Ephraim said, Yet I am become rich, I have found me out substance: [in] all my labours they shall find none iniquity in me that [were] sin.

become servants to <u>45\_ROM\_06\_22</u> # But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.

become sin <u>19\_PSA\_109\_07</u># When he shall be judged, let him be condemned: and let his prayer become sin.

become small dust <u>02\_EXO\_09\_09</u># And it shall become small dust in all the land of Egypt, and shall be a boil breaking forth [with] blains upon man, and upon beast, throughout all the land of Egypt.

becometh poor that <u>20\_PRO\_10\_04</u># He becometh poor that dealeth [with] a slack hand: but the hand of the diligent maketh rich.

becometh poor <u>21\_ECC\_04\_14</u># For out of prison he cometh to reign; whereas also [he that is] born in his kingdom becometh poor.

becometh saints and <u>45\_ROM\_16\_02</u># That ye receive her in the Lord, as becometh saints, and that ye assist her in whatsoever business she hath need of you: for she hath been a succourer of many, and of myself also.

becometh saints <u>49\_EPH\_05\_03</u> # But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints;

becometh surety in <u>20\_PRO\_17\_18</u># A man void of understanding striketh hands, [and] becometh surety in the presence of his friend.

becometh the gospel <u>50\_PHP\_01\_27</u> # Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel;
