calamus and cinnamon <u>22_SON_04_14</u> # Spikenard and saffron; calamus and cinnamon, with all trees of frankincense; myrrh and aloes, with all the chief spices:

calamus two hundred <u>02_EXO_30_23</u> # Take thou also unto thee principal spices, of pure myrrh five hundred [shekels], and of sweet cinnamon half so much, [even] two hundred and fifty [shekels], and of sweet calamus two hundred and fifty [shekels],

calamus were in <u>26_EZE_27_19</u> # Dan also and Javan going to and fro occupied in thy fairs: bright iron, cassia, and calamus, were in thy market.
