behave himself proudly [23 ISA 03 05](#) # And the people shall be oppressed, every one by another, and every one by his neighbour: the child shall behave himself proudly against the ancient, and the base against the honourable.

behave itself unseemly [46 1CO 13 05](#) # Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil;

behave myself wisely [19 PSA 101 02](#) # I will behave myself wisely in a perfect way. O when wilt thou come unto me? I will walk within my house with a perfect heart.

behave ourselves valiantly [13 1CH 19 13](#) # Be of good courage, and let us behave ourselves valiantly for our people, and for the cities of our God: and let the LORD do [that which is] good in his sight.

behave themselves strangely [05 DEU 32 27](#) # Were it not that I feared the wrath of the enemy, lest their adversaries should behave themselves strangely, [and] lest they should say, Our hand [is] high, and the LORD hath not done all this.

behave thyself in [54 1TI 03 15](#) # But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth.

behaved and quieted [19 PSA 131 02](#) # Surely I have behaved and quieted myself, as a child that is weaned of his mother: my soul [is] even as a weaned child.

behaved himself more [09 ISA 18 30](#) # Then the princes of the Philistines went forth: and it came to pass, after they went forth, [that] David behaved himself more wisely than all the servants of Saul; so that his name was much set by.

behaved himself very [09 ISA 18 15](#) # Wherefore when Saul saw that he behaved himself very wisely, he was afraid of him.

behaved himself wisely [09 ISA 18 05](#) # And David went out whithersoever Saul sent him, [and] behaved himself wisely: and Saul set him over the men of war, and he was accepted in the sight of all the people, and also in the sight of Saul's servants.

behaved himself wisely [09 ISA 18 14](#) # And David behaved himself wisely in all his ways; and the LORD [was] with him.

behaved myself as [19 PSA 35 14](#) # I behaved myself as though [he had been] my friend [or] brother: I bowed down heavily, as one that mourneth [for his] mother.

behaved not ourselves [53 2TH 03 07](#) # For yourselves know how ye ought to follow us: for we behaved not ourselves disorderly among you;

behaved ourselves among [52 1TH 02 10](#) # Ye [are] witnesses, and God [also], how holily and justly and unblameably we behaved ourselves among you that believe:

behaved themselves ill [33 MIC 03 04](#) # Then shall they cry unto the LORD, but he will not hear them: he will even hide his face from them at that time, as they have behaved themselves ill in their doings.

behaveth himself uncomely [46 1CO 07 36](#) # But if any man think that he behaveth himself uncomely toward his virgin, if she pass the flower of [her] age, and need so require, let him do what he will, he sinneth not: let them marry.
