betrothed a wife [05_DEU_20_07](#) # And what man [is there] that hath betrothed a wife, and hath not taken her? let him go and return unto his house, lest he die in the battle, and another man take her.

betrothed and lay [05_DEU_22_28](#) # If a man find a damsel [that is] a virgin, which is not betrothed, and lay hold on her, and lie with her, and they be found;

betrothed and lie [02_EXO_22_16](#) # And if a man entice a maid that is not betrothed, and lie with her, he shall surely endow her to be his wife.

betrothed damsel cried [05_DEU_22_27](#) # For he found her in the field, [and] the betrothed damsel cried, and [there was] none to save her.

betrothed damsel in [05_DEU_22_25](#) # But if a man find a betrothed damsel in the field, and the man force her, and lie with her: then the man only that lay with her shall die:
