change of garments [07 JUD 14 12](#) # And Samson said unto them, I will now put forth a riddle unto you: if ye can certainly declare it me within the seven days of the feast, and find [it] out, then I will give you thirty sheets and thirty change of garments:

change of garments [07 JUD 14 13](#) # But if ye cannot declare [it] me, then shall ye give me thirty sheets and thirty change of garments. And they said unto him, Put forth thy riddle, that we may hear it.

change the natural [45 ROM 01 26](#) # For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature:

change the night [18 JOB 17 12](#) # They change the night into day: the light [is] short because of darkness.

change their glory [28 HOS 04 07](#) # As they were increased, so they sinned against me: [therefore] will I change their glory into shame.

change them and [19 PSA 102 26](#) # They shall perish, but thou shalt endure: yea, all of them shall wax old like a garment; as a vesture shalt thou change them, and they shall be changed:

change them into [23 ISA 09 10](#) # The bricks are fallen down, but we will build with hewn stones: the sycamores are cut down, but we will change [them into] cedars.

changeable suits of [23 ISA 03 22](#) # The changeable suits of apparel, and the mantles, and the wimples, and the crisping pins,

changed according to [27 DAN 06 08](#) # Now, O king, establish the decree, and sign the writing, that it be not changed, according to the law of the Medes and Persians, which altereth not.

changed against Shadrach [27 DAN 03 19](#) # Then was Nebuchadnezzar full of fury, and the form of his visage was changed against Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego: [therefore] he spake, and commanded that they should heat the furnace one seven times more than it was wont to be heated.

changed and his [27 DAN 05 06](#) # Then the king's countenance was changed, and his thoughts troubled him, so that the joints of his loins were loosed, and his knees smote one against another.

changed from man's [27 DAN 04 16](#) # Let his heart be changed from man's, and let a beast's heart be given unto him: and let seven times pass over him.

changed his apparel [10 2SA 12 20](#) # Then David arose from the earth, and washed, and anointed [himself], and changed his apparel, and came into the house of the LORD, and worshipped: then he came to his own house; and when he required, they set bread before him, and he did eat.

changed his behaviour [09 ISA 21 13](#) # And he changed his behaviour before them, and feigned himself mad in their hands, and scrabbled on the doors of the gate, and let his spittle fall down upon his beard.

changed his raiment [01 GEN 41 14](#) # Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph, and they brought him hastily out of the dungeon: and he shaved [himself], and changed his raiment, and came in unto Pharaoh.

changed in him [27 DAN 05 09](#) # Then was king Belshazzar greatly troubled, and his countenance was changed in him, and his lords were astonished.

changed in me [27 DAN 07 28](#) # Hitherto [is] the end of the matter. As for me Daniel, my cogitations much troubled me, and my countenance changed in me: but I kept the matter in my heart.
