bound in chains <u>34\_NAH\_03\_10</u> # Yet [was] she carried away, she went into captivity: her young children also were dashed in pieces at the top of all the streets: and they cast lots for her honourable men, and all her great men were bound in chains.

bound in fetters 18\_JOB\_36\_08 # And if [they be] bound in fetters, [and] be holden in cords of affliction;

bound in heaven <u>40\_MAT\_16\_19</u># And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

bound unto Jerusalem <u>44\_ACT\_22\_05</u> # As also the high priest doth bear me witness, and all the estate of the elders: from whom also I received letters unto the brethren, and went to Damascus, to bring them which were there bound unto Jerusalem, for to be punished.

bound unto the <u>44\_ACT\_09\_21</u> # But all that heard [him] were amazed, and said; Is not this he that destroyed them which called on this name in Jerusalem, and came hither for that intent, that he might bring them bound unto the chief priests?

bound with chains 19\_PSA\_68\_06 # God setteth the solitary in families: he bringeth out those which are bound with chains: but the rebellious dwell in a dry [land].

bound with cords <u>26\_EZE\_27\_24</u> # These [were] thy merchants in all sorts [of things], in blue clothes, and broidered work, and in chests of rich apparel, bound with cords, and made of cedar, among thy merchandise.

bound with fetters <u>41\_MAR\_05\_04</u> # Because that he had been often bound with fetters and chains, and the chains had been plucked asunder by him, and the fetters broken in pieces: neither could any [man] tame him.
