chant to the <u>30\_AMO\_06\_05</u># That chant to the sound of the viol, [and] invent to themselves instruments of music, like David;

enchanter or a <u>05\_DEU\_18\_10</u># There shall not be found among you [any one] that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, [or] that useth divination, [or] an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch,
