clay and anointed <u>43\_JOH\_09\_11</u># He answered and said, A man that is called Jesus made clay, and anointed mine eyes, and said unto me, Go to the pool of Siloam, and wash: and I went and washed, and I received sight.

clay and brake <u>27\_DAN\_02\_34</u> # Thou sawest till that a stone was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet [that were] of iron and clay, and brake them to pieces.

clay and opened <u>43\_JOH\_09\_14</u> # And it was the sabbath day when Jesus made the clay, and opened his eyes.

clay and part <u>27\_DAN\_02\_41</u># And whereas thou sawest the feet and toes, part of potter's clay, and part of iron, the kingdom shall be divided; but there shall be in it of the strength of the iron, forasmuch as thou sawest the iron mixed with miry clay.

clay and set 19\_PSA\_40\_02 # He brought me up also out of an horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, [and] established my goings.

clay for shall 23 ISA 29 16 # Surely your turning of things upside down shall be esteemed as the potter's clay: for shall the work say of him that made it, He made me not? or shall the thing framed say of him that framed it, He had no understanding?

clay ground between <u>11\_1KI\_07\_46</u># In the plain of Jordan did the king cast them, in the clay ground between Succoth and Zarthan.

clay ground between 14\_2CH\_04\_17 # In the plain of Jordan did the king cast them, in the clay ground between Succoth and Zeredathah.

clay in the 24\_JER\_43\_09 # Take great stones in thine hand, and hide them in the clay in the brickkiln, which [is] at the entry of Pharaoh's house in Tahpanhes, in the sight of the men of Judah;

clay is in 24\_JER\_18\_06 # O house of Israel, cannot I do with you as this potter? saith the LORD. Behold, as the clay [is] in the potter's hand, so [are] ye in mine hand, O house of Israel.

clay of the <u>43\_JOH\_09\_06</u># When he had thus spoken, he spat on the ground, and made clay of the spittle, and he anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay,

clay of the <u>45\_ROM\_09\_21</u> # Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour?
