beseech God that 39\_MAL\_01\_09 # And now, I pray you, beseech God that he will be gracious unto us: this hath been by your means: will he regard your persons? saith the LORD of hosts.

beseech him to 41\_MAR\_07\_32 # And they bring unto him one that was deaf, and had an impediment in his speech; and they beseech him to put his hand upon him.

beseech Syntyche that <u>50\_PHP\_04\_02</u> # I beseech Euodias, and beseech Syntyche, that they be of the same mind in the Lord.

beseech thee and 10\_2SA\_13\_24 # And Absalom came to the king, and said, Behold now, thy servant hath sheepshearers; let the king, I beseech thee, and his servants go with thy servant.
