companions according to [15 EZR 06 13](#) # Then Tatnai, governor on this side the river, Shetharboznai, and their companions, according to that which Darius the king had sent, so they did speedily.

companions and bewailed [07 JUD 11 38](#) # And he said, Go. And he sent her away [for] two months; and she went with her companions, and bewailed her virginity upon the mountains.

companions and said [15 EZR 05 03](#) # At the same time came to them Tatnai, governor on this side the river, and Shetharboznai, and their companions, and said thus unto them, Who hath commanded you to build this house, and to make up this wall?

companions hearken to [22 SON 08 13](#) # Thou that dwellest in the gardens, the companions hearken to thy voice: cause me to hear [it].

companions in travel [44 ACT 19 29](#) # And the whole city was filled with confusion: and having caught Gaius and Aristarchus, men of Macedonia, Paul's companions in travel, they rushed with one accord into the theatre.

companions of them [58 HEB 10 33](#) # Partly, whilst ye were made a gazingstock both by reproaches and afflictions; and partly, whilst ye became companions of them that were so used.

companions of thieves [23 ISA 01 23](#) # Thy princes [are] rebellious, and companions of thieves: every one loveth gifts, and followeth after rewards: they judge not the fatherless, neither doth the cause of the widow come unto them.

companions sakes I [19 PSA 122 08](#) # For my brethren and companions' sakes, I will now say, Peace [be] within thee.

companions that dwell [15 EZR 04 17](#) # [Then] sent the king an answer unto Rehum the chancellor, and [to] Shimshai the scribe, and [to] the rest of their companions that dwell in Samaria, and [unto] the rest beyond the river, Peace, and at such a time.
