clothe a man [20 PRO 23 21](#) # For the drunkard and the glutton shall come to poverty: and drowsiness shall clothe [a man] with rags.

clothe her priests [19 PSA 132 16](#) # I will also clothe her priests with salvation: and her saints shall shout aloud for joy.

clothe him with [23 ISA 22 21](#) # And I will clothe him with thy robe, and strengthen him with thy girdle, and I will commit thy government into his hand: and he shall be a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and to the house of Judah.

clothe Mordecai and [17 EST 04 04](#) # So Esther's maids and her chamberlains came and told [it] her. Then was the queen exceedingly grieved; and she sent raiment to clothe Mordecai, and to take away his sackcloth from him: but he received [it] not.

clothe the grass [42 LUK 12 28](#) # If then God so clothe the grass, which is to day in the field, and to morrow is cast into the oven; how much more [will he clothe] you, O ye of little faith?

clothe the grass [40 MAT 06 30](#) # Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, [shall he] not much more [clothe] you, O ye of little faith?

clothe the heavens [23 ISA 50 03](#) # I clothe the heavens with blackness, and I make sackcloth their covering.

clothe thee with [23 ISA 49 18](#) # Lift up thine eyes round about, and behold: all these gather themselves together, [and] come to thee. [As] I live, saith the LORD, thou shalt surely clothe thee with them all, as with an ornament, and bind them [on thee], as a bride [doeth].

clothe thee with [38 ZEC 03 04](#) # And he answered and spake unto those that stood before him, saying, Take away the filthy garments from him. And unto him he said, Behold, I have caused thine iniquity to pass from thee, and I will clothe thee with change of raiment.

clothe them with [02 EXO 40 14](#) # And thou shalt bring his sons, and clothe them with coats:

clothe themselves with [26 EZE 26 16](#) # Then all the princes of the sea shall come down from their thrones, and lay away their robes, and put off their broidered garments: they shall clothe themselves with trembling; they shall sit upon the ground, and shall tremble at [every] moment, and be astonished at thee.

clothe with shame [19 PSA 132 18](#) # His enemies will I clothe with shame: but upon himself shall his crown flourish.

clothe you but [37 HAG 01 06](#) # Ye have sown much, and bring in little; ye eat, but ye have not enough; ye drink, but ye are not filled with drink; ye clothe you, but there is none warm; and he that earneth wages earneth wages [to put it] into a bag with holes.

clothe you O [42 LUK 12 28](#) # If then God so clothe the grass, which is to day in the field, and to morrow is cast into the oven; how much more [will he clothe] you, O ye of little faith?

clothe you O [40 MAT 06 30](#) # Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to

morrow is cast into the oven, [shall he] not much more [clothe] you, O ye of little faith?

clothe you with [26 EZE 34 03](#) # Ye eat the fat, and ye clothe you with the wool, ye kill them that are fed: [but] ye feed not the flock.

clothed all that [14 2CH 28 15](#) # And the men which were expressed by name rose up, and took the captives, and with the spoil clothed all that were naked among them, and arrayed them, and shod them, and gave them to eat and to drink, and anointed them, and carried all the feeble of them upon asses, and brought them to Jericho, the city of palm trees, to their brethren: then they returned to Samaria.

clothed and in [42 LUK 08 35](#) # Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus, and found the man, out of whom the devils were departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

clothed and in [41 MAR 05 15](#) # And they come to Jesus, and see him that was possessed with the devil, and had the legion, sitting, and clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

clothed and that [66 REV 03 18](#) # I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and [that] the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

clothed Daniel with [27 DAN 05 29](#) # Then commanded Belshazzar, and they clothed Daniel with scarlet, and [put] a chain of gold about his neck, and made a proclamation concerning him, that he should be the third ruler in the kingdom.

clothed him with [03 LEV 08 07](#) # And he put upon him the coat, and girded him with the girdle, and clothed him with the robe, and put the ephod upon him, and he girded him with the curious girdle of the ephod, and bound [it] unto him therewith.

clothed him with [41 MAR 15 17](#) # And they clothed him with purple, and platted a crown of thorns, and put it about his [head],

clothed me with [23 ISA 61 10](#) # I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for he hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decketh [himself] with ornaments, and as a bride adorneth [herself] with her jewels.

clothed me with [18 JOB 10 11](#) # Thou hast clothed me with skin and flesh, and hast fenced me with bones and sinews.

clothed most gorgeously [26 EZE 23 12](#) # She doted upon the Assyrians [her] neighbours, captains and rulers clothed most gorgeously, horsemen riding upon horses, all of them desirable young men.

clothed them [01 GEN 03 21](#) # Unto Adam also and to his wife did the LORD God make coats of skins, and clothed them.

clothed upon that [47 2CO 05 04](#) # For we that are in [this] tabernacle do groan, being burdened: not for that we would be unclothed, but clothed upon, that mortality might be swallowed up of life.

clothed upon with [47 2CO 05 02](#) # For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed upon with our house which is from heaven:

clothed we shall [47 2CO 05 03](#) # If so be that being clothed we shall not be found naked.

clothed with a [13 1CH 15 27](#) # And David [was] clothed with a robe of fine linen, and all the Levites that bare the ark, and the singers, and Chenaniah the master of the song with the singers: David also [had] upon him an ephod of linen.

clothed with a [66 REV 01 13](#) # And in the midst of the seven candlesticks [one] like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.

clothes and bathe [03 LEV 15 08](#) # And if he that hath the issue spit upon him that is clean; then he shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

clothes and bathe [03 LEV 15 10](#) # And whosoever toucheth any thing that was under him shall be unclean until the even: and he that beareth [any of] those things shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

clothes and bathe [03 LEV 15 11](#) # And whomsoever he toucheth that hath the issue, and hath not rinsed his hands in water, he shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

clothes and bathe [03 LEV 15 13](#) # And when he that hath an issue is cleansed of his issue; then he shall number to himself seven days for his cleansing, and wash his clothes, and bathe his flesh in running water, and shall be clean.

clothes and bathe [03 LEV 15 21](#) # And whosoever toucheth her bed shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

clothes and bathe [03 LEV 15 22](#) # And whosoever toucheth any thing that she sat upon shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

clothes and bathe [03 LEV 15 27](#) # And whosoever toucheth those things shall be unclean, and shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

clothes and bathe [03 LEV 16 26](#) # And he that let go the goat for the scapegoat shall wash his clothes, and bathe his flesh in water, and afterward come into the camp.

clothes and bathe [03 LEV 16 28](#) # And he that burneth them shall wash his clothes, and bathe his flesh in water, and afterward he shall come into the camp.

clothes and bathe [03 LEV 17 15](#) # And every soul that eateth that which died [of itself], or that which was torn [with beasts, whether it be] one of your own country, or a stranger, he shall both wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even: then shall he be clean.

clothes and bathe [04 NUM 19 19](#) # And the clean [person] shall sprinkle upon the unclean on the third day, and on the seventh day: and on the seventh day he shall purify himself, and wash his clothes, and bathe himself in water, and shall be clean at even.
