charity among yourselves [60 IPE 04 08](#) # And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins.

charity and desire [46 ICO 14 01](#) # Follow after charity, and desire spiritual [gifts], but rather that ye may prophesy.

charity and holiness [54 ITI 02 15](#) # Notwithstanding she shall be saved in childbearing, if they continue in faith and charity and holiness with sobriety.

charity and service [66 REV 02 19](#) # I know thy works, and charity, and service, and faith, and thy patience, and thy works; and the last [to be] more than the first.
