changed according to <u>27_DAN_06_08</u># Now, O king, establish the decree, and sign the writing, that it be not changed, according to the law of the Medes and Persians, which altereth not.

changed against Shadrach <u>27_DAN_03_19</u> # Then was Nebuchadnezzar full of fury, and the form of his visage was changed against Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego: [therefore] he spake, and commanded that they should heat the furnace one seven times more than it was wont to be heated.

changed and his <u>27_DAN_05_06</u># Then the king's countenance was changed, and his thoughts troubled him, so that the joints of his loins were loosed, and his knees smote one against another.

changed his behaviour <u>09_1SA_21_13</u> # And he changed his behaviour before them, and feigned himself mad in their hands, and scrabbled on the doors of the gate, and let his spittle fall down upon his beard.

changed his behaviour <u>19_PSA_34_01</u> # [A Psalm] of David, when he changed his behaviour before Abimelech; who drove him away, and he departed. I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise [shall] continually [be] in my mouth.

changed his colour <u>03_LEV_13_55</u># And the priest shall look on the plague, after that it is washed: and, behold, [if] the plague have not changed his colour, and the plague be not spread; it [is] unclean; thou shalt burn it in the fire; it [is] fret inward, [whether] it [be] bare within or without.

changed his name 12_2KI_24_17 # And the king of Babylon made Mattaniah his father's brother king in his stead, and changed his name to Zedekiah.

changed his raiment 01_GEN_41_14 # Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph, and they brought him hastily

out of the dungeon: and he shaved [himself], and changed his raiment, and came in unto Pharaoh.

changed in him <u>27_DAN_05_09</u> # Then was king Belshazzar greatly troubled, and his countenance was changed in him, and his lords were astonied.

changed in me <u>27_DAN_07_28</u> # Hitherto [is] the end of the matter. As for me Daniel, my cogitations much troubled me, and my countenance changed in me: but I kept the matter in my heart.

changed into the <u>47_2CO_03_18</u> # But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, [even] as by the Spirit of the Lord.
