cheek and said 11\_1KI\_22\_24# But Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah went near, and smote Micaiah on the cheek, and said, Which way went the spirit of the LORD from me to speak unto thee?

cheek and said <u>14\_2CH\_18\_23</u> # Then Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah came near, and smote Micaiah upon the cheek, and said, Which way went the Spirit of the LORD from me to speak unto thee?

cheek bone thou 19 PSA 03 07 # Arise, O LORD; save me, O my God: for thou hast smitten all mine enemies [upon] the cheek bone; thou hast broken the teeth of the ungodly.

cheek offer also 42\_LUK\_06\_29 # And unto him that smiteth thee on the [one] cheek offer also the other; and him that taketh away thy cloak forbid not [to take thy] coat also.

cheek reproachfully they <u>18\_JOB\_16\_10</u># They have gaped upon me with their mouth; they have smitten me upon the cheek reproachfully; they have gathered themselves together against me.

cheek teeth of 29\_JOE\_01\_06 # For a nation is come up upon my land, strong, and without number, whose teeth [are] the teeth of a lion, and he hath the cheek teeth of a great lion.

cheek to him 25\_LAM\_03\_30 # He giveth [his] cheek to him that smiteth him: he is filled full with reproach.

cheek turn to <u>40\_MAT\_05\_39</u># But I say unto you, That ye resist not evil: but whosoever shall smite thee on thy right cheek, turn to him the other also.

cheek <u>33\_MIC\_05\_01</u># Now gather thyself in troops, O daughter of troops: he hath laid siege against us: they shall smite the judge of Israel with a rod upon the cheek.

cheeks among all <u>25\_LAM\_01\_02</u># She weepeth sore in the night, and her tears [are] on her cheeks: among all her lovers she hath none to comfort [her]: all her friends have dealt treacherously with her, they are become her enemies.

cheeks and the <u>05\_DEU\_18\_03</u># And this shall be the priest's due from the people, from them that offer a sacrifice, whether [it be] ox or sheep; and they shall give unto the priest the shoulder, and the two cheeks, and the maw.

cheeks are as <u>22\_SON\_05\_13</u> # His cheeks [are] as a bed of spices, [as] sweet flowers: his lips [like] lilies, dropping sweet smelling myrrh.

cheeks are comely <u>22\_SON\_01\_10</u> # Thy cheeks are comely with rows [of jewels], thy neck with chains [of gold].

cheeks to them <u>23\_ISA\_50\_06</u># I gave my back to the smiters, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I hid not my face from shame and spitting.
