centurion a just [44 ACT 10 22](#) # And they said, Cornelius the centurion, a just man, and one that feareth God, and of good report among all the nation of the Jews, was warned from God by an holy angel to send for thee into his house, and to hear words of thee.

centurion and they [40 MAT 27 54](#) # Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God.

centurion and to [44 ACT 27 31](#) # Paul said to the centurion and to the soldiers, Except these abide in the ship, ye cannot be saved.

centurion answered and [40 MAT 08 08](#) # The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed.

centurion believed the [44 ACT 27 11](#) # Nevertheless the centurion believed the master and the owner of the ship, more than those things which were spoken by Paul.

centurion beseeching him [40 MAT 08 05](#) # And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto him a centurion, beseeching him,

centurion delivered the [44 ACT 28 16](#) # And when we came to Rome, the centurion delivered the prisoners to the captain of the guard: but Paul was suffered to dwell by himself with a soldier that kept him.

centurion found a [44 ACT 27 06](#) # And there the centurion found a ship of Alexandria sailing into Italy; and he put us therein.

centurion Go thy [40 MAT 08 13](#) # And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, [so] be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.

centurion he asked [41 MAR 15 44](#) # And Pilate marvelled if he were already dead: and calling [unto him] the centurion, he asked him whether he had been any while dead.

centurion he gave [41 MAR 15 45](#) # And when he knew [it] of the centurion, he gave the body to Joseph.

centurion heard that [44 ACT 22 26](#) # When the centurion heard [that], he went and told the chief captain, saying, Take heed what thou doest: for this man is a Roman.

centurion of Augustus' [44 ACT 27 01](#) # And when it was determined that we should sail into Italy, they delivered Paul and certain other prisoners unto [one] named Julius, a centurion of Augustus' band.

centurion of the [44 ACT 10 01](#) # There was a certain man in Caesarea called Cornelius, a centurion of the band called the Italian [band],

centurion saw what [42 LUK 23 47](#) # Now when the centurion saw what was done, he glorified God, saying, Certainly this was a righteous man.

centurion sent friends [42 LUK 07 06](#) # Then Jesus went with them. And when he was now not far from the house, the centurion sent friends to him, saying unto him, Lord, trouble not thyself: for I am not worthy that thou shouldest enter under my roof:

centurion that stood [44 ACT 22 25](#) # And as they bound him with thongs, Paul said unto the centurion that stood by, Is it lawful for you to scourge a man that is a Roman, and uncondemned?

centurion to keep [44 ACT 24 23](#) # And he commanded a centurion to keep Paul, and to let [him] have liberty, and that he should forbid none of his acquaintance to minister or come unto him.

centurion which stood [41 MAR 15 39](#) # And when the centurion, which stood over against him, saw that he so cried out, and gave up the ghost, he said, Truly this man was the Son of God.

centurion willing to [44 ACT 27 43](#) # But the centurion, willing to save Paul, kept them from [their] purpose; and commanded that they which could swim should cast [themselves] first [into the sea], and get to land:

centurion's servant who [42 LUK 07 02](#) # And a certain centurion's servant, who was dear unto him, was sick, and ready to die.

centurions and ran [44 ACT 21 32](#) # Who immediately took soldiers and centurions, and ran down unto them: and when they saw the chief captain and the soldiers, they left beating of Paul.

centurions saying Make [44 ACT 23 23](#) # And he called unto [him] two centurions, saying, Make ready two hundred soldiers to go to Caesarea, and horsemen threescore and ten, and spearmen two hundred, at the third hour of the night;

centurions unto him [44 ACT 23 17](#) # Then Paul called one of the centurions unto [him], and said, Bring this young man unto the chief captain: for he hath a certain thing to tell him.
