catch all that [19 PSA 109 11](#) # Let the extortioner catch all that he hath; and let the strangers spoil his labour.

catch him in [41 MAR 12 13](#) # And they send unto him certain of the Pharisees and of the Herodians, to catch him in [his] words.

catch in thorns [02 EXO 22 06](#) # If fire break out, and catch in thorns, so that the stacks of corn, or the standing corn, or the field, be consumed [therewith]; he that kindled the fire shall surely make restitution.
