Cyprus an old <u>44_ACT_21_16</u># There went with us also [certain] of the disciples of Caesarea, and brought with them one Mnason of Cyprus, an old disciple, with whom we should lodge.

Cyprus and Antioch <u>44_ACT_11_19</u># Now they which were scattered abroad upon the persecution that arose about Stephen travelled as far as Phenice, and Cyprus, and Antioch, preaching the word to none but unto the Jews only.

Cyprus and Cyrene <u>44_ACT_11_20</u># And some of them were men of Cyprus and Cyrene, which, when they were come to Antioch, spake unto the Grecians, preaching the Lord Jesus.

Cyprus because the <u>44_ACT_27_04</u> # And when we had launched from thence, we sailed under Cyprus, because the winds were contrary.

Cyprus we left <u>44_ACT_21_03</u># Now when we had discovered Cyprus, we left it on the left hand, and sailed into Syria, and landed at Tyre: for there the ship was to unlade her burden.

Cyprus <u>44_ACT_04_36</u> # And Joses, who by the apostles was surnamed Barnabas, [which is, being interpreted, The son of consolation,] a Levite, [and] of the country of Cyprus,

Cyprus <u>44_ACT_13_04</u> # So they, being sent forth by the Holy Ghost, departed unto Seleucia; and from thence they sailed to Cyprus.

Cyprus <u>44_ACT_15_39</u> # And the contention was so sharp between them, that they departed asunder one from the other: and so Barnabas took Mark, and sailed unto Cyprus;
