Canaan which Eleazar <u>06_JOS_14_01</u> # And these [are the countries] which the children of Israel inherited in the land of Canaan, which Eleazar the priest, and Joshua the son of Nun, and the heads of the fathers of the tribes of the children of Israel, distributed for inheritance to them.

Canaan which I <u>05 DEU 32 49 #</u> Get thee up into this mountain Abarim, [unto] mount Nebo, which [is] in the land of Moab, that [is] over against Jericho; and behold the land of Canaan, which I give unto the children of Israel for a possession:

Canaan which I <u>03_LEV_14_34</u> # When ye be come into the land of Canaan, which I give to you for a possession, and I put the plague of leprosy in a house of the land of your possession;

Canaan which I <u>04_NUM_13_02</u># Send thou men, that they may search the land of Canaan, which I give unto the children of Israel: of every tribe of their fathers shall ye send a man, every one a ruler among them.

Canaan which shall <u>04_NUM_35_14</u> # Ye shall give three cities on this side Jordan, and three cities shall ye give in the land of Canaan, [which] shall be cities of refuge.

Canaan whither I <u>03_LEV_18_03</u> # After the doings of the land of Egypt, wherein ye dwelt, shall ye not do: and after the doings of the land of Canaan, whither I bring you, shall ye not do: neither shall ye walk in their ordinances.

Canaan with the <u>04_NUM_34_02</u> # Command the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye come into the land of Canaan; [this [is] the land that shall fall unto you for an inheritance, [even] the land of Canaan with the coasts thereof:]

Canaan 13_1CH_01_08 # The sons of Ham; Cush, and Mizraim, Put, and Canaan.

Canaan <u>02_EXO_16_35</u># And the children of Israel did eat manna forty years, until they came to a land inhabited; they did eat manna, until they came unto the borders of the land of Canaan.

Canaan <u>01_GEN_09_18</u># And the sons of Noah, that went forth of the ark, were Shem, and Ham, and Japheth: and Ham [is] the father of Canaan.

Canaan <u>01 GEN_28_06</u> # When Esau saw that Isaac had blessed Jacob, and sent him away to Padanaram, to take him a wife from thence; and that as he blessed him he gave him a charge, saying, Thou shalt not take a wife of the daughters of Canaan;

Canaan <u>01_GEN_31_18</u># And he carried away all his cattle, and all his goods which he had gotten, the cattle of his getting, which he had gotten in Padanaram, for to go to Isaac his father in the land of Canaan.

Canaan <u>01_GEN_36_05</u> # And Aholibamah bare Jeush, and Jaalam, and Korah: these [are] the sons of Esau, which were born unto him in the land of Canaan.

Canaanite and the <u>02_EXO_23_28</u> # And I will send hornets before thee, which shall drive out the Hivite, the Canaanite, and the Hittite, from before thee.

Canaanite and the <u>02_EXO_34_11</u># Observe thou that which I command thee this day: behold, I drive out before thee the Amorite, and the Canaanite, and the Hittite, and the Perizzite, and the Hivite, and the Jebusite.

Canaanite and the <u>01_GEN_13_07</u># And there was a strife between the herdmen of Abram's cattle and the herdmen of Lot's cattle: and the Canaanite and the Perizzite dwelled then in the land.

Canaanites among whom <u>01_GEN_24_03</u># And I will make thee swear by the LORD, the God of heaven, and the God of the earth, that thou shalt not take a wife unto my son of the daughters of the Canaanites, among whom I dwell:

Canaanites and all <u>06_JOS_07_09</u># For the Canaanites and all the inhabitants of the land shall hear [of it], and shall environ us round, and cut off our name from the earth: and what wilt thou do unto thy great name?

Canaanites and gavest 16_NEH_09_24 # So the children went in and possessed the land, and thou

subduedst before them the inhabitants of the land, the Canaanites, and gavest them into their hands, with their kings, and the people of the land, that they might do with them as they would.

mourning in the floor of Atad, they said, This [is] a grievous mourning to the Egyptians: wherefore the name of it was called Abelmizraim, which [is] beyond Jordan.

Canaanites spread abroad <u>01_GEN_10_18</u># And the Arvadite, and the Zemarite, and the Hamathite: and afterward were the families of the Canaanites spread abroad.

Canaanites that dwell <u>06_JOS_17_16</u># And the children of Joseph said, The hill is not enough for us: and all the Canaanites that dwell in the land of the valley have chariots of iron, [both they] who [are] of Bethshean and her towns, and [they] who [are] of the valley of Jezreel.

Canaanites that dwelt <u>11_1KI_09_16</u># [For] Pharaoh king of Egypt had gone up, and taken Gezer, and burnt it with fire, and slain the Canaanites that dwelt in the city, and given it [for] a present unto his daughter, Solomon's wife.

Canaanites that dwelt <u>06_JOS_16_10</u># And they drave not out the Canaanites that dwelt in Gezer: but the Canaanites dwell among the Ephraimites unto this day, and serve under tribute.

Canaanitish woman <u>01_GEN_46_10</u># And the sons of Simeon; Jemuel, and Jamin, and Ohad, and Jachin, and Zohar, and Shaul the son of a Canaanitish woman.

Candace queen of <u>44_ACT_08_27</u># And he arose and went: and, behold, a man of Ethiopia, an eunuch of great authority under Candace queen of the Ethiopians, who had the charge of all her treasure, and had come to Jerusalem for to worship,

candle and put <u>40_MAT_05_15</u># Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house.

candle and sweep <u>42_LUK_15_08</u># Either what woman having ten pieces of silver, if she lose one piece, doth not light a candle, and sweep the house, and seek diligently till she find [it]?

candle brought to <u>41_MAR_04_21</u> # And he said unto them, Is a candle brought to be put under a bushel, or under a bed? and not to be set on a candlestick?

candle covereth it <u>42_LUK_08_16</u> # No man, when he hath lighted a candle, covereth it with a vessel, or putteth [it] under a bed; but setteth [it] on a candlestick, that they which enter in may see the light.

candle doth give <u>42_LUK_11_36</u># If thy whole body therefore [be] full of light, having no part dark, the whole shall be full of light, as when the bright shining of a candle doth give thee light.

candle goeth not 20_PRO_31_18 # She perceiveth that her merchandise [is] good: her candle goeth not out by night.

candle neither light <u>66_REV_22_05</u> # And there shall be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for the Lord God giveth them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever.

candle of the <u>18_JOB_21_17</u># How oft is the candle of the wicked put out! and [how oft] cometh their destruction upon them! [God] distributeth sorrows in his anger.

cannot deny himself 55_2TI_02_13 # If we believe not, [yet] he abideth faithful: he cannot deny himself.

cannot deny it <u>44_ACT_04_16</u># Saying, What shall we do to these men? for that indeed a notable miracle hath been done by them [is] manifest to all them that dwell in Jerusalem; and we cannot deny [it].

canst thou know <u>18_JOB_11_08</u># [It is] as high as heaven; what canst thou do? deeper than hell; what canst thou know?

Canst thou lift <u>18_JOB_38_34</u> # Canst thou lift up thy voice to the clouds, that abundance of waters may cover thee?

Canst thou make <u>18_JOB_39_20</u> # Canst thou make him afraid as a grasshopper? the glory of his nostrils [is] terrible.

canst thou mark <u>18_JOB_39_01</u> # Knowest thou the time when the wild goats of the rock bring forth? [or] canst thou mark when the hinds do calve?

Canst thou number <u>18_JOB_39_02</u> # Canst thou number the months [that] they fulfil? or knowest thou the time when they bring forth?
