cinnamon and odours <u>66_REV_18_13</u># And cinnamon, and odours, and ointments, and frankincense, and wine, and oil, and fine flour, and wheat, and beasts, and sheep, and horses, and chariots, and slaves, and souls of men.

cinnamon half so <u>02_EXO_30_23</u> # Take thou also unto thee principal spices, of pure myrrh five hundred [shekels], and of sweet cinnamon half so much, [even] two hundred and fifty [shekels], and of sweet calamus two hundred and fifty [shekels],

cinnamon with all <u>22_SON_04_14</u># Spikenard and saffron; calamus and cinnamon, with all trees of frankincense; myrrh and aloes, with all the chief spices:

cinnamon 20_PRO_07_17 # I have perfumed my bed with myrrh, aloes, and cinnamon.
