belly and by [45 ROM 16 18](#) # For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple.

belly and goeth [41 MAR 07 19](#) # Because it entereth not into his heart, but into the belly, and goeth out into the draught, purging all meats?

belly and his [27 DAN 02 32](#) # This image's head [was] of fine gold, his breast and his arms of silver, his belly and his thighs of brass,

belly and is [40 MAT 15 17](#) # Do not ye yet understand, that whatsoever entereth in at the mouth goeth into the belly, and is cast out into the draught?

belly and the [46 1CO 06 13](#) # Meats for the belly, and the belly for meats: but God shall destroy both it and them. Now the body [is] not for fornication, but for the Lord; and the Lord for the body.

belly bitter but [66 REV 10 09](#) # And I went unto the angel, and said unto him, Give me the little book. And he said unto me, Take [it], and eat it up; and it shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall be in thy mouth sweet as honey.

belly cleaveth unto [19 PSA 44 25](#) # For our soul is bowed down to the dust: our belly cleaveth unto the earth.

belly for meats [46 1CO 06 13](#) # Meats for the belly, and the belly for meats: but God shall destroy both it and them. Now the body [is] not for fornication, but for the Lord; and the Lord for the body.

belly God shall [18 JOB 20 23](#) # [When] he is about to fill his belly, [God] shall cast the fury of his wrath upon him, and shall rain [it] upon him while he is eating.

belly he shall [18 JOB 20 20](#) # Surely he shall not feel quietness in his belly, he shall not save of that which he desired.

belly I knew [24 JER 01 05](#) # Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, [and] I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.

belly is as [18 JOB 32 19](#) # Behold, my belly [is] as wine [which] hath no vent; it is ready to burst like new bottles.

belly is as [22 SON 05 14](#) # His hands [are as] gold rings set with the beryl: his belly [is as] bright ivory

overlaid [with] sapphires.

belly is like [22 SON 07 02](#) # Thy navel [is like] a round goblet, [which] wanteth not liquor: thy belly [is like] an heap of wheat set about with lilies.

belly of hell [32 JON 02 02](#) # And said, I cried by reason of mine affliction unto the LORD, and he heard me; out of the belly of hell cried I, [and] thou heardest my voice.

belly of the [32 JON 01 17](#) # Now the LORD had prepared a great fish to swallow up Jonah. And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights.

belly of the [20 PRO 13 25](#) # The righteous eateth to the satisfying of his soul: but the belly of the wicked shall want.

belly prepareth deceit [18 JOB 15 35](#) # They conceive mischief, and bring forth vanity, and their belly prepareth deceit.
